**PERMIT PROCEDURES:**

In accordance with Title V, Chapter 49, the undersigned herewith makes application for a permit to undertake a proposed earth change. Permit requirements will be as follows:

1. An application for a City-prescribed permit shall be submitted to the Department of Engineering by a person proposing to undertake an earth change. In land development the application shall be submitted by the land owner or his authorized agent, whoever is responsible for the earth change.
2. The application shall be accompanied by a soil erosion and sedimentation control plan.
3. The soil erosion and sedimentation control plan shall be reviewed and approved by a person designated by the City Engineer who is certified to administer Part 91, SESC, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act.
4. The Department of Engineering shall approve, disapprove or require modification of an application for an earth change permit within thirty calendar days following receipt of the application.
5. A prescribed permit shall be used by the Department of Engineer and shall include any additional provisions which may be required by the Department of Engineering. The permit shall be available on the site of the earth change for inspection.
6. Upon a determination that an application has met all the requirements, the Department of Engineering shall issue a permit for the proposed earth change.
7. An “authorized public agency” is exempt from obtaining a permit from the Department of Engineering but shall notify the Department of Engineering of each proposed earth change.
