

ORDINANCE NO. 1696

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, TRAFFIC, CHAPTER 26, TRAFFIC, SUBCHAPTER H, SOUTHFIELD VEHICLE CODE, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SOUTHFIELD BY DELETING SECTION 10.1006, PARKING REQUIREMENTS, AND INSERTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SECTION 10.1006, PARKING REQUIREMENTS.

THE CITY OF SOUTHFIELD ORDAINS:

THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SOUTHFIELD IS HEREBY AMENDED BY DELETING SECTION 10.1006, PARKING REQUIREMENTS, OF CHAPTER 26, TRAFFIC, SUBCHAPTER H, SOUTHFIELD VEHICLE CODE, OF TITLE X, TRAFFIC, AND INSERTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SECTION 10.1006, PARKING REQUIREMENTS, WHICH SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Sec. 10.1006. Parking Regulations

A motor vehicle shall not be parked on any public street between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.; however, permission to park during these hours may be granted by the chief of police or his designee for a period not to exceed seven (7) days when a social function is being held, construction is in progress prohibiting the use of a driveway or garage, or other special occasion(s) upon the finding by the chief of police or his designee that such permission will not be detrimental to the surrounding neighborhood; provided, however, any such permission to park on the public street during these hours issued by the chief of police or his designee shall be limited to no more than two (2) annually per residence or household.

SECTION 2.

Should any section, subsection, clause, or paragraph of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same will not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION 3.

Rights and duties which have matured; penalties which have been incurred; proceedings which have begun and prosecutions for violations of law occurring before the effective date of this Ordinance are not affected or abated by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
