

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program – FY2019/2020 Activities

The City of Southfield proposes the following activities for FY 2019/2020 with the Community Development Block Grant Funds, reprogrammed funds and program income from the Southfield Home Improvement Program (SHIP).

- 1. Administration: Administrative costs for running the CDBG program. Expenditures include wages, supplies, legal notices, etc. CDBG Budget: \$87,540.*
- 2. Fair Housing: Promotes equal and fair housing through the Fair Housing Center of Metropolitan Detroit. CDBG Budget: \$1,983.*
- 3. HAVEN: Providing services related to domestic violence. CDBG Budget: \$1,000.*
- 4. South Oakland Shelter: Providing services to residents for youth counseling and runaway shelters. CDBG Budget: \$1,000.*
- 5. Southfield Youth Assistance (SYA): Provides funds for scholarships for needy youth for skill building programs such as summer school, education and recreation programs, camps, etc. CDBG Budget: \$19,675.*
- 6. Transportation of Southfield Seniors (TOSS): Provides affordable public transportation to senior adult residents. CDBG Budget: \$25,795.*
- 7. Emergency Relief Fund (ERF): Provides interim care to low/moderate income residents to prevent evictions, utility shut offs, food, medication, etc. CDBG Budget: \$19,675.*
- 8. Southfield Home Improvement Program (SHIP): Provides funds to low/moderate income homeowners to repair their homes. Typical improvements include: roofs, furnaces, sewer connections. CDBG Budget: \$82,592. plus program income funds.*
- 9. Rebuilding Together: To assist low/moderate income families with home improvements with volunteers. CDBG Budget: \$29,772.*
- 10. Chore Program: Provides assistance to low/moderate income seniors with funds for minor home repair. CDBG Budget: \$148,840.*
- 11. Code Enforcement: Provides funds for code enforcement officers to eliminate blight through enforcement of anti-blight ordinances. CDBG Budget: \$29,772.*
