Picnic Shelter Reservations

Reservations for summer 2021 begin at 9 am on Monday, April 5.



Beech Woods Park \$150

Maximum occupancy 65 people (12 tables) Park features a playlot, tennis courts and sand volleyball court. The Beech Woods Driving Range is also on site (additional fees required to play).



Pebble Creek Park 🛛 \$275

Maximum occupancy 150 people (18 tables) There is a large grill within the shelter available for your use. Also on site are a paved walking path, a playlot, volleyball court, soccer field (permit required) and restrooms. Please note: no vehicles are allowed past the gate at Pebble Creek Park. No exceptions.





- Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis and must be made by a Southfield resident or Business Leisure Card holder.
- Payment in full is required at time of booking. No cash or checks. Credit card payment only.
- There are no refunds on shelter permits.





Civic Center Park #1 \$200

Maximum occupancy 100 people (15 tables)

Civic Center Park features a playlot, nature trail, tennis courts, sand volleyball courts (permit required) and a baseball field (permit required). Also on site is the Evergreen Hills Golf Course. Please note: Due to the pandemic, Open Swim at the Southfield Sports Arena Pool is not yet available.

Civic Center Park #2 \$100

Maximum occupancy 50 people (10 tables) This shelter is available for rental only on the weekends.

Please note for summer 2021:
All participants must wear a face mask and maintain 6 ft. of distance between households as much as possible.

- No cash or checks. Credit card payment only.
- There are no tents, inflatables or food trucks allowed on park property.

Rules for 2021 Picnic Shelter Reservations

- 1. Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis and must be made in person by a City of Southfield adult resident or a Business Leisure Card holder. One permit, per person, per day.
- 2. The picnic area may be reserved from 8:00 am until 8:00 pm
- 3. There are NO refunds on shelter permits.
- 4. The park and its amenities are available to the public as well as picnic permit holders. However, the picnic shelter is exclusive to the permit holder's group.
- 5. To avoid complications, please bring your picnic shelter permit with you on the day of your event.
- 6. No tents or inflatables allowed at parks for summer 2021.
- 7. No food trucks allowed on park property.
- 8. In accordance with Epidemic Orders in place by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, all participants must wear a face mask. Participants must also maintain 6 ft. of distance between households as much as possible.
- 9. Please do not nail, staple or use thumbtacks on the picnic shelter. Signs/banners may be adhered to the shelter by string or tape. At the conclusion of your event, please remove all signs posted in the park by your group.
- 10. Steel pins/stakes are not permitted in the ground at any park site due to the irrigation system and underground wiring.
- 11. Please observe all park rules posted at each park.
- 12. Electricity is not available at any of the picnic shelters.
- 13. A \$50 fee is applied to any change in the event date. The holder of the permit must bring the permit into the Southfield Parks & Recreation offices for all requested changes. No changes over the phone or via e-mail.
- 14. No deep-frying allowed in the parks.
- 15. The holder of the picnic shelter permit will be held responsible for damages or repairs incurred during the time of your event.
- 16. No alcohol is allowed at any Southfield park.
- 17. There are no vehicles allowed past the gate at Pebble Creek Park. No exceptions.

Please note: Due to the pandemic, Open Swim at the Southfield Sports Arena Pool is not yet available.
