

Project Purpose

Project Guiding Principles


Community Engagement Dog Park

- Locate the park in the right location for safety, and park character
















Park Facilities Park Type Deficiencies and Surplus*










Trends and Research











Scheme 1 "Natural Rhythm"

- Limit amount of new infrastructure in the park; Three separate park entrances with three distinct characters

















Scheme 2 "Par 3"
