

City of Southfield Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

Annual Action Plan Activities FY 2022 -2023

The City of Southfield will propose funds for the following activities for FY 2022/2023 with the Community Development Block Grant Funds, reprogrammed funds and program income from the Southfield Home Improvement Program (SHIP). 2022/2023 Entitlement Funds: \$398,079

- 1. Administration: Administrative costs for running the CDBG program. Expenditures include wages, supplies, legal notices, etc. \$77,594
- 2. Fair Housing: Promotes equal and fair housing through the Fair Housing Center of Metropolitan Detroit. \$1,955
- *3. HAVEN: Provides services related to the needs of those affected by domestic violence.* \$3,000
- 4. South Oakland Shelter: Provides services to people experiencing homelessness. \$1,500
- 5. Southfield Youth Assistance (SYA): Provides funds for scholarships for needy youth for skill building education and recreational programs, camps, etc. \$17,330
- 6. Emergency Relief Fund (ERF): Provides interim care to low/moderate income residents to prevent evictions, utility shut offs, and provides food and medication.\$15,000
- 7. Southfield Home Improvement Program (SHIP): Provides loans to low/moderate income homeowners to repair their homes. *\$121,700*
- 8. Chore Program: Provides assistance to low/moderate income seniors with funds for minor home repair. \$145,000
- 9. Rebuilding together: Assists low/moderate income families with home improvements using the help of volunteers.\$15,000
