

City of Southfield Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

Proposed Annual Action Plan FY 2023 -2024

The City of Southfield will propose funds for the following activities for FY 2023/2024 with the Community Development Block Grant Funds, reprogrammed funds, and program income from the Southfield Home Improvement Program (SHIP).

2023/2024 Entitlement Funds totaling \$387,080

- 1. Administration: Administrative costs for running the CDBG program. Expenditures include wages, supplies, legal notices, etc. **\$75,416**
- 2. Fair Housing: Promotes equal and fair housing through the Fair Housing Center of Metropolitan Detroit. *\$2,000*
- *3. HAVEN: Provides services related to the needs of those affected by domestic violence. \$3,000*
- 4. Lighthouse of Michigan: Provides services to people experiencing homelessness. \$1,500
- 5. Southfield Youth Assistance (SYA): Provides funds for scholarships for low/moderate income youth for skill building education and recreational programs, camps, etc. **\$20,000**
- 6. Emergency Relief Fund (ERF): Provides interim care to low/moderate income residents to prevent evictions, utility shut offs, and provides food and medication. **\$31,562**
- 7. Southfield Home Improvement Program (SHIP): Provides loans to low/moderate income homeowners to repair their homes. **\$61,602**
- 8. Chore Program: Provides assistance to low/moderate income seniors with funds for minor home repair. \$167,000
- 9. Rebuilding Together: Assists low/moderate income families with home improvements using the help of volunteers. **\$25,000**
