# LET CHORE HELP

## CITY OF SOUTHFIELD'S

CHORE program has been assisting seniors (62+) and physically-challenged homeowners in repairing and maintaining their homes and property since its inception in 1983.

A qualified homeowner is granted \$600 per year (subject to change) for this purpose. CHORE grants pay for labor involved, while homeowners are responsible for materials (for example: paint, lumber).

By helping with minor home repairs and yard work, CHORE enables these residents to remain in their homes. CHORE contractors are insured, recommended, and adhere to current health guidelines.

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# SERVICES INCLUDE:

## HOUSEHOLD WORK:

- Lawn care, shrub and tree trimming, leaf pickup
- Snow removal
- Window and gutter cleaning
- Window and screen installation
- Minor plumbing
- Minor furnace repair
- Minor electrical work
- Minor painting
- Carpentry



# WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

## SOUTHFIELD HOMEOWNERS WHO ARE BOTH:

- Senior citizens (62 or older) OR a person of any age receiving social security disability, living alone, or with a qualifying person.

AND

- Whose annual income meets federal low-income guidelines:\*

Family of ONE  
\$33,600 (2024/2025)\*

Family of TWO  
\$38,400 (2024/2025)\*

\* Federal income guidelines change each year. Please consult CHORE staff for current income guidelines.

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
