

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INTERESTING SOUTHFIELD FACTS

- The City of Southfield was named one of the nation's most livable metroarea suburbs by Forbes magazine based on market research conducted by NeighborhoodScout.com, a statistical database that gathers figures from the U.S. Census, the National Center for Education Statistics, the Office of Federal Housing Enterprise Oversight, the FBI and the U.S. Justice Department.
- Southfield was selected as metro Detroit's "most livable" community by Forbes

 ownership rates, home values, quality of schools, and the crime index.
