This logo appears on products that are ENERGY STAR certified.

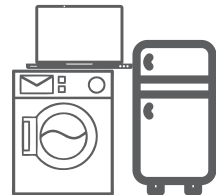


WHAT ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF ENERGY STAR® PRODUCTS?
