


Sustainable Southfield News and Updates

Sustainable Southfield - 2022 Employee Survey Results

The Southfield sustainability team would like to conclude the year with a reporting of some of the sustainability survey results from last year's employee survey. During October of 2022, the Southfield sustainability team launched a survey with the intent to understand the baseline knowledge of City employees, staff, appointed officials, and elected officials regarding sustainability and how they respond to various sustainability concepts impacting the City of Southfield.

The survey was completely confidential, and the questions were presented in different formats to allow for ranking of topics in addition to opportunities for opinions, suggestions, and feedback. We would like to thank all individuals who took the time to respond to the survey.



The general impressions that the survey responses generated can be summarized in the following statements:

- Sustainability **is important** for the future of our City, Region, State, and Country.
- More than half of respondents **value all three** pillars of sustainability: environmental, economic, and social.
- The City of Southfield **should develop** a Sustainability and Climate Action Plan.
