## I. Financial Report:

- FY 22/23 Budget Review (through 9/30/22); Treasurer Wood gave a brief overview of the budget through 9/30/22.

- Croad introduced a new proposed sculpture entitled "Monarch Butterfly: ES #1", which was approved on October 11, 2022, for funding by the Southfield City Centre Advisory Board in the amount of \$60,100.00. The sculpture will be installed in spring 2023 and will be located adjacent to the Southfield City Centre Trail at Eaton Corp. Croad is requesting matching funds from the Arts Commission in the amount up to \$10,000, for donor name and signage; Interpretive panel design; graphic panel printing and display frame; and landscape.

- Informational/Educational signage for the Boulder Garden at Carpenter Lake: The City received a Parks & Recreation Grant in the amount of \$600,000.00 for a picnic shelter, restrooms, new parking lot, etc. Mayor stated that the signage will cost approx. \$14,319.00 as designed by Cranbrook. He is hopeful that the grant can cover some of the cost. The Friends of Public Arts is donating \$2,000.00 towards the cost.
