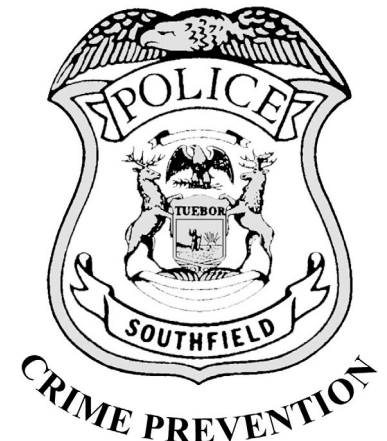
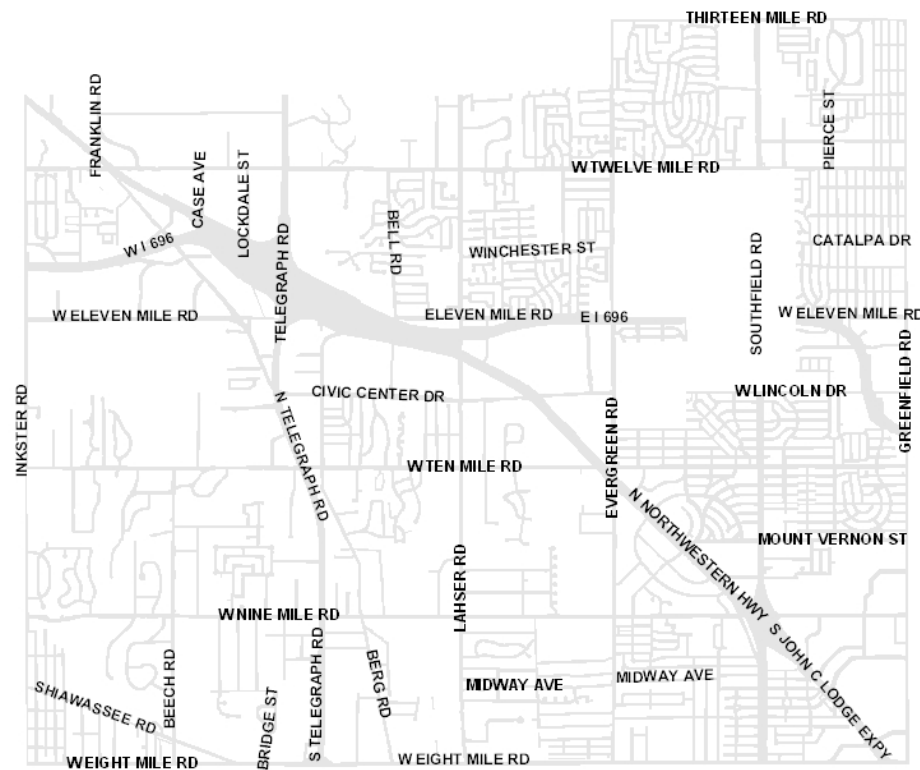

Eight Mile Rd. (Discount Store) on an alarm. Alarm company was monitoring the cameras and observed a male inside the store wearing a grey hoodie, dark pants, and shoes. Upon arrival officers observed a large window to the left of the main entrance door which was boarded up from a previous B&E. There was a freshly cut hole in the board. The hole was approx. 16 inches, and large enough for someone to fit through. Officers cleared the interior of the building, and no one was located inside. Store surveillance shows suspect approaching the store at 2:09am. He plugs in an extension cord and is seen using an angle grinder and cuts the hole in the plywood covering the window. At 2:18am the suspect climbs through the hole and enters the store. He brings in the angle grinder and plugs it in behind the cash register counter. He then makes a couple short attempts at cutting open the door to the safe. He is unsuccessful at opening the safe. He then grabs a plastic bag walks out from the counter and selects an unknown amount food. He puts them in the bag and exits the store by unlocking the front door at 2:21am. The suspect is last seen walking South towards Eight Mile Rd.</p> <p>Suspect Description: Unknown male average height, and thin build. He is wearing a dark mask covering his face. Grey hoodie</p>

			covering his head along with dark pants and shoes. He is also wearing gloves which are neon yellow.

On 04/27/2023, Officers were operating as a double unit around N/B M-10 near Evergreen Rd. Officers observed a Black Dodge Charger traveling at a high rate of speed coming from behind officers. The Charger drove past officers at a high rate of speed.

Officers drove N/B Northwestern to catch up to the vehicle. The vehicle slowed down in front of officers in the right lane N/B and revved its engine multiple times. The vehicle continued onto the exit (Lahser) and got off Northwestern onto the service drive. Officers followed the vehicle off the service drive. Officers drove next to the vehicle on the driver side. Officers made direct eye contact with the driver (later identified), Officers observed a younger B/M with a large black afro, scruffy facial hair, wearing a black and purple hoodie. When officers observed the vehicle, all windows were down. After Officers observed the occupants, they drove behind the vehicle and initiated a traffic stop, lights, and audible siren (fully marked patrol vehicle, push bumper, lights, and insignias). The vehicle sped up, changed to the left lane sped up again changing lanes to the center, going in and out of traffic. The vehicle drove through the red light at Northwestern Service Drive/Lahser. The vehicle continued N/B Lahser Rd from Northwestern Service Drive at a high rate of speed. Officers did not pursue the vehicle. Officers stopped at the red light.

Approximately 5 minutes later Southfield Dispatch notified officers a black sedan struck another vehicle at Northwestern Service Drive and Telegraph Rd. Dispatch advised the accident was possibly related to officers attempted traffic stop/flee and elude. Multiple citizens called

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but do not leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you do not have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you hear any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and

in stating a B/M driver, black afro, "black or purple hoodie" black pants, beige pants, left the scene of the accident.

Officers arrived in the area and observed the driver of the vehicle from the previous traffic stop/flee and elude. The male was holding a black and purple hoodie, large black afro, scruffy beard, black pants (mud on lower half of pants), beige shoes (covered in mud) and had debris in his hair. Officers exited their patrol vehicle and gave suspect commands to stop. Suspect stopped in front business in the 28000 Block of Telegraph Rd. in the Shopping Plaza. Suspect was taken into custody for Fleeing & Eluding & leaving the scene of an accident. It was later learned that the vehicle suspect was driving was a confirmed stolen vehicle. Additional charges for R&C Stolen Vehicle.

24000 Block of Pembroke Dr

On 04/25/2023 at approx. 11:55am, several Officers were dispatched to the 24000 Block of Pembroke for suspicious persons in the area pulling on car door handles. The suspect was described as a black male, wearing a blue hoodie and pink pants. Shortly after arriving in the area, officer advised that he observed a male matching the description at 10 Mile and Code St. A second officer arrived at the location and together they observed the male walking with his hands in his pockets.

Officers gave the suspect verbal commands to remove his hands from his pants, however, he refused to comply. Officers grabbed ahold of suspects arms and advised he was being detained while officers continued their investigation into whether any vehicles were broken into. When officers attempted to pat subject down for weapons he attempted to pull away and run from officers. Additional officers arrived on scene and officers were able to secure the subject in handcuffs.

During the actions with the suspect several credit cards and a drivers license not belonging to suspect fell from his pocket. These items were collected and preserved by a Southfield Police Evidence Technician. Officers went to a residence in the 25000 Block of Maplebrooke Dr and were able to verify ownership of several stolen debit/credit cards, a wallet, and an MI OPS from an attacked vehicle.

The suspect was taken into custody for LFA & Resisting & Obstructing. The suspect was a juvenile and was later turned over to his parents. The suspect is a Southfield resident.

Southfield Detectives forwarded the case to OCPO Juvenile Justice Division for complaint & warrant.

On 04/24/2023 at approx. 10:03am School Resource Officers (SRO's) were notified via school radio that there was a fight in the cafeteria at the school. SRO Officers responded and observed several students shouting and cursing as they were being detained by staff members. SRO Officers assisted faculty with restraining student as she attempted to break free to fight another student. This student continued to attempt to break away from faculty & SRO Officer. The student failed to comply with SRO Officers verbal commands to stop. The student was eventually taken into custody for Disorderly and R/O. The student was identified and transported to the Southfield Jail by responding patrol unit.

During this incident 2- other students were also taken into custody. An 18-year-old student was arrested for Disorderly Person /School Disturbance and transported to the Southfield Jail by patrol unit. A third student 17 years old was arrested for A/B and transported to the Southfield Juvenile holding area where she was processed by SRO Officers. The Oakland County Referee was contacted and notified of the arrest. The suspect's mother was also notified of the arrest. The suspect was successfully processed and was later turned over to her father.

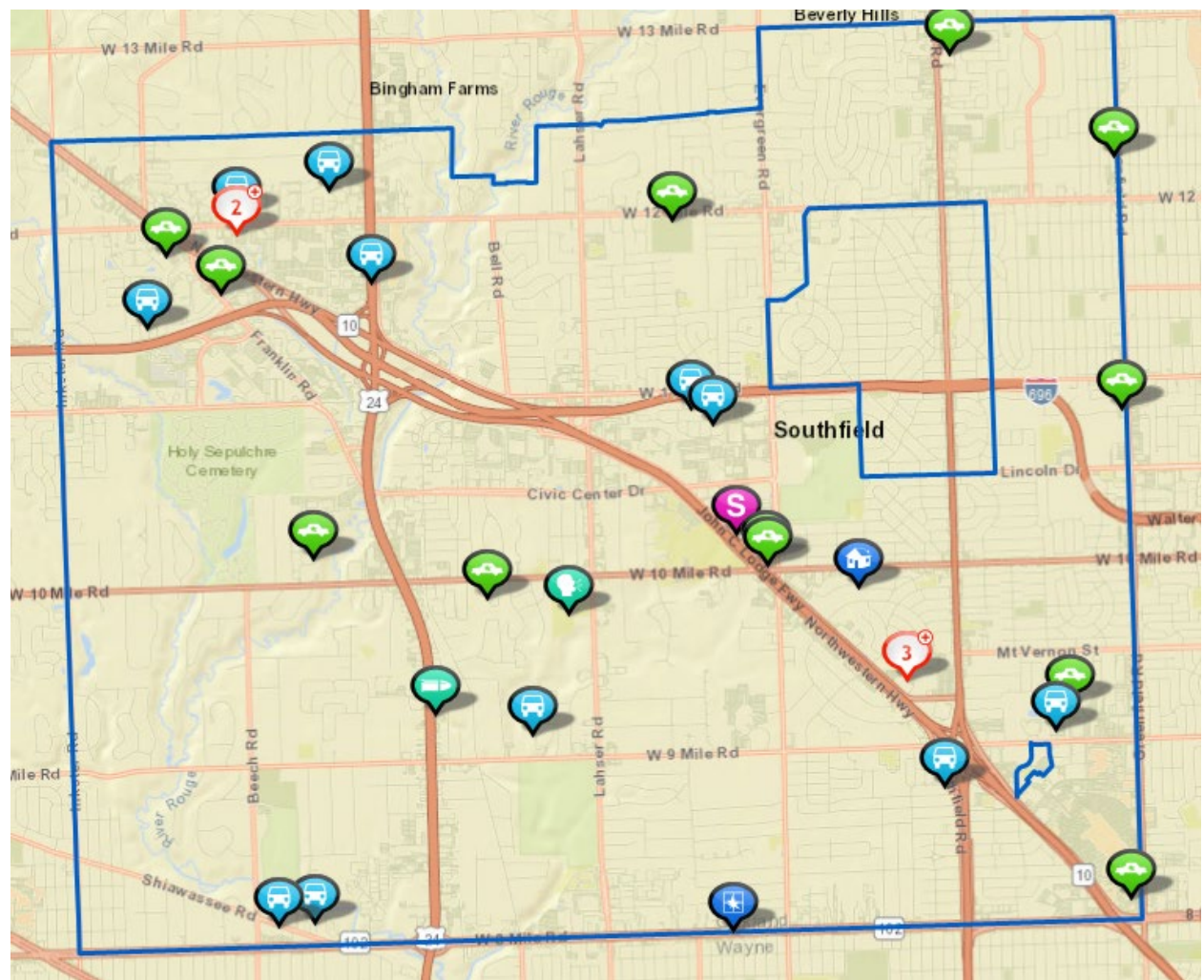

On 04/29/2023, at approx. 3:16am, Officers were dispatched to the area of Telegraph and Nine Mile for a domestic disturbance. Dispatch advised that the R/P's vehicle was struck by her husband, and he took her purse. The R/P was waiting for officers in a nearby parking lot inside her mother's vehicle. Officers located R/P and she stated that she is currently separated from her husband. They own a business together around 10-mile Rd & Telegraph Rd. R/P observed her husband following her. He pulled in front of her and slammed on his brakes. R/P slammed on her brakes and started to back up into a nearby parking lot. R/P's husband then backed his GMC Yukon and slammed into the front of her vehicle.








The husband then got out of his car walked back to R/P's car opened the passenger door and took R/P's purse. The husband then fled the scene. R/P called her husband and requested he bring her purse back. The husband returned & took the key for R/P's vehicle and said, "Now your stranded". Officer's located suspect driving in his GMC Yukon and conducted a traffic stop. Ultimately, the suspect was arrested for Domestic Violence and CCW. Officers located R/P's purse and the key to her car and they were returned to her.

During the inventory search of suspects vehicle Officers located a loaded handgun in suspects vehicle. The handgun was recovered and placed into evidence. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician took photos of the damages to both vehicles.

Suspect was processed and lodged at Southfield Jail. Southfield Detective submitted case to OCPO for review. He secured complaint and felony warrant for Assault with a Deadly Weapon.
