

## **Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles** How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- -If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. #### A.O.D. Fleeing & Eluding/ Armed Robbery/ Home Invasion **Car Jacking-4-Arrests**

Eight Mile Rd. & Evergreen Rd.

On 04/24/2022 at approx. 2:30pm Officer received information of a vehicle pursuit on 05/16/2022 10:05am near I-96 and Inkster Rd. Detroit Police Officers were in pursuit of a Silver Toyota Corolla which was wanted for an Armed Robbery and possible Home Invasion from earlier in the day. Detroit Police terminated the pursuit near I-96 and Middlebelt. Per Detroit, the suspect from the earlier Armed Robbery was wearing a white hoodie and armed with a silver handgun. Approx. fifteen minutes later, Southfield Officers spotted the silver Toyota Corolla traveling E/B on 8 Mile Rd near Inkster Rd. Officer was in an unmarked unit and was able to maintain a visual on the Toyota Corolla until Southfield marked patrol cars arrived to assist. Officer observed the driver of the Corolla to be a skinny black male wearing a white hoodie. (Similar to description given by DPD) While Officers were following the vehicle and upon entering the intersection of E/B Eight Mile and Evergreen the suspect vehicle hit another vehicle. The suspect vehicle was disabled and came to a stop on the median of E/B Eight Mile just east of Evergreen Rd. Several officers surrounded the vehicle as 2 black males and a black female crawled out of the rear passenger side of the vehicle. There was also a 4<sup>th</sup> person located in the vehicle. Officers approached the rear of the vehicle and removed the female away from the car.

Dispatch advised the Toyota Corolla was entered as a wanted Carjacking vehicle out of Detroit. The suspects were secured and DPD was notified that four suspects were in custody.

She was a 13-year-old female that was listed as a missing person.

All the suspects were identified and turned over to DPD.

Officers went to the first room and the door was opened by a subject holding a handgun in his left hand. Officers immediately gave the subject verbal commands to drop the gun. After a second command he put the gun down. After securing the subject Officers located several more subjects in a back room. They were asked to leave, and they complied. An inspection of the handgun recovered from subject revealed the Serial # had been removed. The suspect was taken into custody for being in possession of handgun with the serial# altered/removed. Investigation regarding CCW is on-going.
