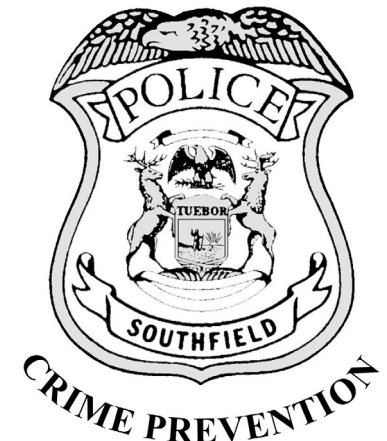
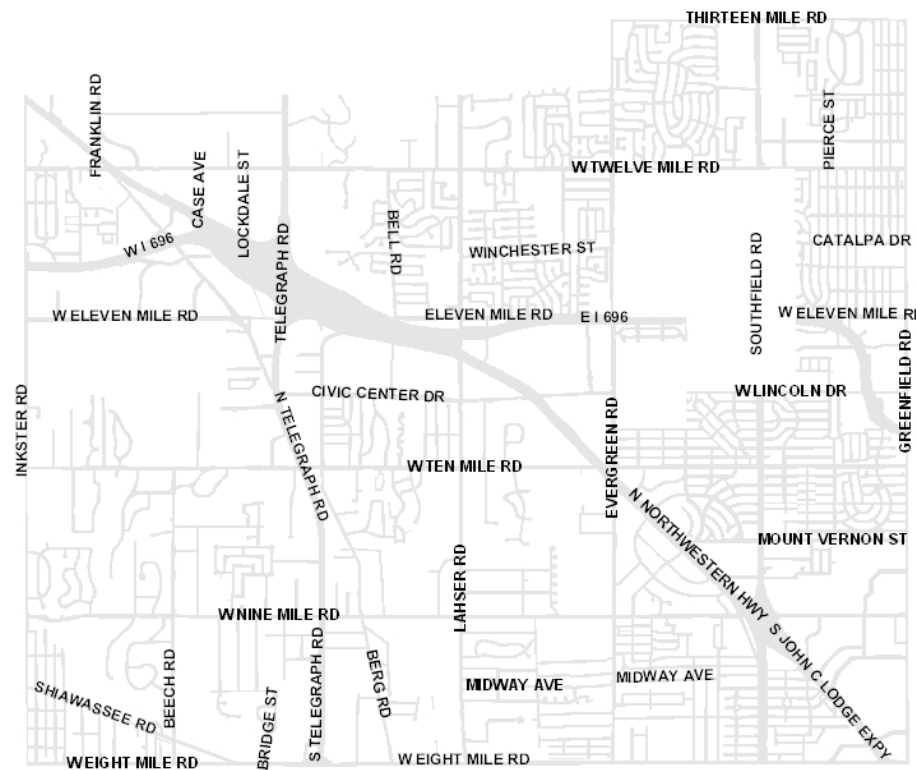

From: 04/03/2023 4:30pm To: 04/04/2023 9:30am	28000 Northwestern (Building under renovation)	Plywood was removed from window. Chain was cut on double doors.	R/P (Rep from construction company) advises when he arrived at the site, he noticed one of the plywood boards was on the ground inside the building. The plywood board was originally resting on the window but not secure. R/P noticed numerous amounts of copper wire had been cut or taken from the rubber covering which were all inside the building. One of the doors that was locked from the inside with a chain had been cut. The suspects then used a rolling cart from the building and pushed the cart towards the S/W part of the parking lot. R/P located the rolling cart pushed over near the rear fence line and noticed footprints on the other side of the fence. No suspect information.

R/P (Superintendent for Job site) states they have had an ongoing issue with unknown suspects breaking into the location, stealing copper wiring, and damaging things inside of the building. Entry was gained by removing a piece of plywood that was covering a broken window. The first incident occurred on the evening of 04/03/2023 into the morning of 04/04/2023. This second incident occurred on the evening of 04/04/2023 5:00pm into the morning of 04/05/2023 7:00am. Both incidents copper wiring and pipes were taken from the jobsite. There is no suspect information.

R/P advised that sometime between 04/07/2023 3:30pm- 04/10/2023 7:15am someone broke out an exterior window by the front entrance and entered the building. The building is currently under renovation. Nothing appeared to be stolen but a bundle of wires containing aluminum had been moved approx. 15 feet away from the entry point gained by the suspect(s). R/P believed the items were left behind only after the suspect(s) realized the wire contained in sheathing was aluminum and not copper. R/P advises this is the third incident in the past week that someone has broken into the building. The objective in all three incidents was to steal copper wire and piping. No suspect information.</p>

When he opened the door, he noticed damage to the deadbolt. Victim discovered that his apartment had been ransacked and several items including a TV/ Soundbar System, Laptop, iPad, Cartier Glasses, and jewelry are missing from his apartment. (Office Building)	Status S - Description Gucci Purse, cash, Credit Union Card & a Neckless.	<p>R/P stated that she and her sister were walking out of the multi office building, from the East main doors to her sister's white Buick Enclave SUV. Due to an ongoing heavy rainfall at the time of the incident, she was using the front side of her jacket to shield her head from the rain drops. As they were walking to their vehicle, she heard her sister scream loudly and observed an unknown B/M dressed in all black snatch her sister's purse while holding a gun in his hand. The suspect then fled to a white pickup truck with tinted windows. The truck may have had four doors. R/P described the truck as newer, with rounded features.</p> <p>The victim stated she and her sister were at a Jewelry Store prior to the incident getting some her jewelry cleaned. While walking out to her vehicle, an unknown male drove up behind her in a white pickup truck. The suspect got out of the truck and approached her. The suspect produced a handgun, pointed it at her, and snatched her purse off her. The suspect vehicle was a newer model White Dodge Ram P.U. Truck with tinted windows & chrome wheels.</p> <p>Investigation is on-going.</p>

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles
How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but do not leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you do not have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you hear any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and

On 04/06/2023 Officer was on routine patrol around Greenfield and Eleven Mile Rd. Officer observed a gray Jeep Grand Cherokee traveling WB on Eleven Mile from Greenfield Rd. A LEIN check on the vehicle returned as a wanted vehicle out of Garden City for Fleeing and Eluding from 04/04/2023. The vehicle pulled into a nearby Apartment Complex, pulled around back and parked. Officer activated his overhead lights and blocked the vehicle into the parking space.

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

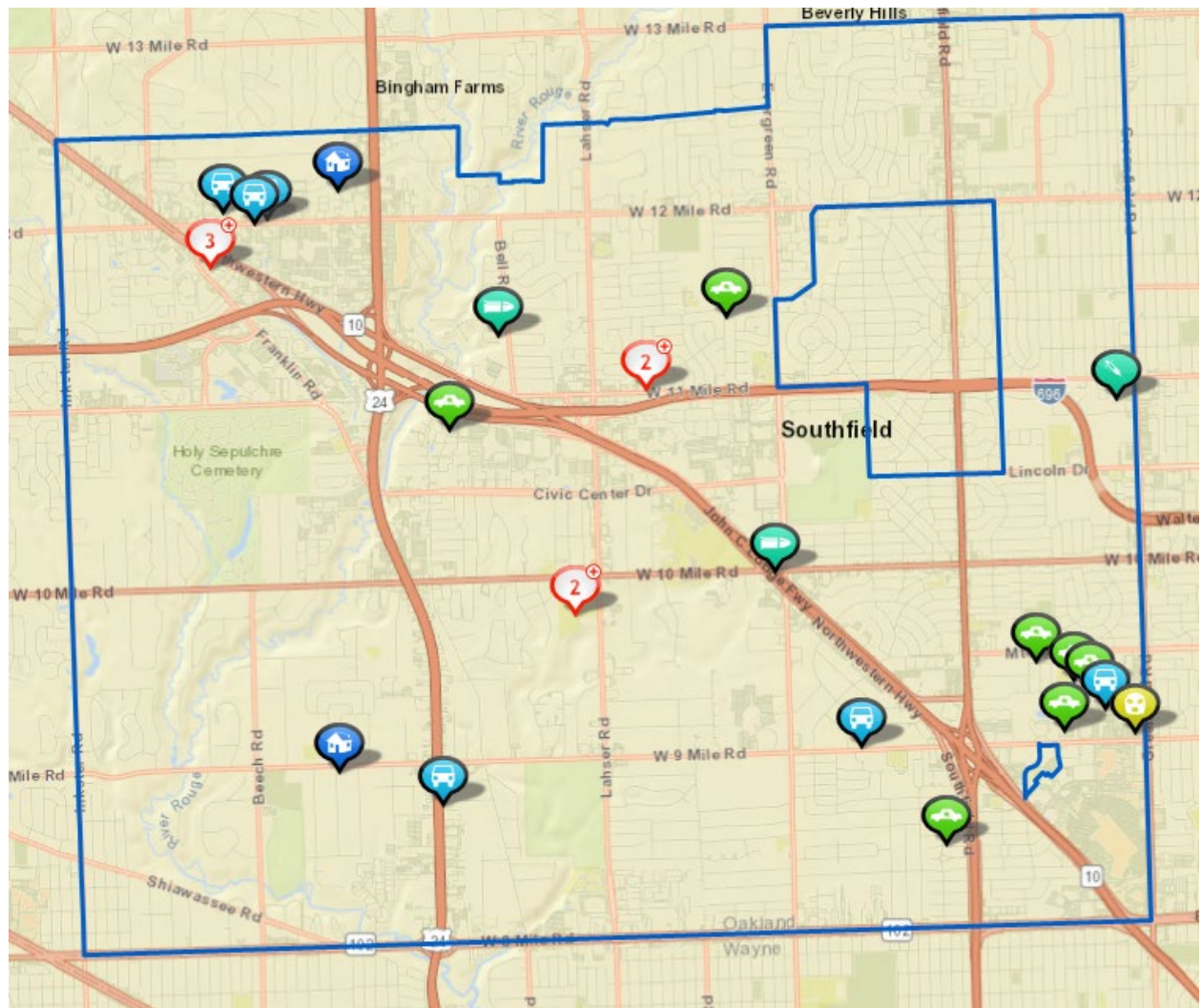
(High School)
