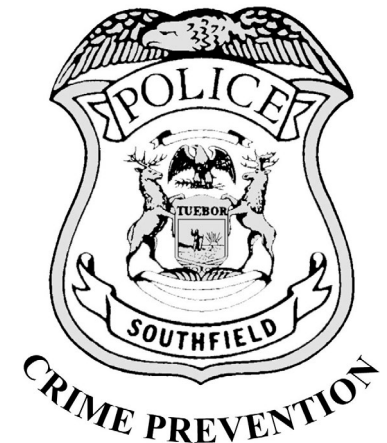
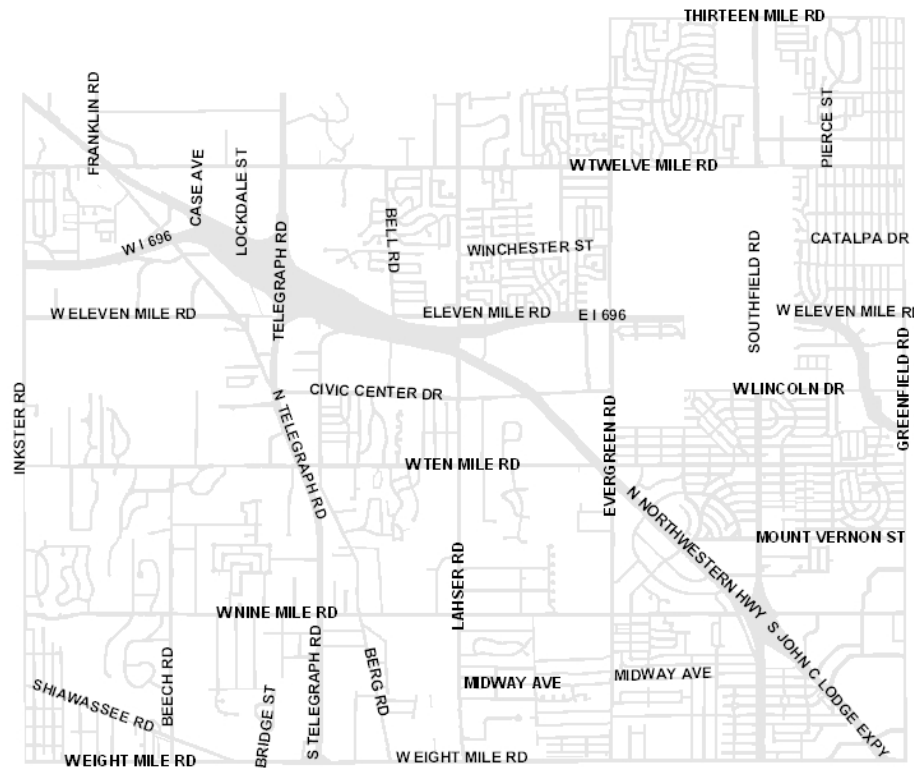

After they donated plasma, they stopped at a liquor store and came back to her apartment in Southfield via bus in the 25000 Block of W. Twelve Mile Rd. Victim stated after they hung out and got intimate, he left her apartment and began walking towards the front entrance. While walking through the complex he was approached by a black male, wearing all blue armed with a handgun. The male pointed the gun at him and demanded all his clothing and whatever he had in his pockets. Victim initially refused, and the male attempted to hit him with the gun. Victim then took his clothes off and handed the suspect his clothing, as well as his phone and cash he had in his pocket. The suspect fled the scene on foot in an unknown direction. Victim ran around the parking lot and approached a citizen who was sitting in their car and asked if they could call the police. Several Officers were dispatched to the 23000 Block of Telegraph Rd. (Hotel) on a possible overdose victim. A female was discovered unconscious and not breathing by a male friend. Narcan was administered with no positive effect. The female was pronounced deceased at the scene. There was a white powdery substance suspected as cocaine or heroin located on nightstand next to the bed. It was later Field Tested by a Southfield Police Evidence Technician. It tested positive for possible presence of cocaine. The Southfield Police Investigation Division was contacted, and Detectives were summoned to the scene. Investigation is on-going.

Special Attention: Fatal Accident

Telegraph Rd. / 12 Mile Rd.

Officers responded to a report of a crash (car vs semi). Franklin PD was out on scene, and it was uncertain whose jurisdiction it was. It was later determined that it was Southfield jurisdiction. The semi driver was on scene and was interviewed. The investigation revealed the car cut the semi off on the roadway attempting to get to the crossover. The driver of the semi was interviewed, and it doesn't appear that alcohol was involved. The driver of the car was deceased when officers arrived. The scene was processed by Southfield Police Accident Investigator and Evidence Technicians. Investigation is on-going.

Special Attention: Larceny of Steering Wheel & Airbag Systems from Chevy Malibu's:

Weapons Offense- 1- Arrest

On 08/28/2022 Officers were on routine patrol when they observed a 2016 Nissan Altima traveling N/B Lahser Rd. Officers initiated a traffic stop N/B Lahser, North of 12 Mile. During the traffic stop Southfield Police Dispatch advised Officers that the registered owner of the vehicle had a confirmed DWLS Southfield Warrant.

Officers contacted the driver (owner of vehicle) explained the reason for the stop and asked driver for her driver license registration, and if she had any weapons in the vehicle. The driver stated "no" to any weapons in the vehicle and she couldn't locate her driver's license.

The driver was taken into custody for the Southfield Warrant.

During the vehicle inventory search Officers located a handgun in the female's handbag. The handgun was unregistered, and the female did not have a CPL. She was also charged with CCW.

The Chevy Malibu's that are being attacked are mostly 2015- 2022 model years.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles
How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you are here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your

vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.
