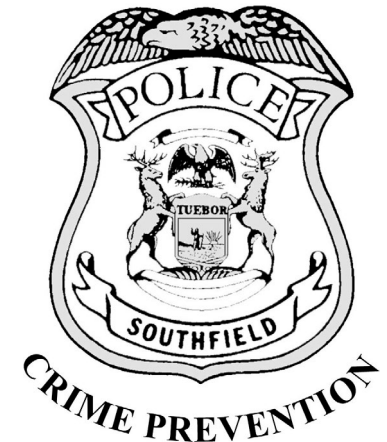
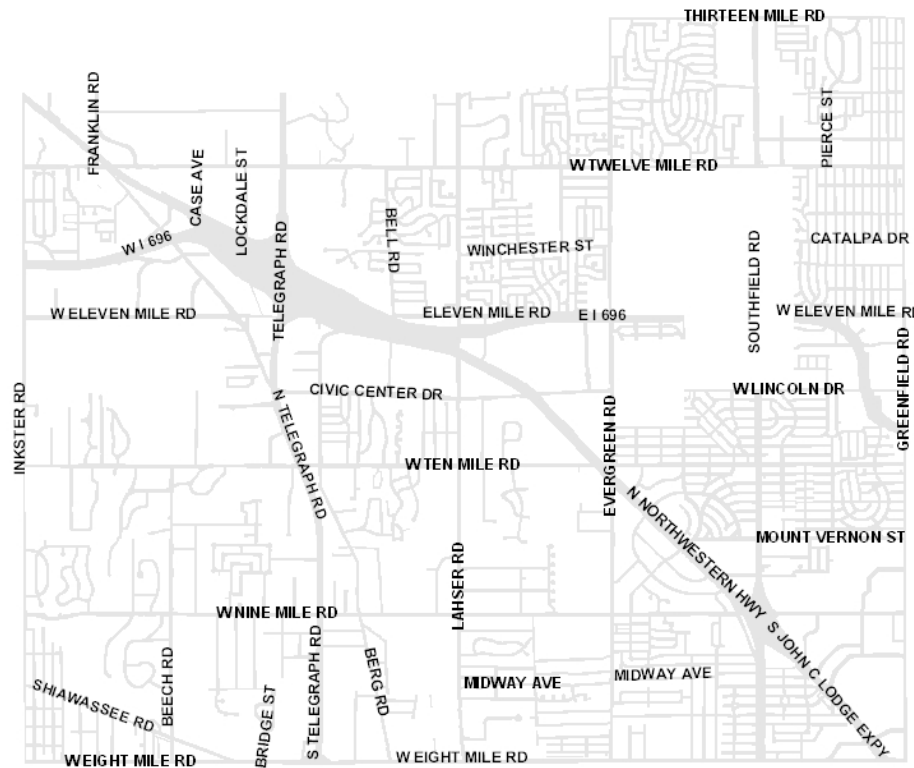

He stated he was power washing the floor in one of the bays when the suspect approached him. The suspect was armed with a handgun and demanded whatever R/P had in his pockets. Victim gave the suspect the cash he had in his pocket. Another employee heard the commotion and went to see what was going on. **Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles
How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

**Possession of Heroin/ DWLS / Retail Fraud 1st Degree-
2- Arrests**

29000 Block of Southfield Rd.

(Commercial- Home Goods)

On 08/29/2022 at approx. 3:15pm, Southfield Officers were sent on a Retail Fraud in progress in the 29000 Block of Southfield Rd. Officers had the suspect vehicle (Black Dodge Caravan) stopped at the intersection of Southfield Rd and California Rd.

Other Officers made the business and spoke with the loss prevention specialist. R/P advised suspect was observed taking merchandise and concealing under his clothing. After walking past all checkout lanes, he was stopped and questioned. Suspect pulled out all the concealed merchandise, threw it to the ground and fled to a Black Dodge Caravan. There was a second person driving the vehicle. After the vehicle was stopped both occupants were taken into custody. The driver was arrested for DWLS, and Possession of Heroin after Officers recovered suspected heroin in the driver's door panel of the vehicle. The passenger was identified as the suspect in the Retail Fraud, and he was taken into custody for Retail Fraud 1st Degree.

-If you are here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

**22000 Block of Greenfield Rd.
(Commercial- Discount Store)**

Officers were dispatched to the parking lot in the 22000 Block of Greenfield Rd. on a report of a subject armed. Dispatch advised there was a B/M wearing all black, with a black cap. Male was holding a black gun and waiving it around. Officers arrived on scene and searched the area; the subject was not located. Officers continued to search the area and went into business in the 22000 Block of Greenfield Rd. They located a subject matching the description given of the suspect. Officers observed a bulge in the waistband of the subject consistent with where a pistol would be located. Officers approached the subject and asked if he had a pistol on him, he replied "yes I do", he was then asked if he has a CPL he replied "yes". Officers secured the handgun from subject and continued their investigation. The subject was walked outside and identified. The subject was checked in LEIN and returned with no valid CPL. He was taken into custody for CCW. Officers also located a fraudulent CPL Card and a gold badge on the suspect.
