


Officer advised the vehicle was pulling into a parking space. The driver and passenger exited the vehicle and saw Officer. The driver was a B/M approx. 30 years old and the passenger appeared to be a B/M approx. 20 years old. Both occupants looked at Officer and immediately re-entered the stolen vehicle. The driver quickly accelerated out of the parking spot & struck Officers patrol vehicle. Officer attempted a PIT maneuver on the back, passenger side of the vehicle as it was driving over a curb to evade him. The 300 spun around in the snow before continuing to flee. The stolen vehicle turned E/B on 12 Mile Rd, disregarding the red traffic signal. The vehicle continued to flee until Officer was able perform another pit maneuver this time immobilizing the vehicle on the center median of Winchester St. just east of Lahser Rd. The passenger exited the vehicle and put his hands over his head and laid on the ground. Officer contacted the passenger and at the same time the driver exited the stolen vehicle and got

into Officers police vehicle. Officer quickly approached the suspect after he entered his patrol vehicle and attempted to open the door. The suspect had locked the doors. Officer got his window punch and broke the front window out and attempted to remove the suspect from his patrol vehicle. As Officer was reaching into the patrol vehicle attempting to remove the suspect, the suspect put the vehicle into drive and started to drive away dragging Officer until he was thrown to the ground causing injury. The suspect then fled the scene at a high rate of speed in Officers patrol vehicle. Another Officer observed the stolen police vehicle with its overhead lights and siren activated e/b on Winchester at a high rate of speed. Officer made deliberate contact with the police vehicle (Pit Maneuver) as it passed him causing the vehicle to spin out and become immobilized. Additional units arrived and attempted to get the suspect out of the stolen police vehicle. He made furtive movements that he may be armed and refused orders to show his hands and to exit the vehicle. At some point during the confrontation with suspect, Officers noted that the patrol rifle that was to be locked into Officers police vehicle was lying on front seat next to the suspect. The suspect had his hands concealed under his body.

Officers used the necessary force to affect the arrest. (It was later learned that after the patrol

vehicle was immobilized you could hear from the in-car video system the suspect hitting buttons until the patrol rifle came free from the locking mechanism) **Note:** Officer was transported to an area hospital via ambulance for treatment. Suspect was treated for facile burns on his face from the air bags being deployed. **Note:** Suspect is currently on probation out of Wayne County for two counts of receiving and concealing stolen motor vehicle and fleeing and eluding police. Suspect absconded from probation on 09/30/2019. During the Southfield incident, suspect was in possession of a stolen motor vehicle, struck police vehicles, fled and eluded police two times in two different vehicles, feloniously assaulted a police officer, stole a police vehicle, damaged police property, resisted and obstructed police multiple times, and was in possession of a firearm upon his final arrest. Suspect was also driving on a suspended driver license. Southfield Detectives forwarded this case to The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office for review and Complaint & Warrants.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- -If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Southfield Officers were dispatched to business in the 28000 Block of Telegraph Rd. on 02/19/2022 regarding a Retail Fraud that had occurred. Officers were given information that the suspect vehicle was a Gray Jeep Renegade and the license plate was also given to Officers. The vehicle was described to have two occupants inside, one being the driver and the other individual to be in the back seat. The driver was a B/F with long braids, a blue coat, leggings, and black boots. Officer located the suspect vehicle, Jeep Renegade traveling, S/B M-10 near Southfield Fwy. and conducted a traffic stop on it.

The driver of the vehicle was taken into custody for Retail Fraud. The stolen merchandise was recovered and returned to the store. Officer conducted an inventory search of the vehicle and located an 8" Dagger and a handgun in the vehicle. The handgun registers to suspect but she doesn't have a valid CPL.

Note: There was a 5- year old child in the car that was in a booster chair (Non- approved car seat) and was in the car alone while suspect was in the store shop lifting.

Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.
