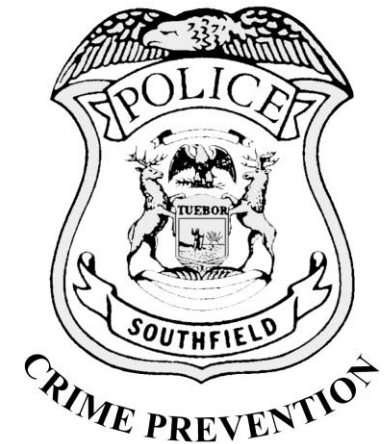
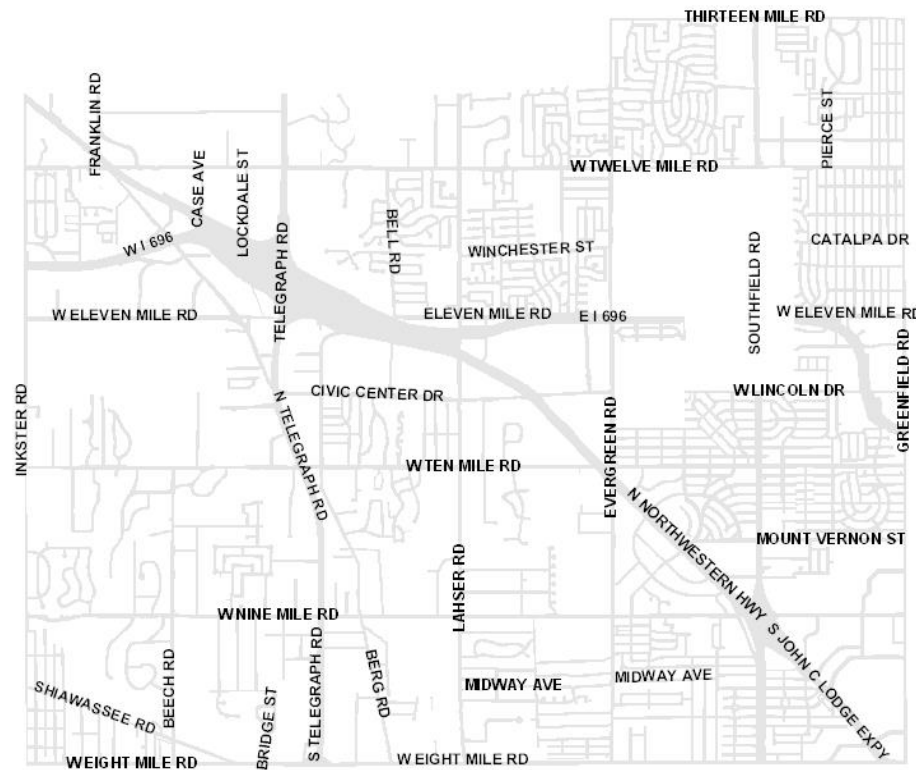

03/03/2022 2:06am	21000 Virginia St.	Front door was kicked in.	On 03/03/2022 Officers responded to a Home Invasion just occurred. The R/P stated his ex-girlfriend kicked in the door, assaulted him and then fled on foot in an unknown direction. Upon arrival Officers were advised by the victim that the suspect fled out of the front door. A K-9 track was initiated with negative results. The front door had damage that was consistent with forced entry. There was also broken glass on the bedroom floor that was from suspect attempting to break the ceiling fan. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene. The suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.

<p>From: 03/03/2022 8:30am To: 03/03/2022 4:00pm</p>	<p>15000 Harden Cir.</p>	<p>Entry through unlocked door wall.</p>	<p>Victim was gone from the residence on 03/03/2022 from 8:30am- 4:00pm. When she returned home she noticed the light was on in her bedroom. Investigating further victim discovered her top dresser drawer opened, the nights stand drawer opened, and a jewelry box drawer dumped out on top of the dresser. After discovering someone was in the house, she left immediately. She did not see anyone. It was later discovered that the rear sliding patio door wall was left unlocked. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and collected evidence. No suspect information.</p>
<p>03/03/2022 10:05pm</p>	<p>26000 W Twelve Mile Rd (Apartments)</p>	<p>No signs of forced entry.</p>	<p>Victim states she left her apartment in the 26000 Block of W. Twelve Mile Rd. at 10:03am on 03/03/2022. Victim she returned to her apartment at approx. 1:45am on 03/04/2022 she discovered that someone had forced open her door by unknown means and ransacked the interior of her apartment. No suspect information.</p>

<p>03/03/2022 4:30pm</p>	<p>21000 Indian St. (Church)</p>	<p>Entry through an unlocked north door.</p>	<p>On 03/03/2022 at 11:09pm Officers were dispatched to the 21000 Block of Indian reference a break in that occurred at 4:30pm. (Church) Officers met with the R/P who stated he had video evidence of a break in and walked officers to a door on the north side of the building. He stated four young white females arrived on church property and three of them entered the church through the north door. There was no damage to the door. Security video shows three of the girls opening the door and walking inside the church at 4:30pm. They did not damage the door. The girls left at approx. 4:50pm and got into a Black Lincoln MKX. It doesn't appear that there was any forced entry into the church and nothing was disturbed or taken from inside the church.</p>

<p>03/04/2022 9:35pm</p>	<p>21000 Indian St. (Church)</p>	<p>Entered through an unsecured door.</p>	<p>On 03/04/2022 at 9:50pm, Officers were dispatched to the 21000 Block of Indian regarding B&E at Church. R/P advised he arrived at the church at approx. 9:35pm and observed car lights on in the n/e parking lot and believed people were inside. He walked up to the front glass doors and banged on them yelling at the unknown individuals to leave the property. R/P observed the suspect vehicle take off on Indian and began following it. He described the car as a Yellow Dodge Challenger.</p> <p>Surveillance video shows a group of four individuals (one white female and three white males, all young) could be seen leaving through a singular open door on the n/e corner of the church. They fled in a light-colored sedan. Nothing appeared to be disturbed inside the church.</p>

<p>03/04/2022 3:54pm</p>	<p>21000 Indian St. (Church)</p>	<p>Entry through double doors on n/e side of building.</p>	<p>On 03/04/2022 at 9:50am Officers were dispatched to the 21000 Block of Indian reference B&E of Church. Officers met with the R/P who showed them video of incident.</p> <p>At 3:54pm a Black Jeep Trail hawk was seen driving onto the property and parked in the northeast parking lot. There were five occupants in the car, four young white females and one young white male (driver). One of the females looked like one of the suspects from previous incident at the same church.</p> <p>The suspects begin walking towards a set of double doors on the northeast side of the building before the video ends. The cameras begin detecting movement again a couple minutes later showing the group all leaving the church.</p> <p>Note: Three separate incidents were reported at this location. Nothing was disturbed or taken in any of the incidents.</p>

<p>From: 03/04/2022 8:30pm To: 03/05/2022 7:48am</p>	<p>19000 Dorset St</p>	<p>Attempt on door inside the garage leading into the house. There are several pry marks on the door.</p>	<p>Incident is Domestic Related. Female R/P states she broke up with her ex-boyfriend approx. 6 months ago. He moved out and took his belongings with him. When he returned on 03/04/2022 R/P wouldn't let him into the house. He stated that he needed to get some things and when R/P refused to let him in he threatened to kill her.</p> <p>The ex-boyfriend went over to R/P's fathers house and contacted R/P's father.</p> <p>R/P's father agreed to get the ex-boyfriends things for him. When he got to R/P's house and was entering the house the ex-boyfriend forced his way past R/P's father and ran into the basement. He was looking for something, didn't find it and ran out of the house. He got into a White Charger and left prior to Officers arrival. R/P advises her ex-boyfriend did not have permission to enter her house. The suspect has been identified and investigation is on-going.</p>

Dispatch advised two vehicles, a Black Jeep Grand Cherokee and a Silver Chevrolet Malibu, had been broken into. A handgun was taken from the Black Jeep. The driver's side rear window was broken out on the Silver Chevy Malibu. The vehicle was ransacked but doesn't appear anything was taken. The incidents occurred between 03/04/2022 6:00pm and the following morning at 9:03am. No suspect information.</p>

Attempt Only.	<p>Several Southfield Officers responded to an Attempted Armed Robbery at Bank in the 28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy.</p> <p>Upon arrival and interviewing the witness teller she describes the lone suspect as a B/M dark complexion, slim build wearing all black clothing. The lone suspect reportedly approached the teller window and presented a folded note hand printed in black ink with writing indicating it was a Robbery.</p> <p>The letter was presented by the suspect & his coat was opened showing a handle of a handgun secured in his front waistband.</p> <p>The teller advised the suspect that she was just opening and didn't have the amount of money that the suspect was requesting. The suspect reportedly calmly walked out of the bank without any money. Nothing was disturbed or taken in any of the incidents. Appears they are entering through unlocked or unsecured doors to the building. Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles
How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Domestic Assault/ Strangulation- 1- Arrest

21000 Block of McClung Ave.

Officers were dispatched to the 21000 Block of McClung regarding a Domestic Assault in progress. The caller stated her ex-boyfriend body slammed her and choked her.

Officers arrived on scene and conducted their investigation.

Investigation revealed that both subjects were engaged in a verbal argument that escalated to both parties grabbing onto each other. The female half stated that her ex-boyfriend grabbed her around the throat and choked her two different times. At one point, he picked her up and slammed her on the garage floor. The female had redness around her neck area supporting her statement. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician took photos of victim's injuries.

The male was taken into custody for Domestic Assault/ Strangulation. He was transported to the Southfield Jail, processed and lodged.

Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Domestic Assault- 1- Arrest

**26000 Block of American Dr.
(Hotel)**

On 03/04/2022 at 6:39pm, Officers were dispatched to the 26000 Block of American Drive (Hotel) regarding a Domestic Assault. Dispatch advised Officers that a B/M subject in a dark blue hoodie was observed assaulting a female in the hotel lobby. Officers arrived at the hotel and located the male & female at the front entrance to the hotel. The two were separated and interviewed. The female was crying and had an obvious injury to her face. She denied any assault by the male. Officers interviewed employees at the hotel and Guests that witnessed incident. Witnesses stated that the male subject knocked the female into a garbage can, dragged her by her hair and slammed her face into the vestibule glass. The male was taken into custody for Domestic Assault.
