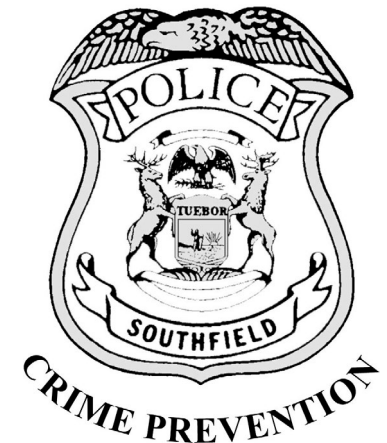
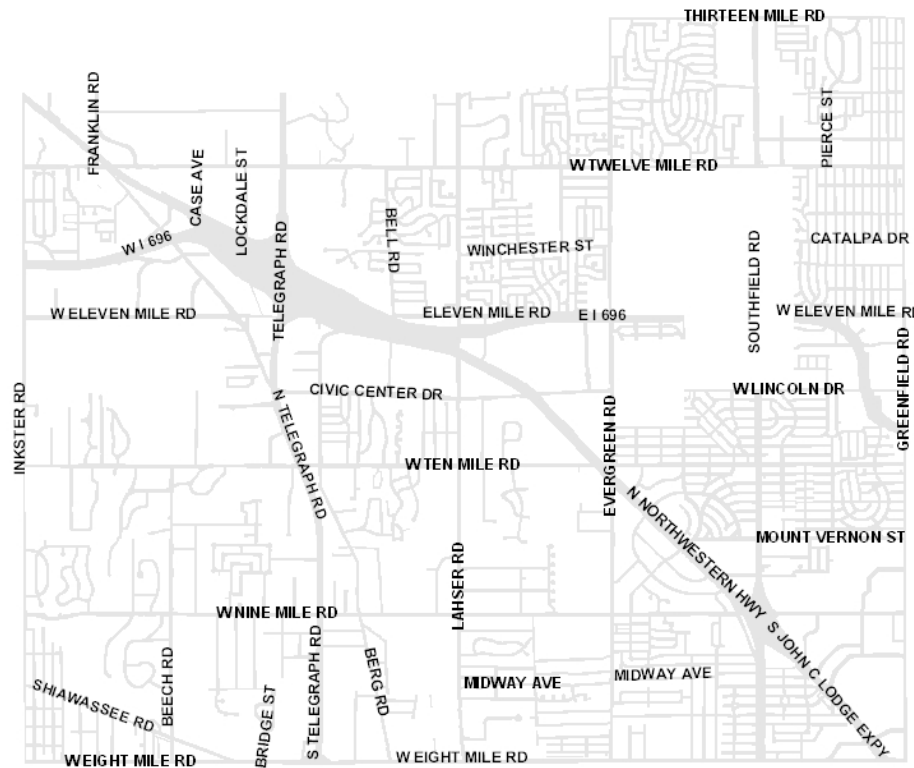

Further review of surveillance video revealed that the suspect vehicle was a Black SUV with the right rear taillight out.</p>

R/P advised she was alerted by a parent there was a white male with a grey T-shirt who appeared to be covered in dirt who opened the gate on the east side of the building and was attempting to pry open one of the back doors to the building. R/P stated she peeked out one of the back doors to the building and saw the male matching the description attempting to enter one of the back doors with a screwdriver. R/P asked what he was doing. out of his car. The suspect stated something about not wanting to go back to jail then fled on foot towards the Condo Complex. The B/M suspect was wearing blue jeans and a black Adidas t-shirt with white stripes. A witness at the accident scene advised that he could identify the B/F suspect driver if she was located. The male suspect wasn't located but Officers through their investigation efforts were able to come up with a possible suspect. A photo show was conducted with witness (victim) that suspect attempted to steal his truck. The suspect was positively identified as the person that attempted to steal witnesses Ford F-150 and is most likely the male that fled from the fleeing vehicle. Investigation is on-going.

**19000 Block of W Ten Mile Rd.**

Officers were dispatched to the 19000 Block of W. Ten Mile Road for a report of a male in the area who previously broke into the business. Officers were advised by Southfield Dispatch that the R/P has camera footage of the male throwing a rock through the front door of the business. Officers arrived on scene and met with the owner of the business. He provided officers with camera footage of the suspect when the initial report for the break in was made. The owner pointed out to Officers that the male suspect who broke into his business was sitting in the parking lot at the business next door. Officers observed a subject sitting in the parking area and contacted the male. The subject denied causing any damage to the business or being in the business. A Southfield Officer that had viewed the surveillance footage of suspect arrived on scene and positively identified subject as the suspect who was seen on camera breaking into the business. The subject was taken into custody for B&E and transported to Southfield Jail without incident. He was processed and lodged.
