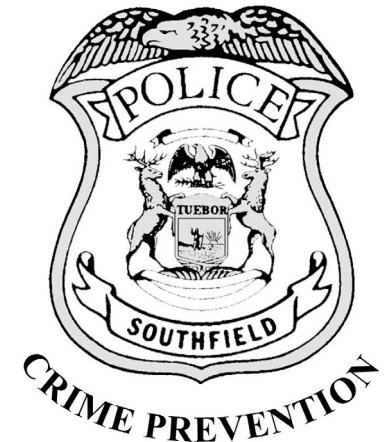
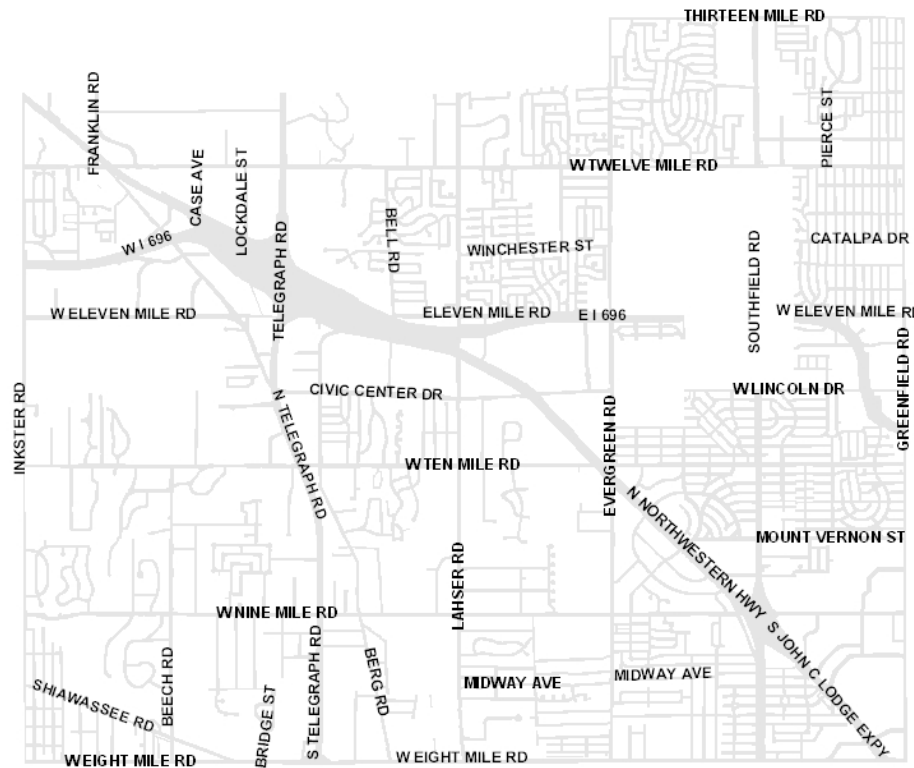

(Liquor Store)	Front windowpane adjacent to the front door was smashed out with an axe.	<p>On 06/21/2022, Officers were dispatched to business, (Liquor Store) located in the 24000 Block of W Ten Mile Rd. with the report of a B&E alarm at 5:08 am. Upon officers' arrival at approx. 5:12am, the front windowpane directly to the left of the main door was smashed out, and a large axe was laying on the sidewalk just outside the broken window with a large pile of window glass. Officers cleared the store and found no one inside the store. The owner of the store arrived on scene and advised some high-end liquor and cigarettes are missing from the store. Surveillance video shows one suspect approach the store from the back at approx. 5:04am. This subject is carrying an axe in his hands. The subject breaks the window glass and makes entry into the business. The subject jumps the countertop, and rifles through all the empty cash drawers looking for money. The subject took some liquor & Cigarettes, before fleeing the store at 5:06am.</p> <p>SUSPECT DESCRIPTION: Black Male, 5'10"-6'-0", thin build, aged between 40-50, wearing: black button-down shirt, gray sweater, black pants, gray cap over a black bandana covering the face, black latex gloves, and black and white Nike gym shoes.</p>

06/22/2022 9:21pm	28000 Aberdeen St.	Unlocked front door.	On 06/22/2022, Officers responded to the area of Twelve Mile Rd. and Southfield Rd. for a Home Invasion that had just occurred. Upon arrival, Officer located two white male subjects matching the description given by the R/P near Twelve Mile Rd. and Fairfax St. The two subjects were detained while Officers investigated further. Investigation revealed that the two subjects entered the residence through an unlocked front door. After entering the residence subjects broke out several windows in the residence and damaged several things inside the residence. One of the subjects made admissions to braking out the windows with a shovel. Both subjects are juveniles and were taken into custody. Their parents were contacted and came into the station to pick them up after Officers were done processing them.

He was wearing a hoodie with the hood down, pants, and had on a balaclava type head cover. The male opens the door to victim's car, goes into the driver side of the vehicle for a few moments, then comes back out and shuts the door. He tried the door handle of the other vehicle parked in the driveway which was locked. He then walked away down the driveway out into the street.</p>

25000 Telegraph Rd**(Commercial Donut Shop)**

Officers were dispatched to the 25000 Block of Telegraph Road for a welfare check. R/P (brother) reported that his sister texted her boyfriend around 6:30am requesting help and about a man with a gun at donut shop near her school. Further investigation revealed that the sister never showed up to school. Officers contacted the missing female's boyfriend. He was able to track his sister's vehicle to a street in Toledo, Ohio. While Officers were still investigating the boyfriend received a phone call from Ohio area code which he answered. A mail carrier from Toledo Ohio advised that he was with the female (sister), and she told him she was kidnaped at gunpoint from location in Southfield and forced to drive to Ohio where the suspect stole her vehicle and cellphone. Police from that jurisdiction are in contact with Southfield Police and incident is under further investigation. The female was not injured in this incident.

29000 Block of Southfield Rd

(Commercial Business)

R/P (employee) states suspect was pacing back in forth in front of the business and pulling on the doors prior to the store opening. R/P advised the suspect that he would have to wait until the store opened. When R/P did open the store, the subject brushed by her and stated he wanted to return several items. The items were used, and R/P advised she couldn't return them. The subject got very upset and started to create a scene. A decision was made to allow the return to deescalate the situation. After R/P completed the return, the suspect became very nice and wanted to buy some more product. Some of the product was the same as what he returned. During the time R/P was showing suspect items he deliberately rubbed up against her and touched her buttocks several times. R/P didn't say anything to subject but moved away from him. Suspect was described as a as a W/M, early 30's, clean cut, shorter hair, blue or green short sleeved shirt, and khaki pants. Investigation is on-going.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

How to prevent this from happening to you!

- Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- If you are here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.
