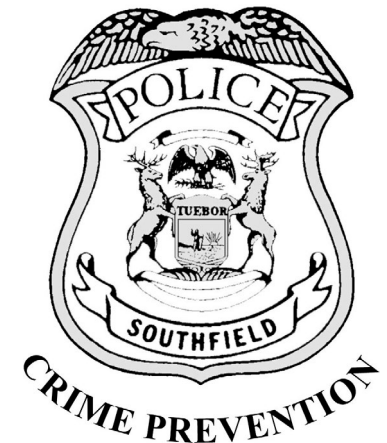
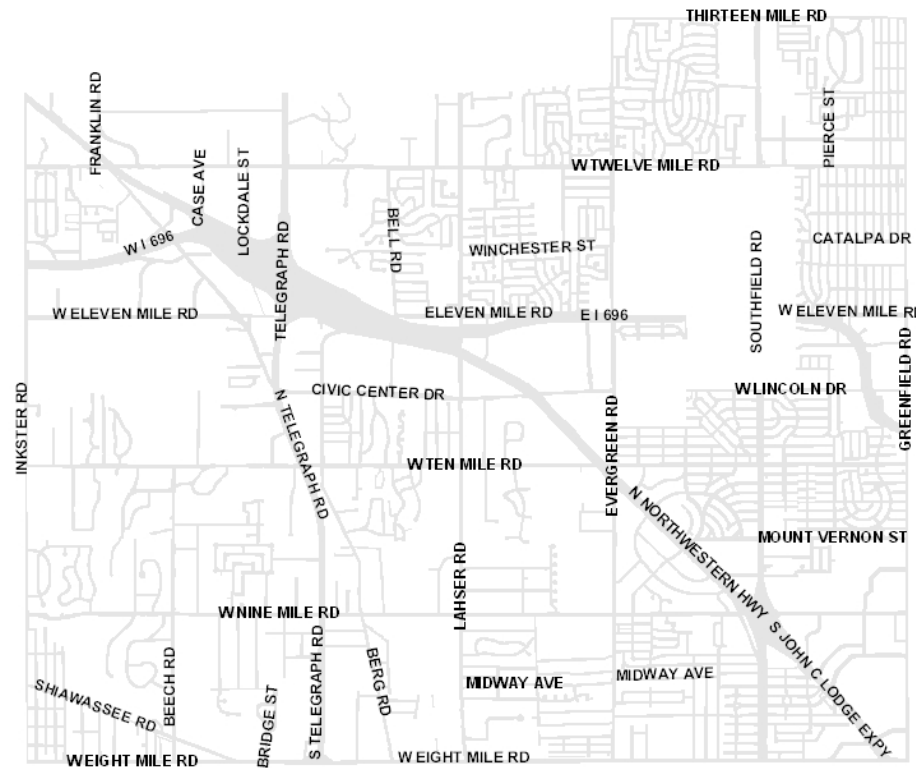

Description: Misc. assorted bills from register were taken</p>	<p>On 07/01/2022 at approx. 9:06pm Southfield Officers were dispatched to the 29000 Block of Greenfield Rd. (Fast Food Business) for a possible Robbery in progress. Dispatched stated three unknown males were carrying crowbars and hammers as they exited the business through the drive through window. Officers arrived on scene and the business appeared to be closed. Officers made entry through the open drive through window on the north side to check the interior for suspects. Nobody was located inside. Witness advised he observed three subjects exiting the drive-thru window carrying crowbars and hammers. He stated they were all wearing dark clothing and had some sort of face coverings. One of the males was possibly wearing a black shirt or sweatshirt with a white Adidas logo on it. Manager advised that an undisclosed amount of cash was taken from two cash registers. During the investigation the witness advised that the suspects may be at another fast-food business on Greenfield Rd. in Oak Park. Oak Park PD was on scene at the business, and they assisted our Officers in identifying two subjects. The subjects were released pending further investigation.</p>

R/P advises several of their business vehicles are parked at this location daily. Sometime on 06/26/2022 through the night into the next morning at 11:24am someone cut off the catalytic converters from five (5) of their business vehicles. There have been previous incidents as well.

**21000 Block of W Eight Mile Rd.**

Officer was on routine patrol when he attempted to make a traffic stop on a 2001 Chrysler Town & Country. The vehicle failed to stop and fled behind a business in the 21000 Block of Eight Mile Rd. Officer lost sight of the vehicle as it pulled behind a large amount of industrial material and wooden pallets in the rear of the business. Officer requested additional units and positioned his vehicle where he could watch for the vehicle should it attempt to exit the back parking area. The vehicle eventually reappeared and drove towards the exit. The lone driver of the vehicle exited the vehicle and put his hands into the air. He failed to comply to instructions to get on the ground. The driver started to go back towards his vehicle and was warned he would be tased if he entered back into his vehicle. Additional Officers arrived on scene and the subject was taken into custody. Officers located a loaded handgun and magazine that suspect discarded when he pulled behind the industrial material & pallets. The driver later made admissions that the gun belonged to his girlfriend. She was not present.

The driver did not have a CPL & he was a convicted Felon. The driver was taken into custody for CCW & NOLOP. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and collected evidence.



**Possession of Cocaine- 1- arrest**

**16000 Block of North Park Dr.  
(North Park Place Apartments)**

Officers were dispatched to the 16000 Block of North Park Dr. for a noise complaint. Caller could hear very loud music coming from the apartment. Officers arrived on scene and confirmed that there was very loud music coming from a specific Apartment. Officers knocked on the apartment door several times and eventually a male subject answered the door. The male subject stood behind the door, he was completely nude and had a handgun in his right hand pointed at the ground. Officers ordered subject to put the handgun down. Officers observed the subject place the handgun down near the front closet. Officers made entry into the apartment, secured the handgun, and made it safe. The subject was intoxicated but cooperative. He gave Officers permission to enter the apartment. When officers entered the apartment there were two females, on a sofa in the living room. Further investigation by Officers discovered that the male that answered the door was a felon in possession of a firearm and cocaine was located on top of the dresser in his bedroom. The male subject made admissions that he bought the cocaine in Detroit earlier in the day to give to the two girls that were in his apartment. The male subject was taken into custody for Possession of Cocaine and Felon in Possession of a Handgun.

Officer was on routine patrol when he came across a Black 2018 Nissan Altima bearing Michigan License Plate. The vehicle was listed as a felony vehicle for flee and elude with the driver possibly armed with a gun. With assistance from other Officers, they conducted a felony stop on the vehicle near 12 Mile & Telegraph Rd. The driver was secured and patted down for weapons. The driver could not produce a valid driver's license. During the pat down Officers located a plastic baggie with unknown pill in it. The pill was identified as a prescription drug. **(Apartment Complex)**

Officers were dispatched to the 26000 Block of Berg Rd. (Apartments) for a reported intimidation threat. The R/P stated his ex-boyfriend was in the apartment complex making threats towards him. R/P stated the subject is known to carry a handgun and is a drug user. The suspect was described as a light complected black male and is bald.

Officers arrived at the area and located subject staggering along the roadway and appeared to be intoxicated. Officers contacted the subject and confirmed that he was the subject that the R/P called about. During Officers investigation they recovered a crack pipe and suspected crack cocaine.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field tested a sample of the suspected substance. The result was positive for possible presence of cocaine. The subject was taken into custody for Possession of Cocaine.
