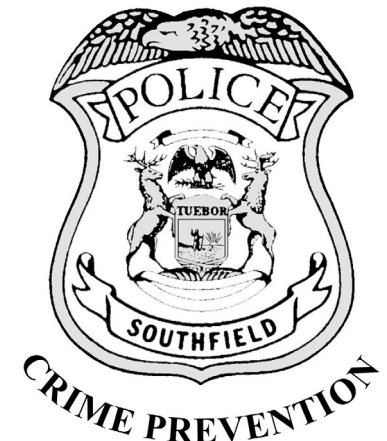
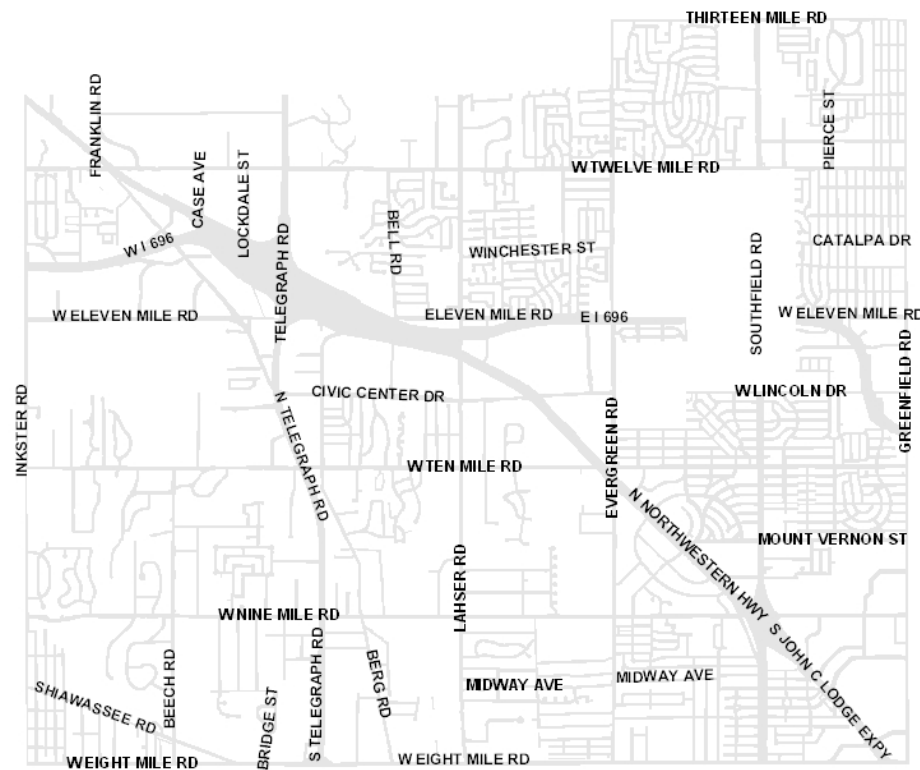

06/09/2023 12:21am	16000 North Park Dr. (Apartments)	Storage Unit was unlocked.	<p>On 06/09/2023, Officer was dispatched to 16000 Block of North Park Drive (Apartment Complex). R/P reports that his Storage Unit was just broken into. R/P advises he and his wife were in the process of moving in. They had left their storage unit which is approx. 30 feet down the hall from their Apartment Unit unlocked while they were moving items between there storage unit and their apartment. At some point during the process, R/P heard some noises from inside the storage unit and noted that the light was on. He opened the door and observed an unknown subject sitting in the storage unit. The suspect was described as: black male (Carmel comp.), 5'9"-6'0", thin build, last seen wearing dark green hoodie, black/gray shorts, and "Black Ugg Boots".</p> <p>The suspect told R/P that he had been kicked out by his parents and needed a place to stay. R/P went back to his apartment and as he was walking into his unit, the suspect exited the storage unit and ran around the corner. He believes the suspect fled down the trash chute. R/P advised they checked the storage unit and determined that the only thing missing was his wife's pair of size 10 Ugg boots, black in color. The suspect left a pair of shoes and a bottle of Aquafina water in the storage unit. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician took photographs and collected the items left behind by the suspect.</p>

			<p>Officers were in the area searching for the suspect, when they observed a subject matching the description. The suspect took off running away from them between Apartment Buildings in the 16000 Block of North Park Dr. SPD Drone was utilized but the suspect was not located.</p>

(Multi Office Building) for a B&E investigation. The R/P (Building Manager) advises she located damage to the door of one of the suites. The damage to the door was consistent with forced entry. The door was split from the doorknob latch to the top of the door. There was debris on the hallway outside of the door as well as inside the suite. The victim who leases the suite stated she left the suite on 06/10/2023 2:00pm. The property manager located damage to the door and victim returned to her suite on 06/11/2023 at 2:00pm. There was no damage inside the suite, and nothing appeared to be disturbed. A nearby business may have video surveillance. Investigation is on-going. No suspect information. Note: There was also attempted entry into the Building Managers suite.

06/05/2023 5:38am	25000 Saint James (Condo Complex)	Roll up garage door was left open. Door from garage into the residence was unlocked.	R/P stated he and his girlfriend reside at Condo in the 25000 Block of St. James (Condo Complex) together and are in the process of moving. R/P arrived home late that evening and had possibly left the garage door open all night. While he and his girlfriend got ready for work in the morning, R/P heard what sounded like the door that connected the garage and home was opening (lower level, at the bottom of the steps). R/P went to check and as he rounded the corner, he saw the door cracked open. He observed a B/M with a black compression mask, & a black hoodie or hat on, and one foot in the entry way. R/P yelled at the male and the male took off. It is unknown which direction the male ran. R/P went into the garage to check if anything was taken. R/P believes that his Black and Yellow Dwelt screw gun was taken from the garage.

Suspect looked into and pulled on several windows.	<p>Victim came into the front desk to report Home Invasion at his residence in the 18000 Block of Melrose. Victim states on 06/05/2023 at 12:12am, a tall white male wearing light colors, a hoodie and a fisherman hat attempted to open the windows around her home. Victim was not home at the time of the incident but has video evidence of the event. No damage to the residence is evident.</p> <p>Victim sent her home video surveillance footage of the incident to Southfield Detectives who reviewed video. The night-mode (B&W) video shows a male (either light skinned black male or a white male), slim build wearing a light-colored hoodie and a light-colored fisherman style hat. The male can only be seen from behind but has a unique logo on the back of his hoodie with a "Shield Type" of shape.</p> <p>The male walked around the house looking into and pulling on windows and then leaves in an unknown direction. It is not known if the male left on foot or in a vehicle. Anyone with any information regarding this incident is advised to contact The Southfield Police Detective Bureau at 248-796-5540.</p>

Victim states that her husband came to her apartment and damaged several items. R/P advises that she is married but separated from her husband. His name is still on the lease, but he does not stay at the apartment. He only visits occasionally with R/P's permission to see their children. Earlier in the day R/P's husband came to the apartment and there was a verbal domestic because her husband and R/P's sister do not get along. During that incident R/P's husband took R/P's keys to her apartment and the apartment building. During the second incident R/P's husband came back while R/P and her sister were not home. It is believed that he entered R/P's apartment using the keys he took from her earlier in the day. When R/P and her sister got home they discovered the suspect had knocked R/P's sisters' belongings down from a shelf in the bedroom closet and had cut (damaged) several of her sneakers. Officers observed numerous sneakers, approximately 10 in various colors, on the bedroom floor with slices in the material. All the damaged shoes belonged to R/P's sister. R/P advises that her husband does not live there, and he did not have permission to enter the apartment. Investigation is on-going.</p>

How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but do not leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you do not have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you hear any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals do not like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it is difficult to see them.

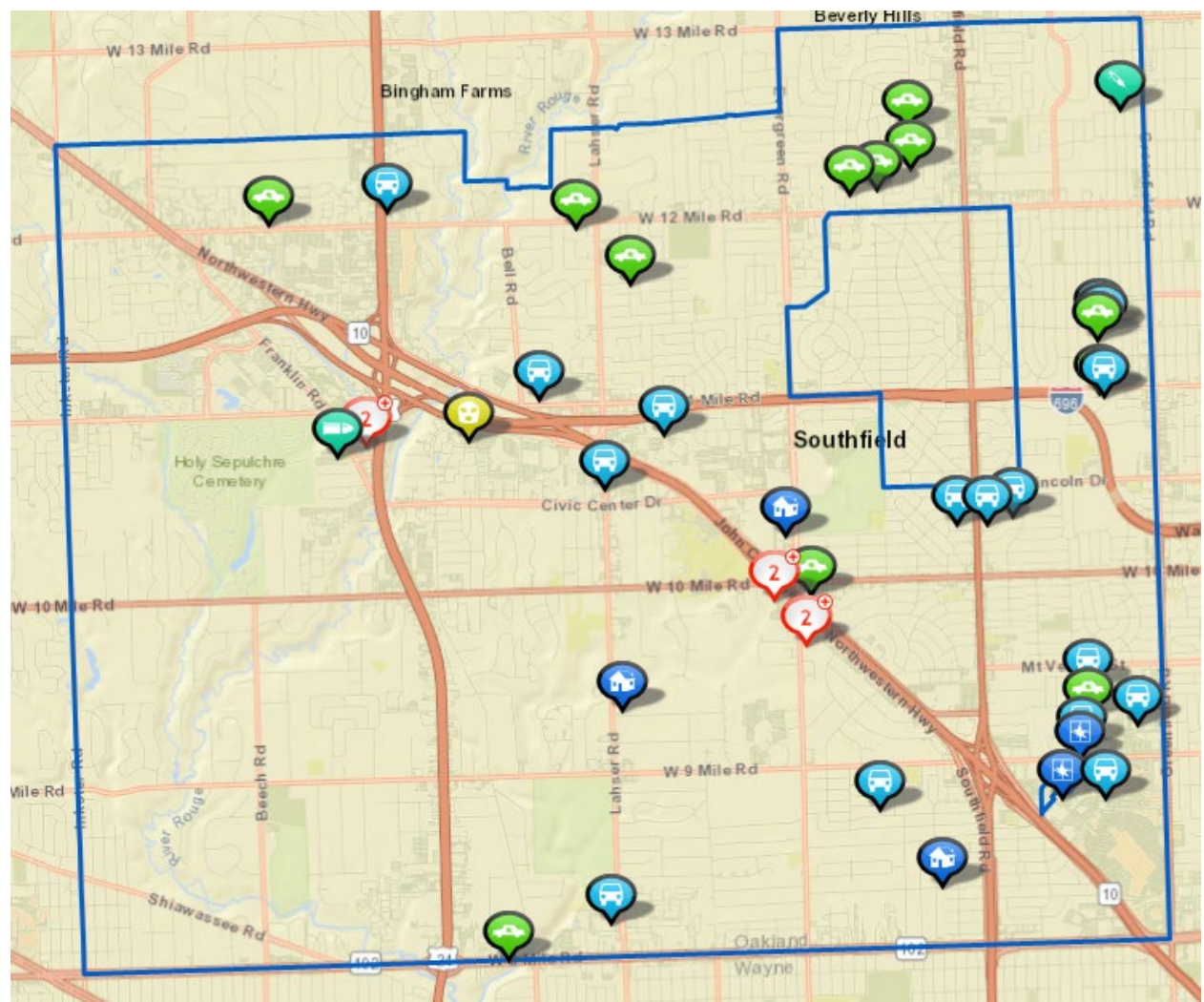
Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.
