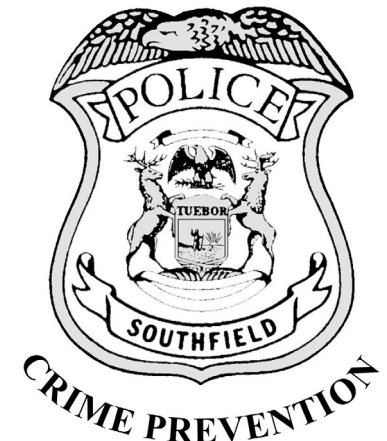
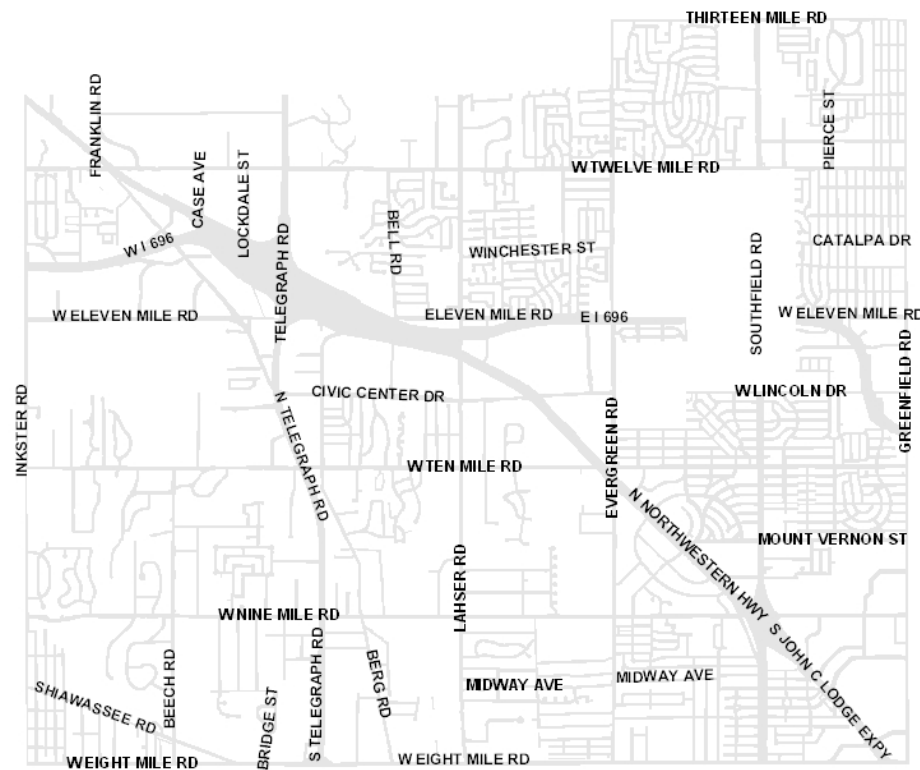

## Commercial Burglaries:

Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
03/22/2023 2:48am	28000 Franklin Rd. (Vacant Building)	The front entry way under the vestibule had broken boards where the unknown suspects entered.	<p>On 3/22/2023 Officers went to the 28000 Block of Franklin Rd. to investigate Breaking and Entering of an unoccupied building. (Old Abandoned Hotel)</p> <p>R/P observed four juveniles enter the location with bats. Upon arrival officers heard loud banging emanating from the interior of the hotel's second floor. Officers then observed a glass window on the second floor of the building being broken out. Officers observed a W/M, wearing a gray hoodie, with blonde hair, throw miscellaneous objects from the interior of the hotel out of the broken window. Officers entered the hotel and subjects inside the room made visual contact with officers. Officers in full uniform loudly announced, "Southfield Police! Come outside with your hands up!" The subjects ignored officers' orders and retreated to the interior of the hotel.</p> <p>Additional officers arrived on scene and assumed roles on the perimeter of the hotel.</p> <p>A K-9 was requested to assist, and Madison Heights K-9 responded to the scene. During the search, officers visually located and called out to four subjects on the top floor of the hotel atrium and directed them to come down to the lower level of the hotel; the subjects refused. Madison Heights K-9 Officer advised the subjects officers would be coming to their location and that they may be bitten by a police K-9.</p> <p>As officers began closing in on the subjects' location, the subjects fleeing down a stairwell and were met by</p>

			<p>officers from the fifth-floor stairwell. Officers ordered all four subjects to place their hands against the wall for safety until officers could take them into custody. One subject who had previously been observed throwing items from the second story window was taken into custody for MDOP &amp; breaking and entering without permission. During the subsequent search of subject officers located brass knuckles with a folding blade in his front right hoodie pocket. (CCW)</p> <p>This subject began to berate officers and made threatening statements towards the officers.</p> <p>The subject was escorted down the stairwell and continued to vocalize his displeasure while shouting, obscenities at Officers and telling officers to shoot me. As officers neared the second floor and while still in the stairwell, subject attempted to pull away from Officers and attempted to strike an Officer. Officers used the necessary force to control the suspect.</p> <p>While this was happening one of the other suspects told the suspect resisting officers to calm down and obey officers' directions. The suspect soon thereafter calmed down and apologized to officers for his behavior. The three other suspects were taken into custody for B&amp;E of a Vacant Building. Two of the suspects were juveniles and processed as such and were later turned over to their parents.</p>

The Sportage had a black bag covering the rear driver side window. The Sportage is seen parking next to victims Optima and the driver of the Sportage exited his vehicle. At 3:20pm the driver of the Sportage gets back into the Sportage and drives off, going south on Providence Dr. It is unknown how many people were in the Sportage. Inspection of the attacked vehicle revealed that the rear drivers side window was broken out and the steering column was damaged with wiring hanging down.</p> <p>Attempt only.</p> <p><b>Note: (Related Recovered Stolen)</b></p> <p>A possible related suspect vehicle was located by Southfield Units in a nearby Apartment Complex. 03/26/2023 4:38pm	24000 Link Rd.	Status S - Stolen/Etc. Description Cash, Keys & Driver's License were taken.	<p>Victim advised Officers that he was on Telegraph when he rear-ended a silver vehicle. R/P states the passenger in his vehicle kept telling him to continue driving and not to stop for the accident. R/P decided to flee the scene of the accident and the vehicle he hit began to chase him. They ended up in the alleyway in the 24000 Block of Link Rd. which was a dead end. R/P got out of his vehicle and tried to give the Driver/Suspect #1, his insurance information. Suspect #1 and his passengers, Suspect #2 and #3 began to jump him. All 3 suspects punched him and stomped him. Officers asked R/P where his friend went, and he said his friend did not help and left him there. He did not know much about the friend. R/P stated the suspects would not take his insurance and instead, took his keys, cash from his wallet, and his driver's license.</p> <p>The female suspect told victim to give them cash or they were going to send people to his address. R/P is unsure which suspect took his keys and his cash from him. R/P states the keys taken were 1</p>

			<p>house key and 1 car key belonging to his vehicle. Victim described <b>Suspect #1</b> as a B/M, 5'7, 30-35 years old, medium build, with short black hair, minimal facial hair, wearing a white shirt.</p> <p><b>Suspect #2</b> is a B/M, late 20s, unknown height, thin build, possible short goatee, wearing a black bedazzled hoodie. <b>Suspect #3</b> is a B/F, 5'7, 35-40 years old, heavy set, black hair styled in a bun, wearing a black bedazzled hoodie. There were no cameras in the area where the incident occurred.</p>
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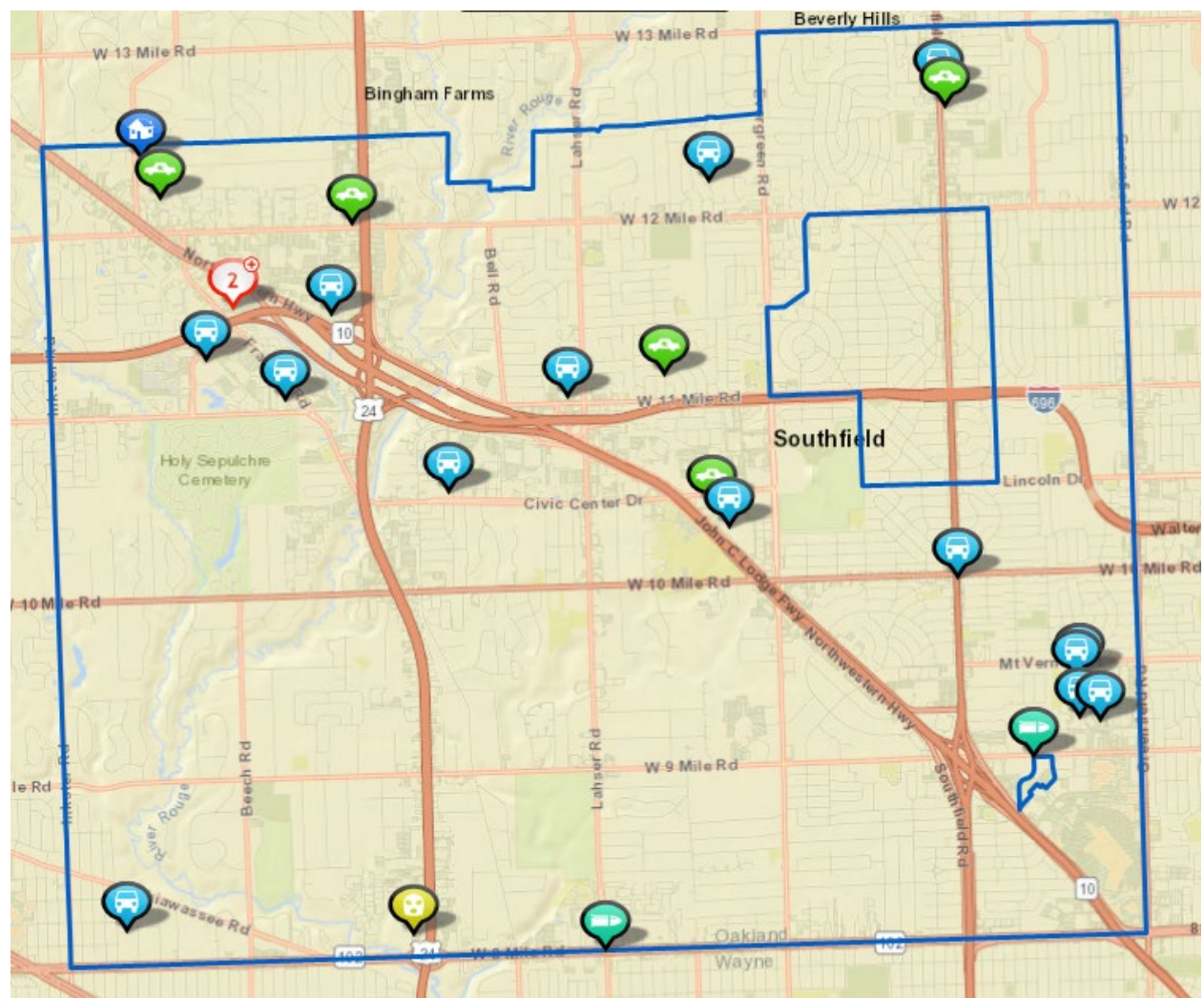

Be on the Look Out Highlights:	Arrests by SPD Officers:
<p><b>Special Attention: Traffic Complaint/ Felony Assault with a Firearm</b> 03/20/2023 2:56pm <b>Lahser Rd. &amp; W Eight Mile Rd.</b></p> <p>Victim advises on March 20, 2023, around 2:56pm he was traveling S/B on Lahser just S of W Ten Mile, in the City of Southfield, when he noticed a Blue/Purple Ford Fusion driving aggressively behind him. At one point, the vehicle pulled alongside his vehicle and the driver yelled obscenities and made gestures before speeding in front of him and slamming on her brakes. When other vehicles attempted to go around the suspects' vehicle, the female driver "sped up" to keep them from passing. Just North of W Nine Mile, the Ford Fusion stopped, and a heavy-set light comp. B/F exited her vehicle "with a gun in hand motioning in a threatening manner". Victim was able to get around the vehicle safely and called 911. Victim reports that as he was on the phone, the female driver followed him and jumped in front of his vehicle again. Victim was advised that officers were dispatched to the area for an area check. The suspect was not located at the time of report. Investigation is on-going.</p>	<p><b>CCW/ F/A/ DWLS- 1- Arrest</b> 03/21/2023 10:17pm <b>W Nine Mile Rd. &amp; Rutland Ave.</b></p> <p>Victim was driving her 2022 Black Chevy Blazer e/b on Nine Mile Rd approaching Greenfield Rd when she noticed an older Chevrolet Impala on her passenger side with a black female yelling something to her. Victim rolled her passenger side window down to see what the other driver wanted, and the driver of the Impala yelled obscenities and pointed a handgun at her. Victim hit her brakes and called 911. Victim stated as she drove past Providence Hospital on Nine Mile Rd. (with the Impala now behind her), she heard what sounded like a gun shot. Victim (still providing information to dispatch) followed the Impala s/b on Greenfield Rd. and then onto JL Hudson Dr where Officers were able to make a traffic stop on the Impala.</p> <p>Note: When Officers attempted to stop the suspect vehicle, the driver attempted to flee. Officers had to make intentional contact with the suspect vehicle at very slow speeds (5 mph) to prevent a chase. After the vehicle was stopped, the driver was observed making furtive movements and was ordered to put her hands up so Officers could see them. The driver eventually complied and was searched and secured while officers completed their investigation. The driver was discovered to be wearing a bullet resistant vest. The driver was asked if she had a handgun and she stated no. Officers were given permission by the driver to search the vehicle. While searching the Impala Officers located a magazine sitting on the passenger side front seat floorboard, near the shifter. The magazine was empty. Continuing to search the vehicle officers located a handgun on the floorboard pushed under the front passenger seat on the back side. The handgun had no magazine</p>

in the well and was chambered with one round. Officers also located two live rounds on the floorboard of the front passenger seat. Officers searching the roadway where victim thought she heard a gunshot located a spent shell casing on 9 Mile Rd near Foster Winter Dr. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician arrived and observed the shell casing in the E/B lane of traffic, near Foster Winter. The shell casing was the same make as those found in the suspect's vehicle. It was collected and preserved as evidence.

**Note:** The victim's vehicle had one flat tire and there was evidence that something had gone through the sidewall of the tire. Officers took the wheel & tire off victims' vehicle and took it and had it broke down. There was evidence that a spent bullet had gone through the sidewall of the tire hit the wheel on the inside and dented the wheel. Fragments of the spent round were recovered inside the tire. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician took photos and collected items as evidence. The suspect was taken into custody for F/A, CCW, & DWLS.
