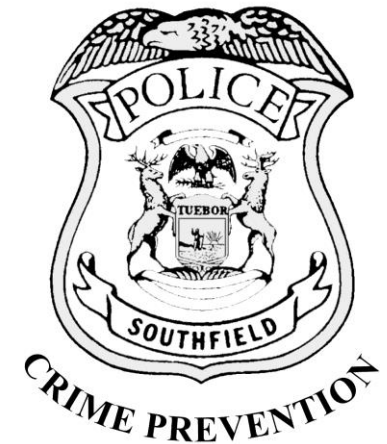
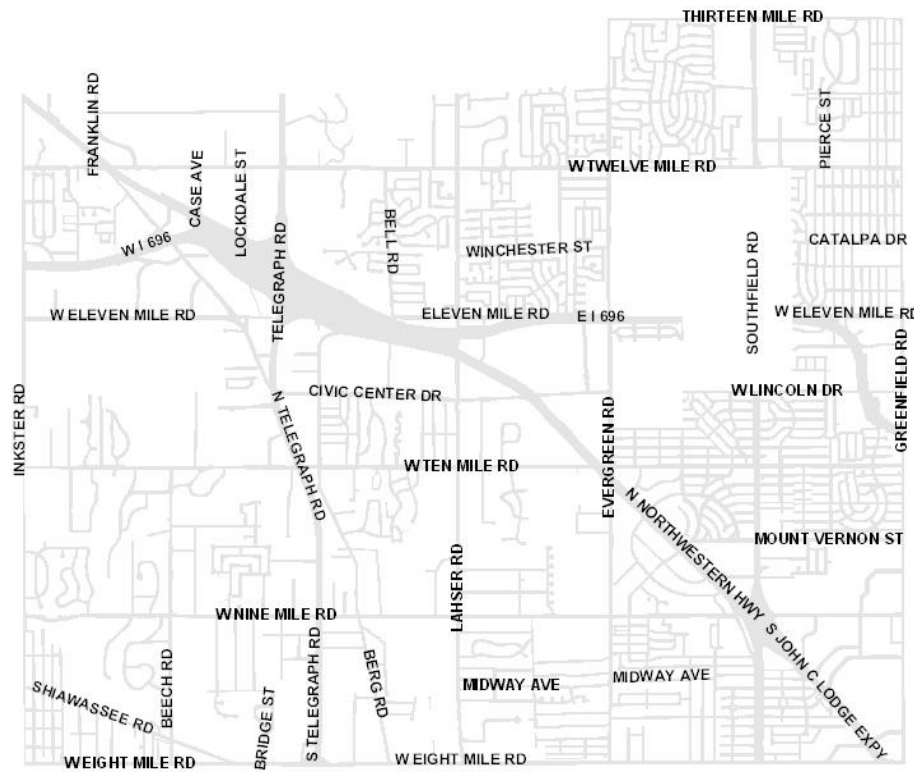

Victim advised he resides out of state and was visiting family in Michigan. On 03/27/2022 at 9:00pm he arrived in the 24000 Block of W. Nine Mile Rd. (Fast Food Business) in his Red Dodge Challenger (Georgia Plate). Victim exited the vehicle and was sitting on the curb nearby his vehicle using his phone. Three unknown B/M's approached victim with handguns, demanding he give them the keys to his vehicle. Victim complied and turned over the keys. The three B/M's entered the Dodge Challenger and left in an unknown direction. Victim later came into the station to report incident.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> During this investigation the R/P reported there were several firearms in the vehicle when it was taken. The R/P had no paperwork for any of the firearms and the one firearm he had the serial# for didn't belong to him. The vehicle was entered as stolen.</p>

Cash was taken from victim.

Victim (valet at business) advises that three patrons from the bar, two males and one female came out of the bar and requested that they be taken to their car, and it be turned over to them. After getting their vehicle, the subjects returned and were upset about how their vehicle was parked and because the front seat had been moved from its original position. One of the males requested an undisclosed amount of cash from the valet and then pinned him up against a vehicle and assaulted him. He then took the valet cell phone and threw it across the parking lot damaging it. While he was pinned up against the vehicle the female suspect reached into the valet pocket and took his cash. The suspects fled in a 2021 White Jeep Grand Cherokee. Investigation is on-going.

## **Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**

### **How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Several Southfield Officers and Detectives responded to location and met with R/P who stated he called police after hearing gun shots and saw that a female friend that he had been staying with the past few days had been shot. The R/P stated that the female was a family friend, but they were not related.

After the scene was secured by Officers, paramedics arrived and pronounced the female deceased.

Further investigation by Officers led to the arrest of the male subject for Homicide & Felony Firearm. A handgun was recovered from the scene and is believed to be the weapon used in the incident.

Investigation is on-going.
