


(Car Dealership) for a report of a B&E & UDAA. Dispatch advised 5 unknown males wearing dark colored clothing and masks were seen taking a Silver Pickup Truck & White SUV, turning left from the parking lot, and leaving the scene.  Officers arrived on scene and the suspects were gone prior to officers' arrival.  Investigation revealed that the metal security gate, which protects vehicles located in the parking lot east of the building, appeared to have been rammed by a vehicle and had significant damage. A large portion of the gate had fallen on top of a nearby vehicle. It appeared the suspects had rammed the gate from the inside of the parking lot as they were leaving. Once inside the east parking lot, Officers located a white Chrysler Pacifica, which was running with the headlights on, but was unoccupied. Officers did not observe any damage to this vehicle.  Officers located point of entry into business through a broken-out glass panel on garage door on the north side of the building. Inside the business it appears that the suspects went through several drawers.

	Further investigation revealed that two vehicles
	had been stolen from the business property.
	Both vehicles belonged to the dealership. The
	vehicles were trade ins and were still registered in
	the old owner's name.

your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals do not like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it is difficult to see them.

# Distribute or Promote Child Sexually Abusive Material/ Use of Computers to Commit Certain Crimes

(Front Desk Report)

On 05/16/2023 Southfield Detectives were advised by Southfield Dispatch that an individual contacted them about alleged dissemination of child sexually abusive material. The R/P was contacted by Detectives. R/P advises he was messaging an unknown male on a dating application. While on the site the unknown male suspect asked R/P if he is into child porn". R/P advised the suspect that he was not interested in child pornography but asked the suspect if he was. The suspect responded with, "I'm into everything" and sent sexually explicit video to R/P.

Detectives working with Federal Task Force developed a suspect, obtained a search warrant, and went to the suspects residence and the search was executed. The suspect was located, and he was taken into custody for Distribute or Promote Child Sexually Abusive Material and Use of Computers to Commit Certain Crimes.

On 05/15/2023 at 12:20am Officers were dispatched to the 28000 Block of Franklin Rd (Apartments) on report of a male banging on a White Chevy Equinox and causing a disturbance. Dispatch then updated and stated the male was firing shots and it fled S/B on Franklin Rd.

Officer located a White Equinox traveling S/B on Telegraph Rd, at 9 Mile Rd. Officer stopped the vehicle in the 21000 Block of Telegraph. Additional officers arrived on scene and assisted in conducting a felony stop. Once the driver (lone occupant) of the vehicle was secured, Officers contacted the R/P from complex who witnessed the incident. He stated a male driving a white Chevy Equinox fired what he believed to be 3 gunshots in front of the entrance and then proceeded to drive recklessly through the parking lot. He stated the male struck a parked vehicle in the lot before leaving the complex and driving S/B on Telegraph Rd. Officers located a Red Jeep Wagoneer that the suspect hit while parked in the parking lot.

Officers also located the female half of what started out as a Domestic Dispute. The suspects girlfriend lives at the complex & advised they got into a verbal argument and her boyfriend stormed off out into the parking lot. She called her boyfriend and then realized that he had taken her rental vehicle. He did not have permission to drive the vehicle and she told him to bring it back. While she was talking to him on the phone, she heard a loud noise and he advised her he had hit a car in the parking lot. A short time later he told her he was being pulled over by the police. Two other witnesses advised they observed the suspect driving recklessly in the parking lot. The suspect stopped

the vehicle, got out of the vehicle, and started pounding on the vehicle. The suspect reentered the vehicle and they heard what they thought was one gunshot. During the traffic stop with the suspect Officers noted that the rear window on the vehicle had been broken out. Officer asked the suspect if he had a firearm on his person. The suspect stated no and gave officers permission to search the vehicle. No handgun was located on subject or the vehicle. The suspect was uncooperative and made several threats towards officers that if he were not handcuffed, he would fight the officers. He made a statement that if he had not hit the vehicle in the parking lot, he would have gotten away Scott free. Further investigation revealed that the suspects drivers license was suspended. The suspect was arrested for DWLS/ Leaving the Scene of Property Damage Accident/ Reckless Discharge of a Firearm.

# R&C Stolen Vehicle/ Fleeing & Eluding/ CCW/ R&O Police Officer- 1- Arrest

### W Eight Mile Rd.& Beech Rd.

Officer was on near 8 Mile Rd & Bridge St. and was conducting stationary laser speed enforcement when he observed a grey Chrysler 300, and his Lidar indicated the vehicle was travelling at 65mph-45mph zone. Officer got behind the vehicle and attempted to stop the vehicle. The vehicle sped up and began to flee. Officer activated his lights & siren and began to pursue vehicle. At this time information came out that the vehicle was stolen out of Clinton Twp. Police Department. The vehicle fled W/B on 8 Mile Rd and then went E/B on 8 Mile Rd. When the vehicle got to 8 Mile & Lahser Rd. Officer was advised to terminate the pursuit. Officer turned his lights & siren off and stopped his vehicle for the red light at 8 Mile & Lahser. The suspect vehicle continued E/B on 8 Mile Rd.

Officer observed the Chrysler 300 continue east on 8 Mile Road and begin to apply its brakes. The Chrysler 300 attempted to turn south onto a side street from East 8 Mile Road around a White BMW SUV. The Chrysler 300 crashed into a fire hydrant head-on and the driver ran from the front driver seat, south through the parking lot of a Gas Station.

Officer pulled up to the accident and checked the vehicle for injuries or occupants. There were no occupants. Officer observed a black handgun on the driver's floorboard. A blue Apple iPhone with a clear case was also on the driver's floorboard near the handgun. While standing by on scene while a K-9 conducted a track, Detroit Police Department arrived on scene and stated they had apprehended the suspect. The suspect was seated in the rear seat of a Detroit Police Department patrol vehicle. The suspect had tall dreadlocks, a white t-

shirt with a black zip up jacket, black shoes and black pant with white socks pulled over them near the ankle.

Officers contacted an employee at nearby Gas Station and was able to review surveillance video that shows the accident and the suspect fleeing the stolen vehicle. At approx. 5:52pm, the grey Chrysler 300 crashes head-on into the fire hydrant. A black male with tall dreadlocks wearing a white t-shirt, black unzipped jacket, black shoes, and black pant with white socks above the ankle exits the driver's seat of the grey Chrysler 300 and runs south through the parking lot of the gas station towards an alleyway. The suspect seen on camera footage running from the Chrysler 300 is the same suspect that Detroit Police Department apprehended. Southfield Officers took custody of the suspect. The suspect was transported to Southfield Police Department Jail processed and lodged without incident for R&C Stolen Property, CCW, R&O and Fleeing & Eluding.

Southfield Detective presented case to OCPO for review. Detective received a felony warrant back charging suspect with the following:

SRO Officer was requested for assistance to respond to B-House second floor. Arriving to the area SRO Officer observed (student) arguing with Security Officer.

SRO Officer stood in between the student and security. The student continued to yell, using profanity & attempted to walk towards Security. Students and teachers exited out of their classrooms as the student continued to yell causing a school disturbance. On 5/19/23 Officers responded to a possible shooting in the 16000 Block of Harden Circle. R/P stated that there was a shooting and did not answer any more questions. Multiple people in the background were screaming and it was hard to hear. R/P called back saying her mother was shot on the front porch.

Upon arrival there were several people outside the residence yelling. They were screaming that people were assaulted and guns were pulled. The suspect was leaving in a red truck going n/b on Pierce. They said the people in the red "truck" were shooting. Officers asked who was shot and the crowd said nobody was shot and there was not a shooting. Several officers arrived on scene and began to separate parties and interview them.

Three suspects (all related) arrived at the house unannounced. One of the suspects (primary) began to get very disrespectful in the house, she was intoxicated so the homeowner told her to leave. When the homeowner attempted to get her out of the house the other two suspects intervened and they all assaulted the homeowner and made verbal threats to do bodily harm to the homeowner.

The primary suspect threw a bottle at victim's head and punched victim in the back. Two of the suspects made threats to shoot people at the residence. The lone male suspect picked up a porcelain dog lawn ornament and threw it into the glass exterior door shattering it. All three left the scene in a red Alfa Romeo.

Officers located the suspect vehicle and stopped it. The suspects were ordered out of the vehicle. The primary suspect refused to exit the vehicle and had to be removed from the vehicle forcefully by officers. All three suspects were taken into custody.

On May 21, 2023at 2:00pm Officers were dispatched to the 28000 Block of Franklin Rd, (Abandoned Building) for Malicious Destruction of Property. R/P advised she was on the property and could hear glass shattering from inside the building. When officers arrived on scene, they observed an individual on the fourth floor hitting the window forcefully on the north side of the building. After the window was struck several times, officers observed an individual poke his head out the window. The subject was wearing a black hat. Officers went inside the location, announced police and two subjects announced they were inside the location. They were advised to come downstairs to speak with officers. When the juveniles came downstairs, they were both recording on their cell phones. One of the subjects stated he was inside the building recording footage for a "Tik-Tok" video. The two subjects were juveniles and contact were made with their parents. The subjects were advised on trespassing on the property and their cell phones were confiscated as evidence. Both juveniles were tot their parents. The cell phones were confiscated, and a search warrant was obtained by Detectives for review of content. During the review of content video was observed of both subjects MDOP the inside of the building. The case was forwarded to the city prosecutor's office for review for EWOP and MDOP.

A&B/ Disturbing the Peace/ R&O- 1- Arrest 05/21/2023 12:34am 22000 Block of Telegraph Rd. (Motel)

On 05/21/2023 Officers were dispatched to the 22000 Block of Telegraph Rd. (Motel) for a female who was kicking doors and throwing garbage cans. Contact was made with R/P (Desk Clerk) who stated that the female was throwing garbage cans and kicked in a door. The desk clerk advised officers what room the suspect was in, and he wanted her evicted from the hotel. Officers went to the room and knocked on the door. A female later identified answered the door, and immediately began yelling about the clerk. Officers explained to her multiple times that she was being evicted from the hotel room and she needed to leave. She initially told officers that she was not leaving because she lived there and had paid for the entire week. After Officers explained the law to her multiple times, she began to pack her belongings. She would pack some belongings and then pause to call officers names and scream at them. This continued for approximately 30-40 minutes, as officers gave her ample time to pack her belongings. Once her belongings were packed, suspect carried her belongings to the balcony area. Multiple times while on the balcony, she began to scream across the parking lot at the clerk and another subject in the parking lot. She was advised multiple times when she was screaming across the parking lot that she was disturbing the peace and she needed to stop. When officers were walking suspect to her vehicle and telling her not to come back to the property, she struck an officer in the arm with her open hand. When this occurred, she was placed under arrest for A&B on Police Officer. Offices transported suspect to Southfield lock-up. When Officers were in the sally port of the police station, suspect refused to exit the patrol car and locked her leg on the door. Officers had to forcefully remove suspect from the patrol vehicle. We then escorted her to the lock-up via the elevator suspect made a noise like she was going to spit on officers. When she did this, Officers pressed her body against the door of the elevator to avoid her from spitting on officers. Once in lock-up, Officers were escorting her down the hallway to the behavior modification unit and suspect slammed her body against Officer slamming her into the wall (this occurred twice). Once in the jail cell suspect continued to resist officers and assaulted another officer. Suspect is being charged with Disturbing the Peace, A&B on P.O. & R&O.
