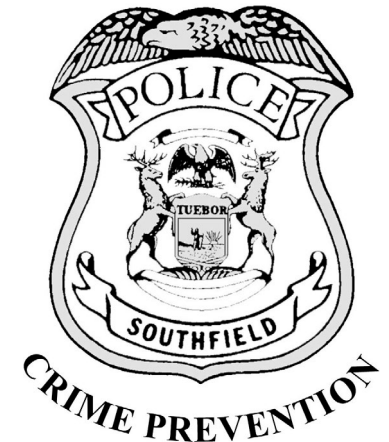
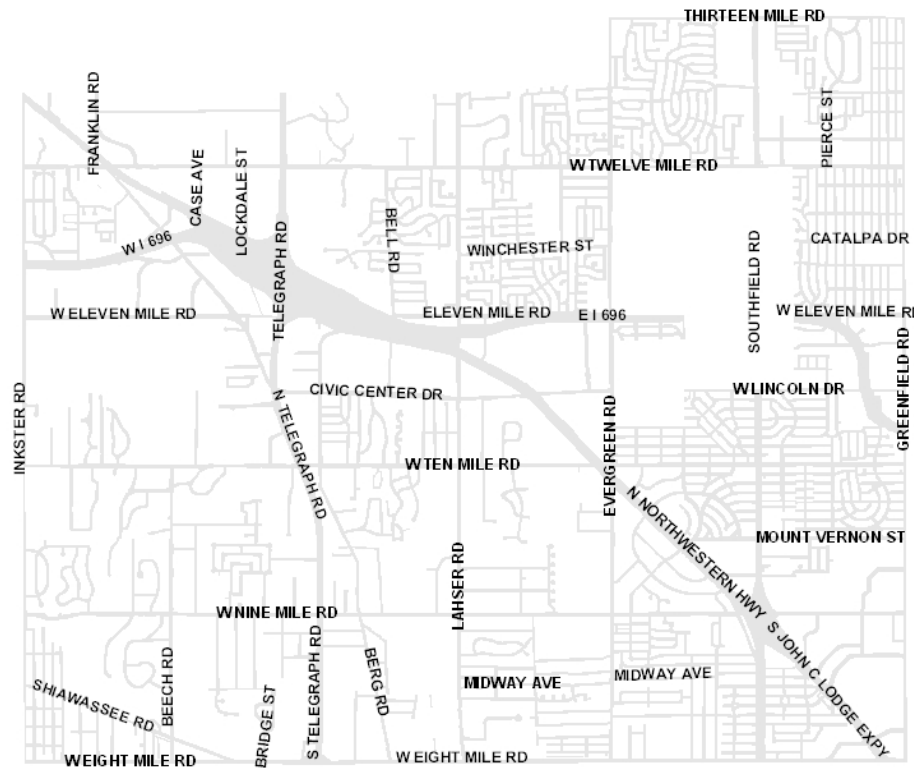

05/17/2022 2:54pm	19000 W Ten Mile (Vacant Office Building)	Glass was broken out on all four entry doors on main level.	R/P stated that a B/M with a dark hoodie was attempting to enter vacant building in the 19000 Block of Ten Mile Rd. R/P believed the subject might possibly be homeless. The R/P lost sight of the subject prior to officers' arrival. Several Officers including a Southfield Police K-9 Unit arrived on scene and made entry into the building. The subject wasn't located. Note: Parts of the building were deemed unsafe and there was black mold evident in areas of the building. There was no evidence that anything was taken.

(Multi Business Strip)</p>	<p>Glass was broken out on front door.</p>	<p>R/P came into his business and noticed the business next to his had the glass broken out on front door. The owner of business was contacted, and he responded to the scene.</p> <p>Officers reviewed surveillance video from business, and it shows suspects arriving in a White Pick-Up Truck. The truck backs up to the business. Two subjects exit the vehicle, and one subject breaks out the glass with a sledgehammer. Three unknown subjects could be seen running into the store and grabbing various miscellaneous clothing items for sale off racks. One subject could be seen at the cash register. Victim stated there was some cash in the cash register that was now missing, and several items of clothing was stolen.</p> <p>Suspect Information:</p> <p>Suspect#1 was wearing a light color hoodie with the hood up, light color pants, gloves, and a mask.</p> <p>Suspect#2 was wearing a light color hoodie with the hood up, dark color pants, gloves, and a mask.</p> <p>Suspect#3 was wearing a dark colored hoodie with the hood up, dark color pants, gloves, and a mask.</p>

R/P stated that she observed her office suite being broken into and the suspects were taking one of their medical machines. Officers arrived on scene and discovered good B&E. R/P states she watched 4 maybe 5 males on video stealing the machine. She stated all males/suspects were wearing black clothing and masks except one, which was wearing a white shirt and no mask. The suspects entered the suite at 8:37am and left at 8:39am. One medical machine is missing from the office. Investigation is on-going.</p>

Description: Keys- 1 Dodge key fob, 1 GMC key fob, 2 standard keys, & a men's watch was taken.	<p>On 05/20/2022 at 3:25pm Officers were dispatched to the 23000 Block of Greenfield Rd (Multi Business Office Building) regarding a robbery. Victim stated two black males armed with handguns robbed him in the parking lot. Victim stated he was in the Office Building looking around at the different jewelry stores with his friend, and then exited the building through the east side doors. As they were walking north through the parking lot to their vehicle, 2 younger black males ran towards them, both armed with handguns. Victim turned around and started running back towards the east doors of the building. His friend ran in another direction. One of the male suspects threatened to shoot R/P so he stopped. One of the suspects pointed a gun at his chest and threatened to shoot him if he didn't give him whatever he had on him. Victim was wearing a high-end watch, so he took it off and handed it to the suspect. The suspect also grabbed his keys when they fell out of his pocket. The keys were for his vehicles and residence. Both suspects ran to a vehicle that was being driven by a third unknown suspect and fled the scene. The victim's friend ran across Greenfield Rd. and called the police. <p>Special Attention: Armed Subject 05/17/2022 11:30pm 16000 Block of W Nine Mile Rd (Hospital) On 05/17/2022 Several Southfield Officers were dispatched to the 16000 Block of W. Nine Mile Rd. (Hospital) regarding an armed subject. Dispatch advised a B/M driving a White Dodge Durango was at the ER armed with an assault rifle, Dispatch further advised that the male fled the scene at a high rate of speed prior to officers' arrival. Officers arrived on scene and were met by several Hospital Security Officers. Officers conducted an area check and were unable to locate suspect. Information was gathered that the suspect had gotten into a verbal argument earlier with another male subject and security had to break it up. The suspect had left but returned shortly after with an assault type rifle. Security responded again and ordered the suspect to drop his weapon. The suspect ignored Security Officers and got back into his car and fled the area. The suspect never pointed the assault rifle at anyone but had it out of his vehicle and on his side.
