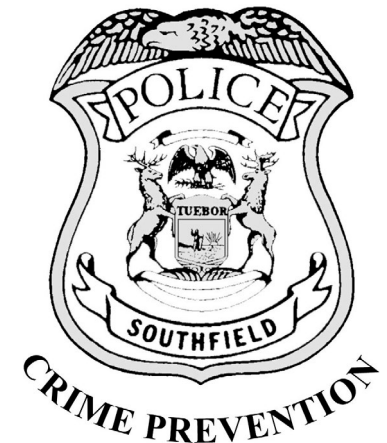
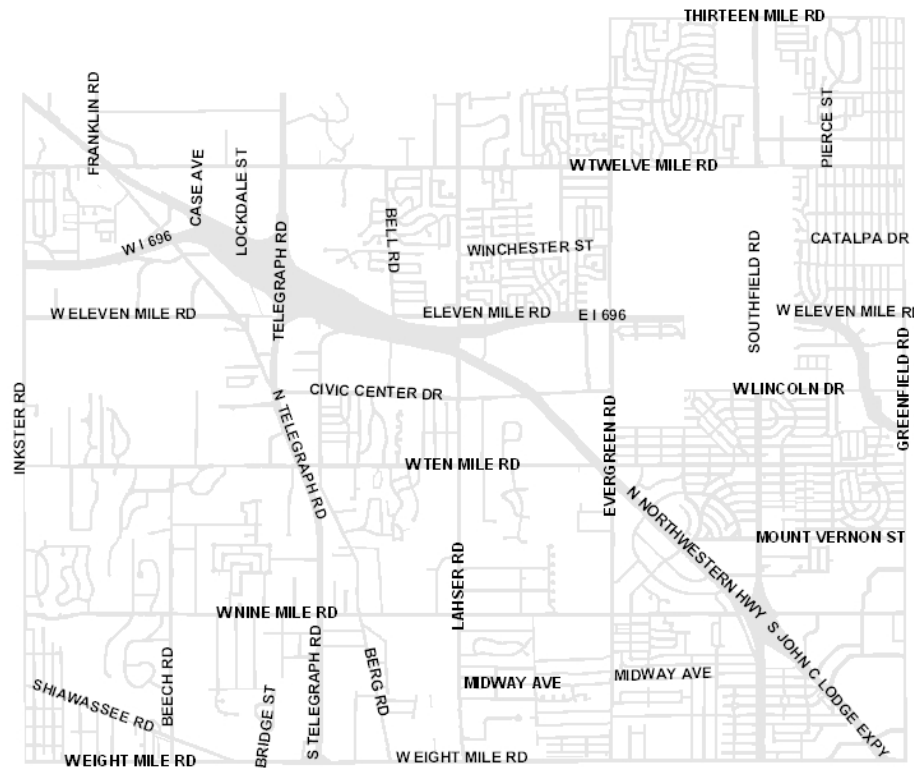

Suspect# 2: Medium Build B/M, wearing a white ski mask, red and black jacket, blue jeans, and red sneakers. Suspect Vehicle: Black sedan possibly a Ford Taurus, tinted windows. chrome grille and trim.</p>

(Hotel)**

On 05/25/2022 at approx. 11:23pm, Officers were dispatched to the 28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy (Hotel) for a welfare check. A neighboring jurisdiction requested officers for a welfare check on a subject staying at the hotel. Other jurisdiction was out with a victim of a sexual assault that occurred in their city. Their victim was staying at the hotel in Southfield with her friend and they are both prostitutes. This morning, victim was allegedly abducted from the hotel in Southfield by a male and assaulted in another jurisdiction. Other PD wanted officers to check the welfare of another female and check for the suspect vehicle (silver or gray Nissan). Upon arrival, the parking lot checked negative for the suspect vehicle. When Officers went to the hotel room, they found the door ajar. Nobody was in the room and the shower was running.

Other PD responded to hotel in Southfield with their victim. Victim advised she and friend checked into the hotel last night. She stated her friend solicits herself to an unknown married man in the area. She stated that man's friend, an unknown black male, (suspect) came to the hotel this morning to meet her (victim). Victim states after her friend

**26000 Block of Telegraph Rd
(Gas Station)**

Officers were dispatched to Gas Station in the 26000 Block of Telegraph Rd. for reports of a shooting. Officers arrived at the area and their investigation revealed that two B/M's were staying at the Hotel were in the parking lot when they got into a verbal argument with a male subject that was at Gas Station across the street in the parking lot. Surveillance video from Hotel and Gas Station confirmed that one of the B/M's that was in the parking lot of the Hotel pulled out a handgun. While he was arguing with male from gas station you can see several bullets striking the cement wall behind where they were standing. The two males could then be seen taking cover and leaving that area. Surveillance video from gas station shows a B/M exiting a black Ford Fusion with an assault rifle and firing several rounds towards the subjects at the hotel.

Officers located the two subjects from the Hotel on the sidewalk in front of the 26000 Block of Franklin Rd. Both subjects started to run until Officers positioned their patrol vehicles to cut their flight path off. The two suspects were handcuffed and detained while Officers continued to investigate. The handgun that suspect had at the hotel was located in a trash can where the

left the unknown male forced her into his vehicle, took her to another city and sexually assaulted her.

Investigation is on-going

Suspect Description:

Unknown black male. Approximately 32 yoa, 6'-0", average build, caramel complexion, short black hair, and a beard/mustache. He was wearing green jogging pants, a brown hoodie, and kaki Nike shoes.

two subjects were seen earlier. The suspect that was in possession of the handgun was identified from surveillance video and taken into custody for CCW & Obstruct Police. The second suspect was released on scene. The suspect from the gas station was not located on this date.

29000 Block of Northwestern Hwy (Bar Club)

Officers responded to reports of shots fired in the parking lot in the 29000 Block of Northwestern Hwy. Initial information is that a woman was involved in an altercation at the bar, the woman went into the parking lot and fired a shot and left the location. Officers arrived on scene and located one of the females involved in the fight.

R/P (victim) states she was at the Bar with some of her friends. It was sometime between 10:00pm- 10:30pm while they were in the club, when they were approached by suspect who is believed to be an ex-girlfriend of one of the females. The suspect and the ex-girlfriend went out into the parking lot and got into a physical fight. Both females then left the area. R/P who is now friends with the suspects ex-girlfriend was sitting in her car when the suspect returned and pulled her vehicle up next to her vehicle.

Suspect got out of her car and wanted to fight her. R/P got out of her car and fought her. R/P said she was winning the fight when suspect went into her Land Rover and grabbed a handgun. As soon as R/P saw suspect grab a gun, she dove on the ground behind her vehicle. She heard a gunshot and continued to lie on the ground until she heard suspects' vehicle leaving. Nobody was injured in the incident.

Investigation is on-going.

Shots Fired Investigation/ Warrant Arrest

05/26/2022 11:03pm

22000 Block of Telegraph Rd

(Hotel)

Officers responded to report of shots fired in a room at motel in the 22000 Block of Telegraph Rd. Witnesses state that an employee of the motel was trying to get the occupants of one of the rooms to relocate. When they refused, the employee left and returned to the room with another male. Shortly after this, shots were fired into the window of the room. The employee (suspect) was located on site and detained. Fresh bullet holes were located at the room in question. DB was contacted and responded.

Further investigation revealed that occupants from the room told officers that an employee known to them came to their room and told everyone in the room they had to move to another room. The occupants refused to leave because the room was paid for. The employee left and returned 2-3 minutes later with another unknown male that was armed with an assault rifle. This subject then fired several rounds into the room.

Everyone in the room took cover and no one was hit.

The employee that was with this subject was located and taken into custody for a Southfield Traffic Warrant. He was uncooperative in the shooting investigation and the shooter is unknown. Investigation is on-going.
