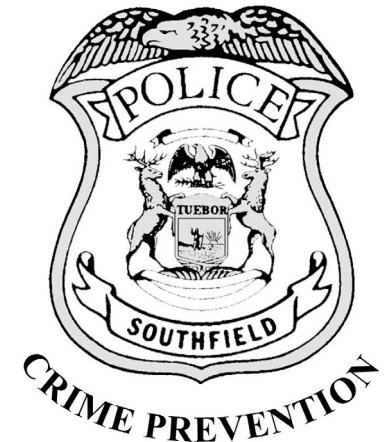
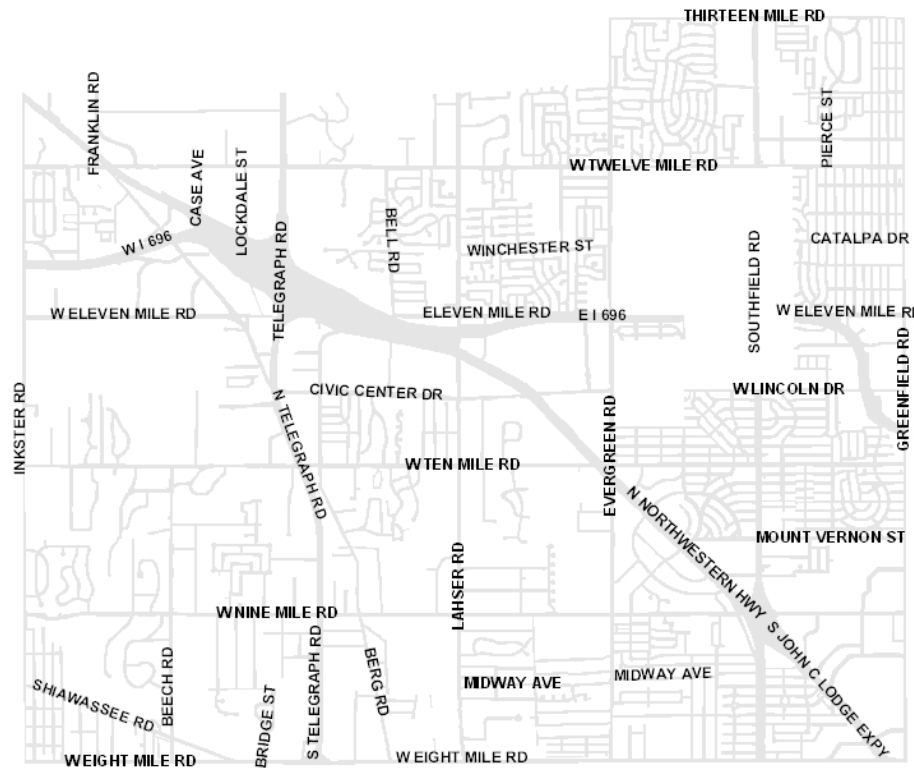

Officers arrived on scene and discovered that the front door glass was partially smashed in (bottom right corner) and the glass window adjacent to the door was broken out almost completely. Officers cleared the building and found no suspects. An attempt by suspects to get into the back-office door was made by suspects with no success. The door handle to the office door was damaged. Security footage at 5:30am shows 2- suspects approaching the front of the store on foot. Suspect #1 was wearing a green or dark hoodie and used a sledgehammer to break the glass. Suspect #2 had on a green hoodie, tan pants, a blue ski mask, and was carrying a bag. Both suspects were only in the store for about a minute before leaving in unknown direction. The owner of the business stated that nothing was taken from the store.</p>

Approx. 15 copper wires were cut & stolen of various sizes from various electrical panels throughout the building. A portable air compressor was also taken. No suspect information.</p>

The 10 Cars Catalytic Converter Thieves Target Most

Catalytic converter theft continues to run rampant throughout the United States.

Catalytic converters, you never think about them until the day you go to start your car and discover the one that was once attached to your vehicle is gone. The biggest clues your catalytic converter might have been stolen? An excessive amount of engine noise and noxious fumes coming from underneath the car.

So, what are catalytic converters and why are they suddenly popular with thieves looking to make a quick buck? To start, catalytic converters are located within the exhaust system and help clean the emissions of a gasoline- or diesel-powered engine. They have been a federally mandated requirement on every new vehicle since 1975.
