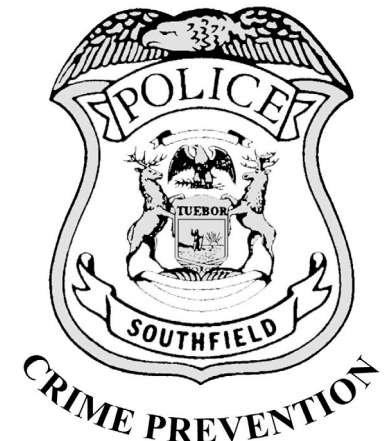
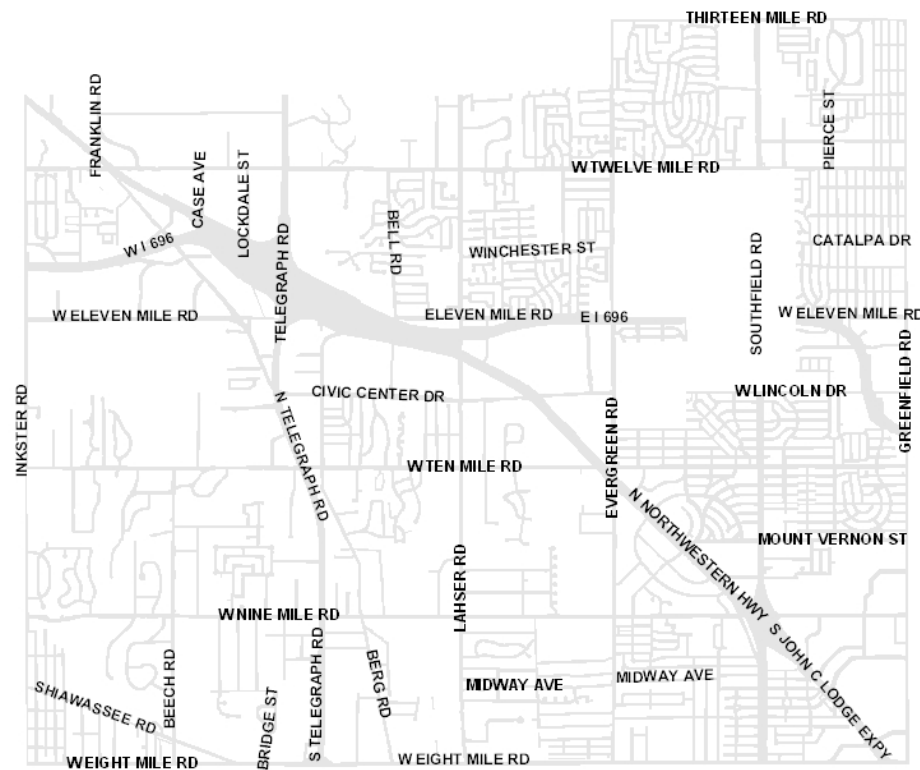

Two individuals were observed attempting to break into a White Kia parked in the complex. Officer arrived on scene and observed a White, Kia, K5 parked on the west side of the main drive. The Kia had its rear passenger side window broken out and it was lying on pavement next to the vehicle. Officer notified dispatch and observed two other vehicles parked next to each other. One vehicle was a Silver, 2017, Hyundai, Sonata, bearing a Michigan Plate. The other was a White, 2016, Hyundai, Sonata, bearing a Michigan Plate. The White Hyundai began frantically blaring its horn at the Silver Hyundai and both vehicles began to flee. Officer activated his lights and siren and pursued both vehicles. As the suspect vehicles were attempting to leave the complex additional Southfield Units were pulling into the area. One of the suspect vehicles circled back & stopped in the complex. Two suspects fled on foot from the vehicle. Officer attempted to block the other suspect vehicle from leaving the complex. The White Hyundai Sonata struck Officers vehicle in the left front wheel disabling his vehicle. The White Hyundai Sonata was traveling toward the entrance at a high rate of speed. A

			<p>second officer positioned his patrol vehicle into the direct path of the oncoming vehicle, attempting to prevent it from exiting the complex. The vehicle swerved around Officers vehicle narrowly avoiding contact, before striking another Officers patrol vehicle in the westbound lanes of Eight Mile Rd, just outside of the complex entrance. The vehicle traveled across the center median before becoming disabled in the middle of the e/b lanes of Eight Mile Rd. Three suspects exited the suspect vehicle and fled on foot. All three of the vehicle's occupants appeared to be younger black males. One of the suspects, who appeared to be the driver, ran s/e from Eight Mile Rd. The additional two suspects ran s/w from Eight Mile Rd. Officers pursued the suspects until they lost sight of them. Officers set up a perimeter around the location that the suspects were last seen.</p> <p>An Oakland County K-9 Unit was brought in, but the suspects were not located.</p> <p>Both suspect vehicles were found to be running with ignition damage. One of the suspect vehicles was reported stolen. The other vehicle had not been reported stolen yet. A handgun was recovered in the White Hyundai Sonata. Investigation is on-going.</p>

Officers met with Southfield FD Fire Inspectors. They received the call for the fire today at 1:34pm. They responded to the scene and found that there were no hotspots. There were no signs of an accelerant used. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician looked inside of the room and saw the mattress closest to the door was burned. The comforter, bed frame and mattress sustained fire damage. The entire room was also covered in smoke residue. The smoke detector had been removed from the wall. The rest of the room appeared to be in order with no apparent damage. Information on who rented the hotel room was obtained. There were several persons staying in the room They were not located during Officers and Fire Inspectors initial investigation. (Apartments)</b>  On 05/08/2023, several Officers were dispatched to the 26000 Block of Berg Rd for a report of a Domestic Dispute at Apartment Complex. Several calls came in that a male and female were fighting in the hallway. One caller stated that the male was an ex-boyfriend. Officers arrived on scene and spoke to the female victim. The group of subjects included victim and two additional females. Victim was emotional and crying. Victim advised her ex-boyfriend, had arrived at the apartment and was banging on her bedroom window and the glass of her patio door. The ex-boyfriend told victim he was going to break out a window. He was angry because victim had broken up with him. Victim came out of her apartment to meet with her two female friends. That is when her ex-boyfriend confronted her and started to push her around. Victims' girlfriends tried to intervene. When Officers arrived on scene the ex-boyfriend snatched victims' keys from her, and he ran into her apartment and locked the door. Officers ordered the suspect to come out of the victim's apartment. The suspect eventually came out of the apartment, and he was taken into custody for Domestic A&amp;B and Home Invasion. The suspect did not live or stay at victim's apartment. During the search incident to arrest officers recovered victims' keys to her apartment and a silver neck chain. Victim identified the neck chain and stated it was taken from inside her apartment. The suspect did not have permission to enter victim's apartment, take her keys or take her chain from the apartment. The suspect was conveyed to the Southfield jail.</p>

Officers contacted two suspects. Both were identified and released on scene. Investigation is on-going. The vehicle was recovered.

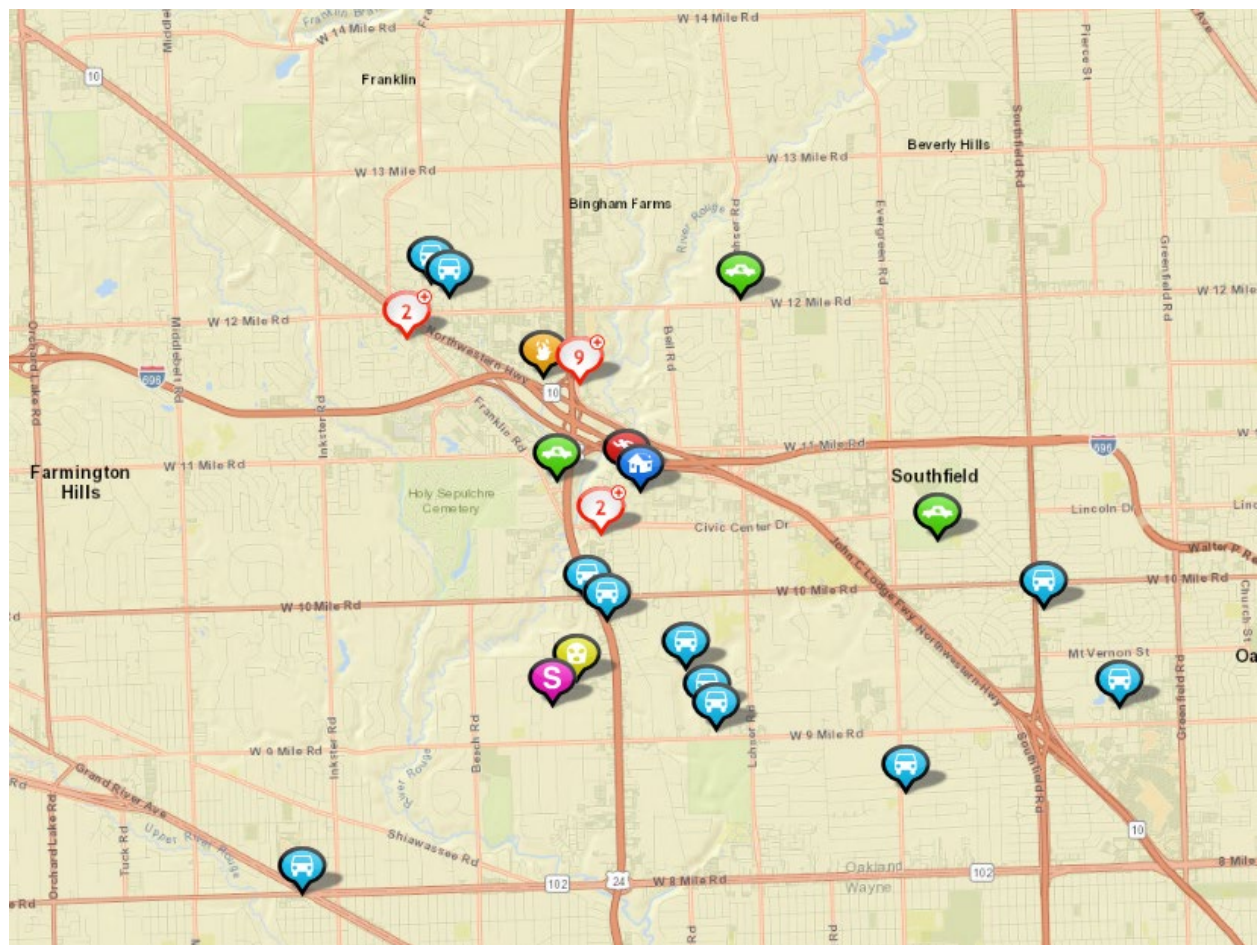
