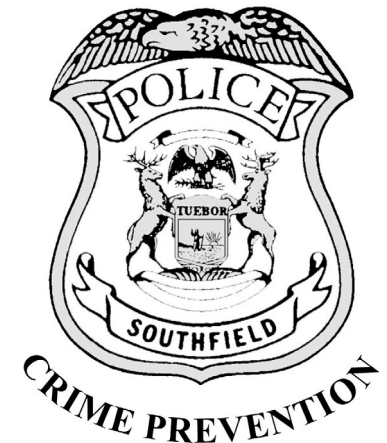
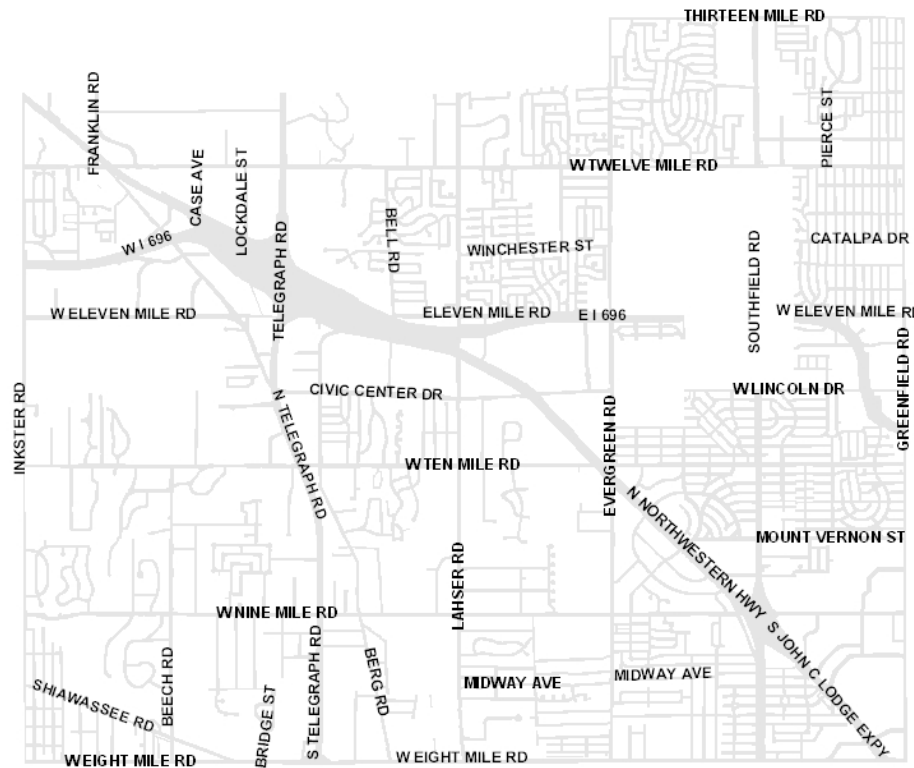

(Hotel) regarding a carjacking just occurred. Victim stated he was at a casino earlier and drove straight to the hotel after he was done at the casino. Victim did not notice anyone paying close attention to him at the casino, nor did he notice anyone following him to the hotel. Victim advised when he arrived at the hotel, he sat in the parking lot to the west of the hotel entrance attempting to book a room through a web site. While he was on his phone an unknown male wearing a ski mask ran up to the driver side door, opened the door and pulled him out of the vehicle at gunpoint. The suspect told him to give him everything he had and started going through his pockets. The suspect threw victims phone on the ground and took his jewelry before entering vehicle and leaving the parking lot in an unknown direction. Victim advised he contacted 911 immediately after the crime occurred. While in route to Hotel Officers located victim's vehicle on Simmons St. just west of Berg Rd. This was within proximity of the hotel where the robbery occurred. The vehicle had both front and rear doors open. Once additional units arrived on scene the vehicle was cleared with negative results of any suspects involved.

			<p>A gold watch was recovered that is believed to belong to the victim. A witness who was sitting in his car near where victim's vehicle was recovered stated he observed the victims Chrysler Pacifica drive onto Simmons St. at approx. 2:35am. He observed two individuals exit the vehicle calmly, grab several items from the car and leave in an unknown direction. He did not have any further suspect information.</p> <p>A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the vehicle and recovered victims watch and 2- I phones. Investigation is on-going.</p>

Victim had his wallet and keys taken by an unknown black male wearing a blue hoodie and jeans. Officers arrived on scene and met with the victim. Victim states he was sitting in his car when he noticed a subject standing next to his vehicle. The suspect opened the door of his vehicle and grabbed his wallet and keys. The suspect didn't make any threats or statements. The suspect then fled on foot.
The victim described the suspect as a younger black male in his 30s, wearing a blue sweatshirt, blue jeans, with a black bandana tied around his face. Victim advised that his wallet contained his drivers license, miscellaneous credit cards, and some cash.
Victim later advised that one of his credit cards was used but he didn't have any details of where it was used. Investigation is on-going.
