


# Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but do not leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- -If you do not have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you are here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside

On 12/01/2022, Officers were dispatched to the 22000 Block of Telegraph Rd. (Groceries/ Market) regarding a fight between two customers. Officer arrived on scene and observed subjects leaving the parking lot and walking across Telegraph Rd. towards a nearby hotel. He also observed a black male (suspect) standing next to a woman in the parking lot at the Market. The suspect was yelling at persons crossing Telegraph Rd. The suspect had a large knot & bruise on his cheek under his left eye and he appeared intoxicated. There were several other persons in the parking lot at the Market and officers attempted to move the suspect away from these persons. The suspect was uncooperative and refused to give any information as to what happened. At one point the suspect attempted to push pass officers. Officers attempted to calm the suspect down, but he continued to be disorderly. He attempted to walk away from Officers and was walking through the parking lot in the direction of the people crossing Telegraph Rd. As he was walking away, he was yelling at the woman he was with. He was swearing at her and saying he was going to whoop her. Suspect continued to be disorderly and attempted to get away from Officers to get across the street to the other group of people. When Officers attempted to take suspect into custody for Disorderly Person, he resisted Officers and assaulted both Officers. He was eventually taken into custody.

While in route to the station the suspect continued to be disorderly and was spitting in the back seat of the patrol vehicle. Once at the station and taken to the jail the suspect continued to be disorderly through the whole process in the jail.

without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals do not like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it is difficult to see them. **Note:** Officers contacted the persons that suspect was yelling at across the street from the market. The male subject stated he did not know (suspect). He was in the market with his girlfriend and her baby shopping. The suspect was intoxicated and started harassing them for no reason. At one point the suspect took his shirt off and came at the male in a threatening manner. The male felt he had no choice but to protect himself and he punched suspect one time in the face. The two started fighting until the male was able to break free and fled the store with his girlfriend and her baby.

#### **Special Attention:**

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.


How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages. Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package. Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

# **Special Attention: Crime Prevention for the Holidays!**

With the Holidays approaching citizens should be extra careful when shopping. Citizens should never leave anything of value inside the compartment area of your vehicle. If you must leave valuables in the car, be sure to put them in the trunk. If you do not have a trunk then I would recommend you take items home. Do not leave Christmas Gifts in your vehicle. Women should be extra careful when carrying a purse. Do not carry your purse over your shoulder and do not leave your purse open and or in a shopping cart unattended. This includes when you are in the store or when moving items from your shopping cart into your vehicle in the parking lot. You are an easy target for someone to take your purse or take your wallet. It only takes a matter of seconds for someone to do this. Stay vigilante!!! I would recommend that citizens not carry a purse. instead, they should carry a wallet or something that can be concealed inside your jacket.
