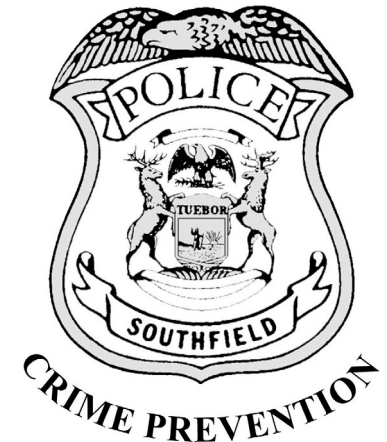
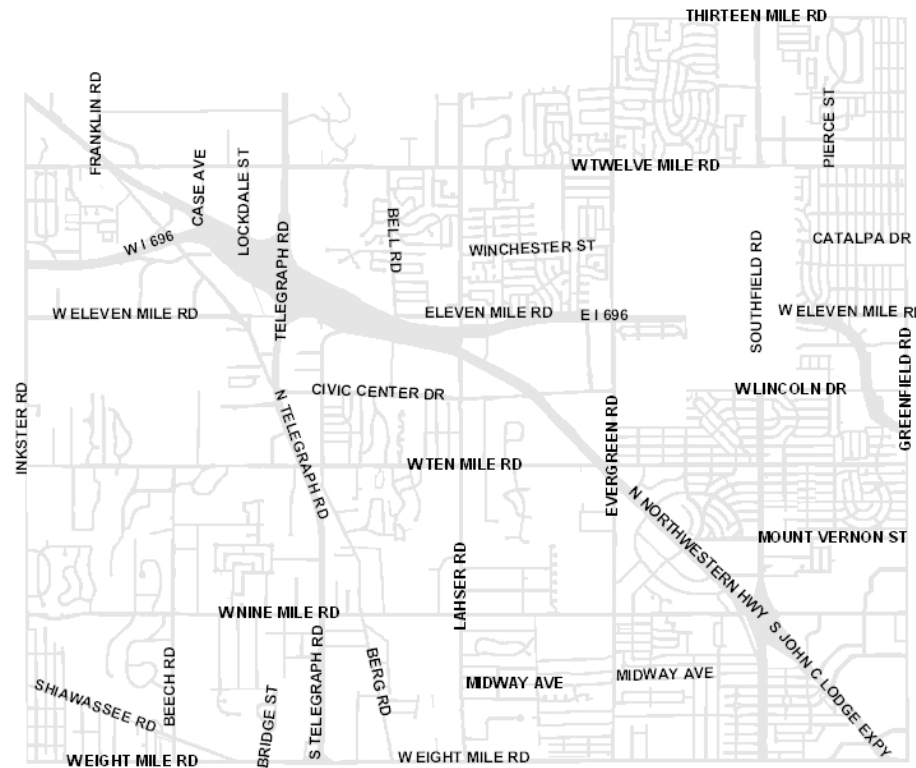

**29000 Block of Gardenia Ln.**

Several Officers responded to shooting that just occurred at 29000 Block of Gardenia. The victim who was shot had been driven to Beaumont Hospital by a family member.

Investigation revealed that several persons were at residence for a Thanksgiving dinner. The resident and host advised that her nephew (victim) got into a verbal argument with her daughter's boyfriend who suddenly pulled out a handgun and shot her nephew. The daughter's boyfriend was identified. He fled the scene and was not located. A BOL was put out for the suspect wanted in the shooting. On 11/28/2022 at approx. 3:00pm Officers were dispatched to Van Buren Twp. PD to pick up the suspect. He was arrested by Van Buren PD when they came across his vehicle which was listed as a felony wanted vehicle for AWIM. The suspect was seen exiting the vehicle and was taken into custody. The suspect was positively identified as the suspect in the shooting and Southfield Officers took custody of suspect from Van Buren PD. He was transported to the Southfield Jail where he was booked and processed without incident.

## **Serious Injury Crash Investigation**

### **12 Mile Rd & Everett**

11/24/2022 10:06am

Officers responded to 12 Mile Rd & Everett to investigate a one car roll over crash. Witnesses said that the vehicle was going against traffic on 12 Mile Rd. and the male driver, 27-year-old Southfield resident, was hanging out of the window prior to crashing and rolling over. The driver, only occupant, sustained serious injuries and was transported to a local hospital for treatment. A Southfield Police Traffic Crash Investigator was called to scene for investigation. The driver was in critical but stable condition.

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but do not leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you do not have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you are here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals do not like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it is difficult to see them.

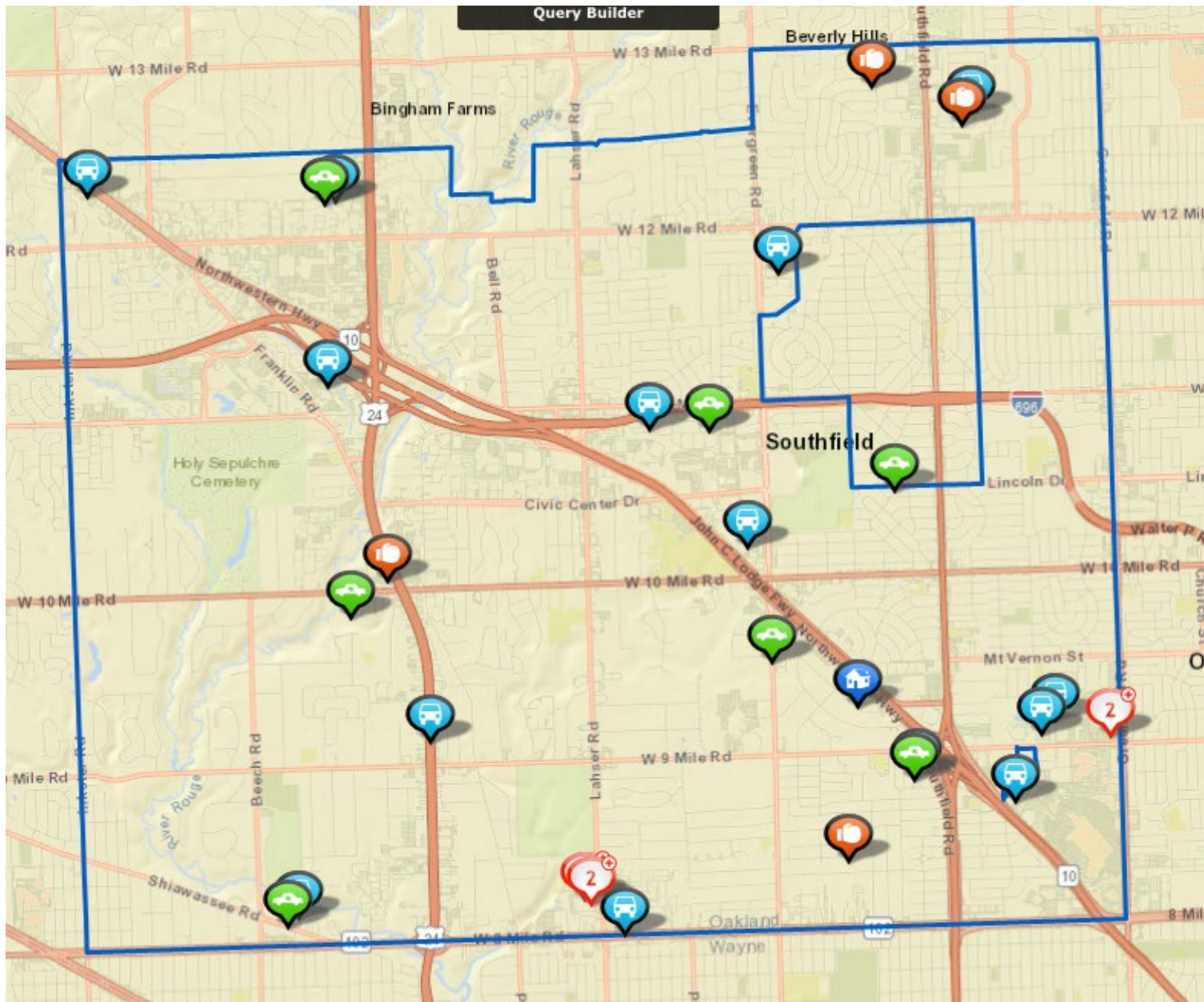
**Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.**

**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.
