


The suspect advised Arresting Officers that she had consumed Heroin. A Life Support Unit arrived on scene and transported suspect to the hospital. During treatment Hospital staff removed suspect's right sock. Officer observed a white rock of suspected crack cocaine fall out of the sock and onto the bed. As he recovered the suspected crack cocaine, he also located a small baggie containing a black substance suspected to be heroin. Both items were recovered and secured as evidence. Officers ran the VIN# on the Ford Fusion. The Fusion came back as stolen out of Redford. Dispatch confirmed the vehicle was stolen through Redford PD. Officers searched the recovered vehicle and located a stolen plate inside the vehicle. After the suspect was triaged at the hospital, she was taken to the Southfield Jail processed & lodged. She was charged with R&C Motor Vehicle/ Possession of Stolen Property/ Fleeing & Eluding & R&O.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- -If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you are here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the

On 10/23/2022, Officers were dispatched to the 26000 Block of American Dr. (Hotel) for a suspicious incident. It was reported that a female at that location was being held against her will and possibly involved in sex trafficking.

Officers arrived on scene and went to a room where it was believed that the caller was at. Officers spoke to a female in the room. It was determined that this wasn't the female that called. It was later learned that this female, was a suspect involved in the trafficking with an unknown male that was her boyfriend. The female caller was eventually located in another room and advised officers she was performing sex acts for the unknown male. She had been at the hotel for approx. two weeks. He was basically hers and some other girl's pimp. He would show up in the morning and take all their money and wouldn't give any to her. She had limited use of her cell phone and was afraid to stop performing sex acts or leave because she would lose her use of her cell phone, or something would happen to her. The female suspect was working with her boyfriend and was watching R/P (victim). She was afraid to leave. When Officers went back to the room to speak with the original female (suspect) she couldn't be located. All the hotel rooms associated with this female were vacated.

(R/P) victim was transported to a Shelter for safe keeping. Later the same day Officer was dispatched back to the hotel reference female suspect returning to the room. Officer contacted the female and spoke to her about the Sex Trafficking. She was taken into custody for Southfield Warrant DWLS & Sex Trafficking. The male suspect was not located. Investigation is on-going.
