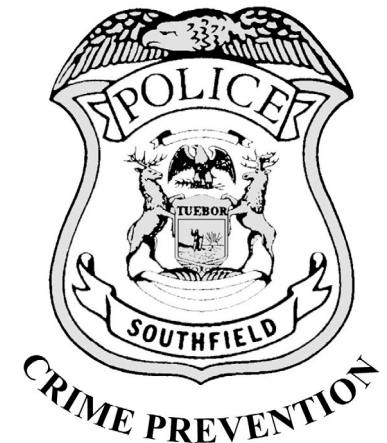
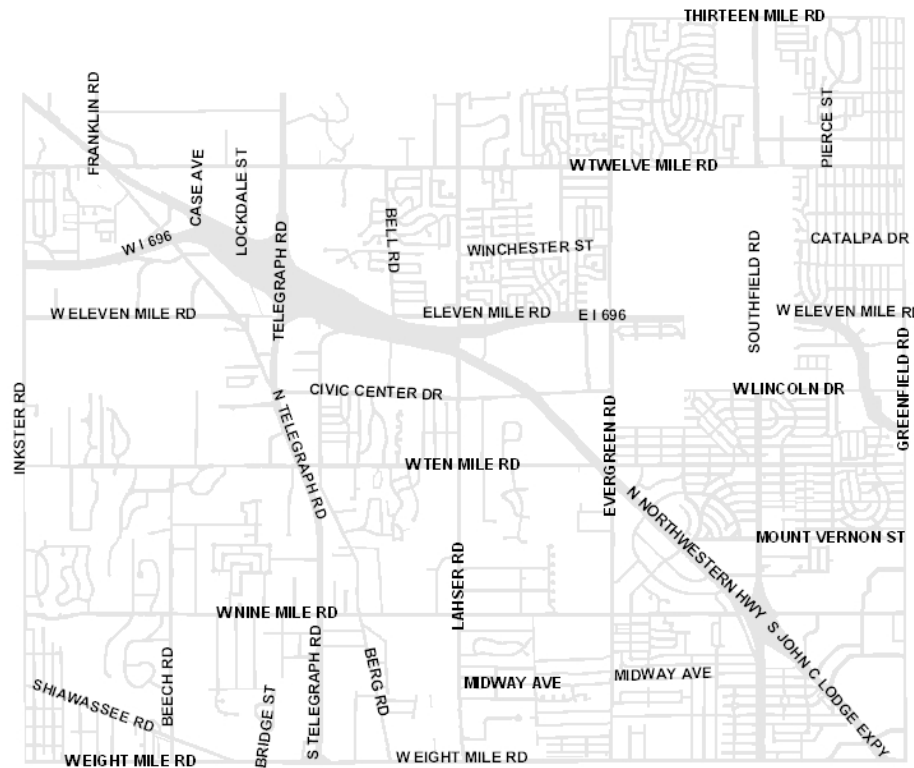

#### How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

**Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**  
**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you hear any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the

**Telegraph Rd. & E/B I-696**

On 10/28/2022, at approx. 1:30am, Officers were conducting routine patrol around N/B Telegraph Rd. and Ten Mile Rd. when a dark colored Ford Edge drove by them at a high rate of speed. Officers caught up to the vehicle and stopped it on N/B Telegraph just south of I-696. The driver was advised why he was stopped. The driver stated he was in a hurry to get to 8 Mile Rd. because his daughter was having a medical emergency. The direction subject was traveling was away from 8 Mile Rd. & contrary to his statement. When officers requested the subjects' driver's license, registration & insurance he dropped some of the information between the seats. The driver was told not to get out of the vehicle. The driver disregarded officers order and opened his door and got out of the vehicle. The driver was making furtive movements and Officers walked the driver back to their patrol vehicle and asked him if he had any weapons on him. The driver responded that he had a knife on him. Officers patted the subject down and recovered a Knife/ Brass Knuckle combination in his jacket pocket. The driver was taken into custody for CCW. After transporting subject to the jail, he refused to exit the patrol vehicle. He eventually exited the vehicle but was still exhibiting combative behavior. When Officers and jail staff attempted to put subject into a cell, he pushed jail staff and attempted to punch one of the Officers. The subject was eventually secured in his cell. On October 25, 2022, at approx. 6:00pm, Officers responded to a possible rolling domestic for a female stating a male will not stop the vehicle and let her out. The male is yelling at the female and refusing to stop the Red Ford Fusion that they were in.

Officers located the Red Ford Fusion eastbound on 9-mile Rd near Southfield. The vehicle came to an abrupt stop on eastbound 9 mile near Rutland St. The driver immediately opened the driver's side door and began to exit the vehicle. He was ordered to stay in the car several times. He proceeded to exit the driver side of the vehicle and reach into the compartment on the driver's door. He pulled a plastic candy container from the compartment and stood with his back to the opening of the driver's side door. The subject was ordered to turn around, to which he did not comply. The subject was ordered to put his hands behind his back. He resisted Officers and continued to use his body to push off the car and try to get away from Officers. Officers were eventually able to handcuff subject and walk him back to their patrol car. Officers conducted a custodial search of subject and found no weapons or contraband and placed him in the back of the patrol car. The subject was run in LEIN, and he returned with a suspended license. He was taken into custody for DWLS & Resisting & Obstructing. The female was interviewed, and she gave Officers her statement. She was not injured during the incident.

On 10/26/2022 Officers were dispatched to the 22000 Block of Essex Way Ct. (Apartments). The female that called stated that her brother physically assaulted her then pointed an assault rifle at her. The suspect is on probation for a weapons offense and has numerous inside the residence. Officer blocked traffic, formed a perimeter, evacuated the complex, and convinced the suspect to exit. The suspect eventually came out and was arrested and transported to the Southfield Detention Center without incident.

A search warrant was obtained, and an Assault Pistol was recovered from the apartment. Several Officers, Detectives and SERT Officers were involved in this investigation. Investigation is on-going.
