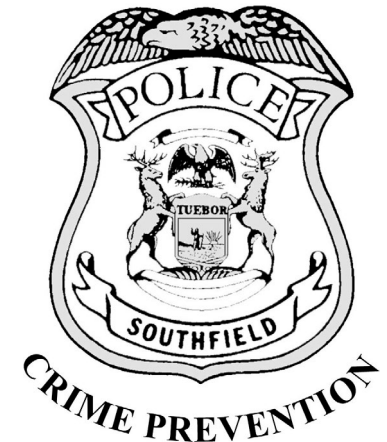
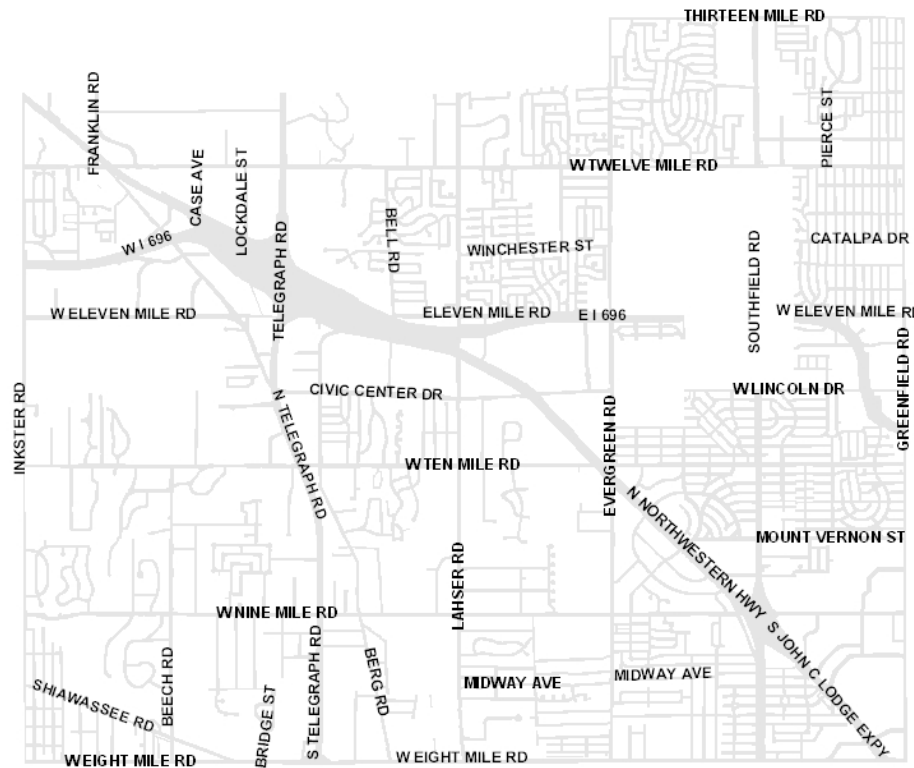

Commercial Burglaries:

Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
09/14/2022 4:43am	21000 W Ten Mile Rd. (Gas Station)	Vehicle was used to force entry into the business.	Officer was on routine patrol when he discovered the front window was broken out on Gas Station in the 21000 Block of W. Ten Mile Rd. A 10' x 10' section making up the front of store was damaged including frame/glass of door, and some concrete. Officers cleared the building. No suspects still on scene. Per Southfield Police Dispatch, no alarm was triggered. Further investigation revealed that an empty ATM Machine was taken. The damage to the business was consistent with a vehicle smashing into the front of the business and then dragging the ATM machine out of the business. The owner advises there should be surveillance video of incident, but it wasn't available at time of report.

09/17/2022 4:13am	26000 Telegraph Rd. (Gas Station)	A large rock was thrown through the front window.	<p>On 09/17/2022 at 5:43am, dispatch advised the Gas Station in the 26000 Block of Telegraph Rd had possibly been broken into.</p> <p>Officers arrived on scene and noticed one of the store fronts windows & frame was laying on the ground in the parking lot. Officers searched the building with negative results for suspects. Representative from the gas station arrived on scene and stated there was an ATM taken.</p> <p>Officers were able to review security footage while on scene. The footage revealed a vehicle pull into the north entrance of the parking lot at 4:13am. Two subjects exited the vehicle and approached the storefront. Suspect#1 Black ski mask, black hoodie, black pants, and gloves. Suspect#2 Black ski mask and surgical mask, black and green camo printed hoodie, black pants, white gloves, and black shoes. Suspect#3 drove the vehicle. Suspect#1 grabbed a rock and began to throw it at the store front window; the glass shattered. Both suspects retrieved a rope from the back of the suspect vehicle and tied it around the ATM. Suspect#3 began to drive the vehicle forward, pulling the ATM into the parking lot. The frame of the store front window was also pulled out.</p> <p>Suspect#1 & #2 grabbed the ATM and placed it into the back of the suspect vehicle. The suspect vehicle fled S/B on Telegraph Rd.</p>

- ❖ Do not display valuable items in windows when closed for business

Dispatch advised a male, and a female were physically fighting outside. The female was trying to break into the home and the male was trying to push her out. Officers arrived on scene, separated the combatants, and interviewed both subjects. Investigation revealed the male's girlfriend came to the residence and was upset that the male half was cheating on her. (There was another female in the house). During the encounter the female forced entry into the male's residence against his wishes and bit him several times when he was trying to keep her out of the house. It was determined that the female didn't live at the male's residence. The female was taken into custody for Home Invasion & Domestic Assault. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician took photos of the males' injuries.

(Gas station) for an Armed Robbery that just occurred.</p> <p>Officers arrived on scene and spoke to victim (employee). He stated that the suspect left prior to Officers arrival. The suspect entered the business at 3:07pm and produced a handgun and pointed it directly at employee while demanding the money. The suspect indicated he wanted the money in the drawer. The male then took the money employee gave him and stated, "Don't call the cops or I will kill you". The subject then backed away from the employee and exited the business at 3:08pm.</p> <p>Suspect Description: Dark skin B/M approx. 5'5"- 5'8" wearing a long black sleeve shirt and black jeans with dark glasses that had gold frames. The suspect was in his late teens to early 20's with no facial hair. The suspect did not have a mask on and had a gold chain around his neck. His shoes were grey with a white stripe on the bottom and a white logo on the back.</p>

Stolen Black Wigs

On 09/12/2022 Officers were dispatched to the 25000 Block of Southfield Rd. (Business) regarding an A&B. Officers arrived on scene and spoke to R/P. R/P stated that two unknown females came into her store and were inquiring about some different wigs. R/P showed the two females' multiple different styles of wigs. The two females then left the store to go get their cell phone to make an apple pay for items. When the females returned one of the females suddenly ripped the wig off R/P's head knocked her down and started to punch her several times. The other female grabbed a wig off a shelf and the two females fled the store and entered a newer model Chevy Malibu. Victim believes that this incident was a set up because she has been receiving threats recently that something bad was going to happen to her. Investigation is on-going.

Suspect/Vehicle Description:
Two black females, about 5' 6", thin build. One female was wearing a yellow shirt with grey pants and the other was wearing a black shirt and black pants. Both females had masks on during the duration of the incident. Both females fled in a newer model, Grey Chevrolet Malibu, unknown plate.

This past week we had two B&Es of Gas Stations where the ATMs were taken.

Investigation was consistent with a vehicle backing into the front door of business. An ATM Machine was taken from the business.
Surveillance video wasn't available at time of report.

On 09/17/2022 at 5:43am, dispatch advised the gas station in the 26000 Block of Telegraph Rd had possibly been broken into.
Officers arrived on scene and discovered good B&E. An ATM Machine had been taken from the business. Three suspects were observed including the driver who used a vehicle to pull the ATM from the business after the two other suspects put straps around the ATM machine.

(Shopping Plaza)

Officer was on routine patrol and observed vehicle running unattended, parked in front of the 25000 Block of Evergreen Rd. Officer queried the license plate on vehicle which returned as stolen vehicle out of another jurisdiction. It was unknown if there were any occupants in the vehicle so additional units were requested to assist in investigating the vehicle. When additional units arrived, the vehicle was found to be unoccupied. Officers then observed a black male with a black tank top and light blue jeans exit an adjacent business. He was walking towards the stolen vehicle, looking at it and mumbled something. Officer recognized the subject as a person that he was familiar with due to previous incidents involving stolen vehicles and firearms. When Officers asked this subject for his ID and to stop, he attempted to flee from Officers. The subject was tased and resisted officers in their attempts to get him handcuffed. The subject was tased a second time and was secured & handcuffed.

Officers made contact at one of the nearby businesses and surveillance video was provided that showed the suspect exiting the stolen vehicle. The key fob for the stolen vehicle was also located on suspect.

Officers also recovered a receipt on suspect for a new pair of shoes that suspect was wearing. The box for the shoes was recovered from the stolen vehicle. Further investigation by officers they recovered two handguns from the stolen vehicle. One of the handguns was reported as stolen. The suspect was taken into custody for R&C Motor Vehicle, R&O Police Officer, CCW & R&C Stolen Property.

The case was submitted to OCPO for review.

Warrant was secured for the suspect for the following:

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you are here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the
