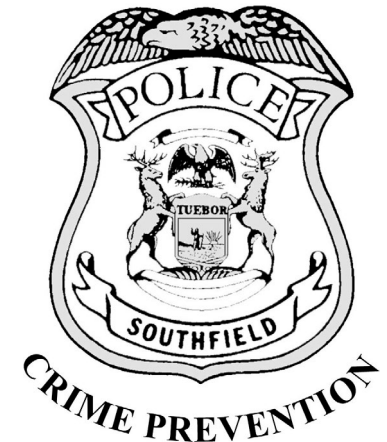
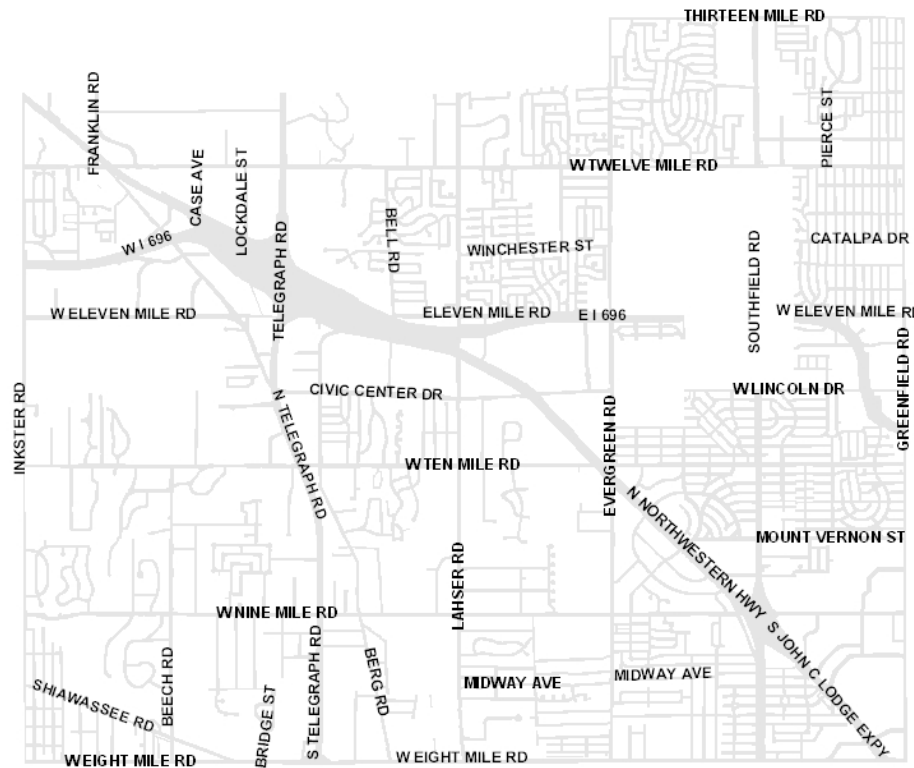

## Commercial Burglaries:

Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
09/27/2022 3:21am	26000 Telegraph Rd. (Gas Station)	Main front door was pried open.	<p>On 09/27/22, Officers were dispatched to an alarm in the 26000 Block of Telegraph Rd. (Gas Station) Officers arrived on scene and discovered the main entrance door had been pried open. There was damage to the door near the locking mechanism and the door was ajar. The owner of the business was contacted and responded to the scene.</p> <p>Video Surveillance showed at 3:20am a Black Cadillac possible CTS pulls into the parking lot and parks directly in front of the entrance doors. 3 subjects exit the vehicle. Each one is dressed in dark clothes, wearing hoodies, masks, gloves and carrying large duffle bags. The front seat passenger used a pry bar to open the doors. All 3 subjects entered the business and go directly toward the vestibule door. The subject with the pry bar makes a quick attempt at the lock on the vestibule door but doesn't make entry.</p> <p>All 3 subjects run out the store and back into the Cadillac. They were in the store 10-20 seconds. In the video the subjects were carrying large red plaid bags. One of the subjects has shoulder length dread locks that appear to be colored. The vehicle exited the lot, drove NB in the SB lanes of Telegraph, and entered the first turn around to go NB on Telegraph.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> At 4:40am another nearby jurisdiction had a similar B&amp;E. A Newer Black Cadillac occupied by 3 black males broke into a business. The vehicle was last seen on 696 west of Mound Rd.</p>

<p>10/01/2022 3:40am</p>	<p>28000 Franklin Rd (Hotel)</p>	<p>Entry was made by forcing open a boarded up section attached to the building.</p>	<p>Anonymous call came in that there was someone in the abandoned building in the 28000 Block of Franklin Rd. (Abandoned Hotel). Officers arrived at location and observed a Black Cadillac parked at the location. Because the building is listed as condemned and not safe Officers did not go into the building. There appeared to be fresh damage where entry was made into the building. A subject eventually came out of the building, and he was taken into custody for B&amp;E. No other subjects were located.</p>

10/01/2022 9:40pm	29000 Everett St.	Front door was kicked in.	On 10/01/2022, Officers were dispatched to the 29000 Block of Everett St. to investigate Home Invasion. R/P, the homeowner's sister advises she told her boyfriend to come over to discuss their relationship issues. When he arrived, he tried to take R/P's cell phone from her. R/P grabbed his bag of weed and went into the house. Shortly after this she came back outside and observed her boyfriend holding a handgun by his side. He never pointed the gun at her. She went back inside and tried to lock the door. An unknown second male (larger build B/M) kicked the front door in. Both males then entered the residence. They were in the house a short time and then fled the scene in an unknown black SUV, possibly a Lincoln Navigator or Black Jeep Grand Cherokee. A witness that was in the residence when all of this happened stated she observed two unknown black males with handguns inside the residence. She described one male as being a "chubby", light skinned, black male with dreads. The second subject was also "chubby" but dark skinned and was wearing a hat. Witness stated that both subjects had handguns in their hands. Investigation is on-going.

10/02/2022 10:35am

#### Greenfield Rd. & W Eight Mile Rd.

Officer was on patrol and heard a broadcast from Dispatch that a shooting occurred in Bloomfield Township near Telegraph Rd and Maple Rd.

The suspect vehicle, described as a white Chrysler 300, was last seen southbound on Telegraph Rd. The license plate on the suspect vehicle was given to Officers.

Officer while around Greenfield and Pembroke observed a Chrysler 300 eastbound on Pembroke Ave, approaching Greenfield Rd. Officer caught up to the White Chrysler 300 & confirmed the plate attached matched the shooting suspect vehicle. He informed Dispatch and requested additional units. A second officer arrived, and they activated their emergency police lights to affect a stop on the vehicle. The Chrysler 300 pulled over to the side of the road. Officer began giving verbal commands over the vehicle PA to turn off the car. Officers heard a faint "pop" and then later learned after approaching the vehicle that the lone driver had shot himself. Detroit Life Unit arrived on scene and pronounced the driver as deceased. It was later confirmed that this was the suspect in the shooting in Bloomfield Township.

## **Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**

### **How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you are here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the

## **Fleeing & Eluding/ R&C - 1- Arrest**

**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.
