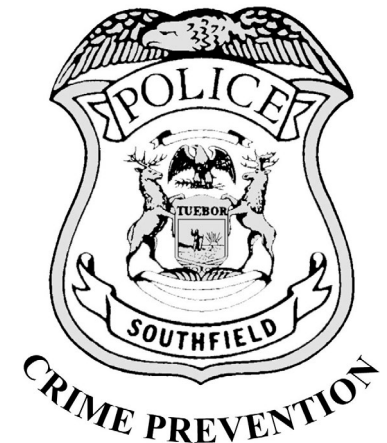
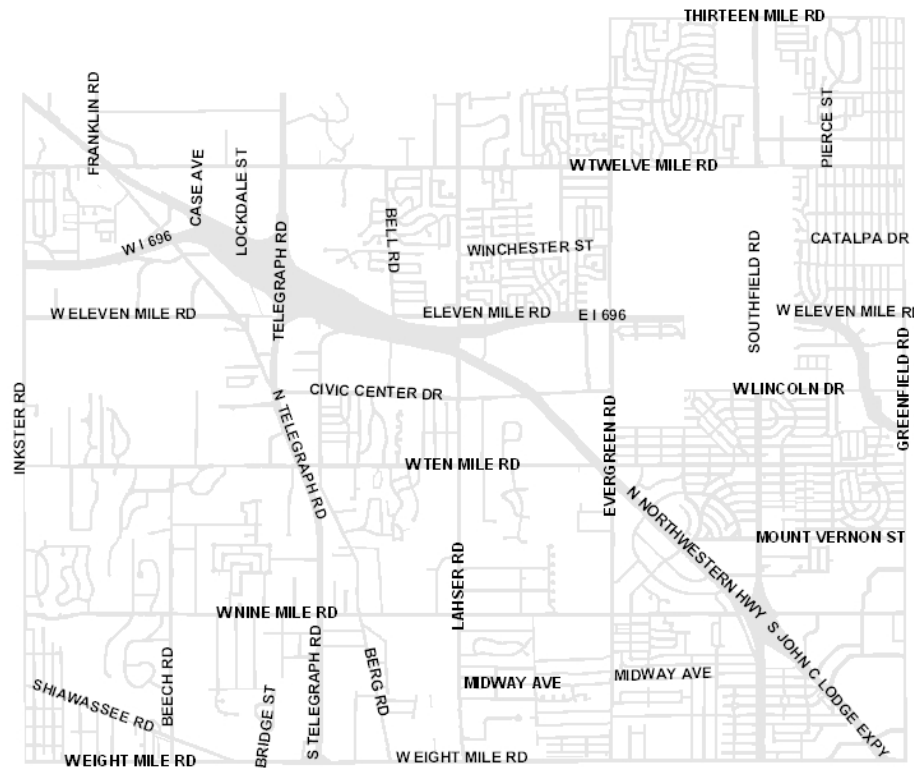

Catalytic Converter was taken from 2004 Ford F-350.</p> <p>Officers arrived on scene and were advised by a witness that the suspects that took the catalytic converter were driving a white SUV type vehicle. Officer located possible suspect vehicle. It was a White Chevy Equinox. He got behind the suspect vehicle on Twelve Mile as it was turning onto S/B Northwestern Hwy. The vehicle immediately started to flee from Officer who had his lights & siren activated. On 09/07/2022 at approx. 8:25am our department was advised by administration from the high school that a student was possibly armed with a handgun. The front office was alerted by an anonymous person that a student arrived at school this morning and had a handgun in his bookbag. A search of the school for subject was conducted and he was found by security near door located on the north side of the school. The student's bag was removed and searched by Security. Security recovered a handgun along with several THC infused snack items and vape liquids from his bookbag. The handgun's serial number was checked through dispatch, and it returned as stolen. The student was taken into custody by Southfield Police School Liaison Officers. He was transported by officers to the Southfield Police Station where he was processed in the juvenile holding area. During the initial investigation there was no information to indicate that the student made any threats with the handgun. Contact was made with the student's mother, and she was advised that her son was in custody and would be transported to Oakland County's Children's Village. The student was transported and turned over to intake Specialist at the Village. Hearing is schedule for the following day at 6th Circuit Court (Probate Division).

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage, you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you are here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately calls 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the

Officers were dispatched to the parking lot of Gas Station in the 25000 Block of Evergreen Road. Dispatch advised a B/M in a BMW has been parked outside of the business for approx. 3 hours. Additionally, the gas station clerk attempted to wake the male up but was unsuccessful. Officers arrived on scene and observed the vehicle in question running with the brake lights on. Officers positioned their vehicles in front and behind the vehicle. Officers approached the vehicle and observed the driver sleeping with his foot on the brake pedal. Officers attempted to wake the subject. He didn't wake up right away and mumbled something. Officers were eventually able to wake the driver. Officers asked the driver to put the vehicle in park and shut the vehicle off. The driver took his foot off the brake and the vehicle started to move forward. He then stopped the vehicle, put it in park and shut it off. Officers could smell the odor of intoxicants; the driver's speech was slurred, and his eyes were bloodshot. Officers began OWI investigation. The driver refused sobriety tests, PBT & Chemical Test. He was taken into custody for OWI and transported to Providence Hospital for a Blood Draw. Search warrant for the Blood Draw was obtained and executed. Subject was then transported to Southfield Jail processed and lodged.
