


After inventory was completed, the victim found that 4 keys were taken from/near the lock box near the front door. A box truck was taken using one of the stolen keys. SUSPECT DESCRIPTION: Surveillance footage shows an unknown male, medium build, approximately 5'7" to 5'11", wearing a white hooded sweatshirt with the hood up, unknown colored ballcap, black gloves, black pants, and black shoes. Investigation is ongoing.

INFORMATION: Officers were dispatched to the listed area for a report of an LFA. Officers were given information that two subjects were seen running through the parking lot. The victim was told by a neighbor that two individuals were seen inside her vehicle and they took off running shortly after the incident.
