













The Deer-Resistant Garden

If you live in an area with foraging deer, you've likely watched some of your favorite plants experience browse. But before you give up on gardening altogether, try making your yard less appealing to deer by choosing plants that deer find less desirable.

It's important to remember that unless you build a very tall fence, there is no such thing as a deer-proof garden. Deer will eat anything if they are hungry enough, and they can adapt and eat plants that are considered "resistant." However, deer do have their favorites, and they're more attracted to places where their preferred food is easily available.

In general, deer prefer.

Plants with lush foliage and high water content, such as hostas Early spring plants like tulips, crocuses, and forsythia Fruiting and berry-producing plants, including vegetable gardens



Deer are less **likely to be attracted** to:
Herbs and strongly flavored plants
Heavily scented foliage
Plants with fuzzy or hairy leaves
Prickly plants
Ferns
Grasses
