Pre-purchase is limited to 10 wristbands per household. Pre-purchasing guarantees admittance.

Splash Pad Rules

- The splash pad operates in 5-minute timed cycles. To start the splash pad, press the button on the activator switch.
- The splash pad is unsupervised and use at your own risk, children must be accompanied by an adult.
- The following items are not allowed in the splash pad area
 - Pets (Service dogs permitted)
 - Glass containers or breakable objects
 - Alcohol
 - Soaps
 - Skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles, scooters

- Athletic equipment such as, balls, bats, noodles, etc.
 - No Smoking
 - No food/beverages in splash zone area
- Swimsuits and/or appropriate attire must be worn at all times, including swim diapers for all toddlers
- The water is chlorinated and processed through a filtration system; do not drink the water
- Climbing, hanging, swinging, or pulling on any splash pad equipment is strictly prohibited
- All participants must conduct themselves in a courteous, safe, and family-orientated manner
- The splash pad and playground area are open to the public and cannot be reserved for private parties or functions

Park Features:

The Lagoon: Main pool with a zero-depth edge

Storm Mountain: Tube slide (Red Thunder) and body slide (Blue Lightning)

Kiddie Cove: Kiddie area with a waterfall, kiddie slide and splash pad

Dolphin Dunes: Sand volleyball and sand play area

Harvey's Hut Concession Stand

Three 25 meter lap lanes (six during lap swim only time slots)

June 7 – August 17 Hours:

Admission:

Day passes can only be purchased the day you visit and cannot be purchased in advance. Walk up visitors are subject to capacity limits and may get turned away if we are near our limit for the day.

Non-resident Daily Pass: \$25/person

Rules:

Children 6 years and under must be directly supervised in the water by an individual 16 or older, who must be within arm's length at all times.

Children over 6 years of age, but under 10 must have an adult within the facility at all times.

Appropriate and approved swim wear is required. No gym shorts.

Swim diapers are required for children not yet potty trained, with a swimsuit. These are available for purchase at the cashier booth.

Outside food and drinks are not permitted in the facility. Harvey's Hut concessions offers food and drinks for sale and the outdoor picnic area is available outside the facility.

For safety reasons, flotation devices and toys are not allowed in the facility (with the exception of Coast Guard approved life jackets).

To ride the body and tube slides, you must be 42" tall and a swim test may also be required.
