The central tower and the extended stay wing will continue to operate as the Radisson.














Construction of eight additional townhouses continues at MapleTree Townhome complex on Franklin Road. 21 townhomes completed last year.

**Shared-Use Pathways:** The City continues to expand its trail network throughout the City. This allows residents and visitors to safely travel without dependence on vehicles. In addition, these trails provide an opportunity for exercise and recreation.


**EV Charging Stations:** An increase in the installation of EV charging stations has been implemented throughout the City. As the auto industry has shifted its priority to increasing electric vehicle production, cities must be able to meet this demand and provide the necessary charging infrastructure.

**Tamarack Creek Stream and Wetland Habitat Restoration:** This award-winning project has been made possible with partnerships by the Alliance of the Rouge Communities (ARC), the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative (GLRI), and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The ultimate goal is to improve the water quality and increase wildlife habitat in the Rouge River Watershed.






## PATIENCE & PERSISTENCE !! Upcoming Sustainability Projects



Monarch Butterily Sculpture : This vibrant sculpture is sponsored by the Arts Commission and will be located adjacent to the newly-constructed pathway along southbound Northwestern Highway.



Valley Woods Trailhead: This project will provide public access to a recreational trail as part of the Valley Woods Nature Preserve. A small parking lot is proposed south of 12 Mile between Streamwood Lane and Bell Road.


