

Officers were dispatched to the 20000 Block of W Twelve Mile Rd. (Cellular Repair Business.) The alarm company advised they had received a rear door, rear motion and mid motion alarm from the business. Officers arrived on scene and they discovered an unlocked rear door, no force noted. Officers entered business and there were several area's that were disturbed. No suspects were located. The owner arrived on scene and he stated that the only thing missing was a box of Samsung Note 5 Parts. The owner and Officers reviewed the store surveillance video of incident: Approx. 20 minutes prior to Officers arrival the suspect is observed walking in front of the business and turns west and walks along the side of the business heading towards the rear of the store. A few minutes later the subject can be seen running east towards the front of the business carrying what appears to be a white box. The owner believes as the suspect made entry to the rear of the building the audible alarm went off scaring the suspect away.

Victim reported on 04/14/2021 that graffiti was spray painted on his building in the overnight hours of 04/13/2021 into 04/14/2021.

The suspect had used white spray paint to spray the words "If I said I could see the future would you believe me?" and "A megacity will emerge here" on the south and east wall. The east wall was signed "shakur". Please P.I. the surrounding area.

Domestic A&B/ Felon in Possession- 1- Arrest

04/20/2021 3:47pm

17000 Block of Westover Rd.

Officers were dispatched to the 17000 Block of Westover Dr. for a Domestic Disturbance. A female called 911 and could be heard screaming "No". The caller later updated dispatch and stated that her older son attacked her younger son at the park. The younger son was bleeding from the mouth and was requesting paramedics.

Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the two brothers.

The younger brother, (victim) stated he was pulled from his vehicle and punched in the face numerous times while he was in his car with his girlfriend. Victims girlfriend was a witness to the A&B. Victim had injuries to his face and mouth.

After returning home the two brothers continued to verbally argue. The older brother went out to his car in the garage. Victim stated he knows that his brother keeps a handgun in the car.

During Officers investigation, they recovered an unregistered handgun from a jacket in the vehicle. The older brother was taken into custody for Domestic A&B and Felon in Possession of a Firearm.



Domestic A&B/ Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia-1- Arrest

On 04/25/2021, Officers responded to the 27000 Block of Northwestern Hwy. to investigate possible Domestic A&B. Officers contacted the R/P, (Victim). R/P stated that he was called to the hotel to pick up his girlfriend. When he got there the male that wa

the hotel to pick up his girlfriend. When he got there the male that was with his girlfriend struck him twice in the face. R/P had visible injuries to his mouth.

Victims girlfriend stated that R/P (victim) called her and needed some money for food. She told him to come there and she would give him some money. When he got there, he physically grabbed his girlfriend and attempted to force her to leave with him. That was when the male that was with R/P's girlfriend intervened.

Note: Officers that were on-scene were familiar with the parties involved and were aware of an earlier incident at another hotel in Southfield. It appears that the males and females are involved in some type of Prostitution Ring.

The R/P was taken into custody for Domestic Assault v's his alleged girlfriend. After his arrest, Officers located a crack pipe in suspects pocket. Additional charge of Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia.

Serious Injury Accident/ Hit & Run- 1- Arrest

Greenfield Rd. & W Twelve Mile Rd.

On 04/24/2020 at 6:24pm Officers were dispatched to a personal injury accident at Greenfield Rd and Twelve Mile Rd that was called in by Berkley PD.

Two vehicles were involved in the accident. The driver of one of the vehicles fled on foot. The driver still on scene was taken to the Hospital where he was listed in serious condition.

A Southfield Police Accident Investigator was called to the scene to work the accident due to possible serious injuries. The scene was processed. The suspect was subsequently located and arrested. The injured drivers condition was later upgraded to stable condition.

Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package. Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

While searching through the parking lot for evidence, a Southfield Police Evidence Technician recovered one spent shell casing in the area where the incident occurred. R/P (victim) came into the front desk to report that she met a male subject on a dating app. called "Hinged".

On 04/24/2021 the male subject invited R/P to come over to his apartment and play "Drunk Uno". Victim went over to the subject's apartment. After meeting the subject at his apartment, they drove to a liquor store, bought some Liquor and then returned to the male's apartment. After playing the game for a time R/P told the male she didn't want to play anymore and she passed out.

When she woke up the following morning she had no cloths on, was at her apartment now, in her bed with the male subject and had no idea what happened or how she got home.

When she questioned the male, he told her she

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- -If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.
- -Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also

very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

-Citizens should always be mindful not to leave anything of value in their vehicles. Especially wallets, purses, cash, handguns, cell phones, laptops, jewelry, or anything else of value. If you must leave your handgun in your vehicle it should be kept in a gun lock box that is bolted down in the trunk of the vehicle. At the very least you should try to hide the handgun somewhere that it would be difficult to find. The first place that criminals will look is under the front seat, in the center console or in the glove box.
