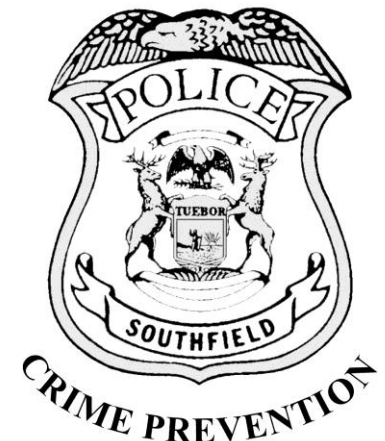
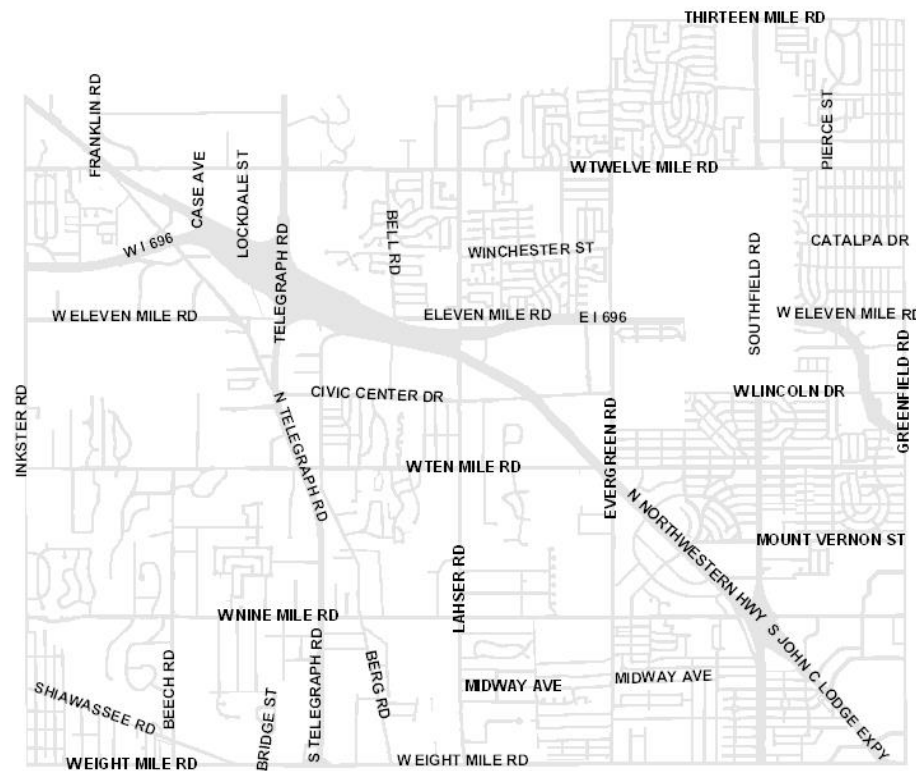

04/27/2021 2:10pm	17000 W Ten Mile Rd. (Commercial- Health Care)	Rear door was kicked in.	<p>On 04/27/2021, Southfield Police Officers were dispatched to the 17000 Block of W. Ten Mile Rd. (Health Care Business) for a breaking and entering in progress. Unknown B/M had arrived in a Black Durango and had entered by forcing entry through the back door of business.</p> <p>Officers arrived on scene and the suspect had already left. Officers contacted female employee R/P. R/P states the suspect is a known patient. He originally showed up and asked to see the doctor. He was told he had to make an appointment. The subject left but returned shortly thereafter and forced entry through the rear door to business. The suspect made some type of threats that he wanted to hurt the doctor. The R/P stopped the suspect from entering the business any further than a couple steps. The suspect then left the business. Several employee's inside the business then heard what they thought was one gunshot. Officers canvassed and processed the area and didn't locate any evidence of a gunshot. The suspect has been identified and the Incident is under investigation.</p>

Officer responded to Gas Station in the 18000 Block of W Nine Mile Road on a report of a subject damaging merchandise inside the business.

The subject was located and detained while Officers investigated further. R/P stated the subject was acting weird and talking to himself while knocking shelves over in the business.

Officers determined that this was a Mental Health situation and took the subject into Protective Custody. He was transported to nearby hospital.

Officers observed three vehicles, all rentals with occupants acting suspicious at Gas Station in the 8 Mile & Southfield Rd. area.

One subject was observed exiting his vehicle and then getting into the back seat of one of the other vehicles. He then exited that vehicle and walked over to the third vehicle carrying a large clear plastic baggie.

A short conversation took place between the driver of this vehicle and the subject with the clear plastic baggie. (Poss. drug transaction)

All occupants returned to their vehicles and the subject with the clear plastic baggie got into his Silver Altima and drove N/B on Southfield Freeway. Officers followed this vehicle and observed vehicle driving recklessly at a high rate of speed cutting off other traffic. The vehicle continued N/B on Southfield to N/B on M-10 at a high rate of speed.

Officers initiated a traffic stop near M-10 & Telegraph Rd.

The vehicle was slow to stop but eventually stopped.

Contact was made with the driver. Officers recovered a plastic baggie with suspected Ecstasy Pills, some marijuana and a Taser.

The driver was taken into custody for VCSA/ Reckless Driving & CCW.

There was also a large sum of cash recovered from the suspect. He did not have a CPL.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Officer was on routine patrol when he observed subject driving w/o his seat belt on. Officer initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle & contact was made with the driver. A LEIN check on the driver revealed his driver's license to be suspended and multiple criminal/traffic warrants.

The driver also had two felony warrants for counterfeiting from 47th District Court in Farmington.

The driver was asked to exit the vehicle. As the driver was exiting the vehicle Officers observed a white pill in his hand. The driver stated it was Percocet and he didn't have a prescription for the drug. It was later identified as Oxycodone.

The driver was taken into custody for Possession of a Controlled substance w/o a prescription. He was also issued violations for No Seat Belt & DWLS.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

-Citizens should always be mindful not to leave anything of value in their vehicles. Especially wallets, purses, cash, handguns, cell phones, laptops, jewelry, or anything else of value. If you must leave your handgun in your vehicle it should be kept in a gun lock box that is bolted down in the trunk of the vehicle. At the very least you should try to hide the handgun somewhere that it would be difficult to find. The first place that criminals will look is under the front seat, in the center console or in the glove box.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Officers arrived on scene and interviewed the parties involved.

R/P states her neighbor parked her vehicle so close to her vehicle that she couldn't get into her vehicle. When R/P was inspecting her vehicle for damage her neighbor came out and pointed a gun at her and threatened her. When R/P stated she was going to call the police the suspect quickly moved her car before Officers arrived.

Officers interviewed witnesses that confirmed the suspect pointed a handgun at victim. The handgun was recovered and the suspect was taken into custody for F/A.
