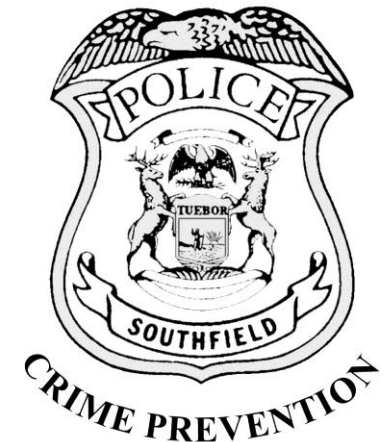

#### (In the Round-about)

Officers were dispatched to the area of Evergreen and Civic Center Drive in response to a Felonious Assault following a custody dispute.

Victim advises that she met with her ex-boyfriend, child in common, for a child exchange. During the child exchange her ex-boyfriend brought his new girlfriend. The ex-boyfriend was driving a **Black Ford Fusion**. The Court Order stated that the victim could have the child for 6 Hours.

Victim took the child w/o incident to a restaurant in Southfield where they spent over an hour. During the visit victim discovered a GPS Tracking Device in her child's backpack, likely placed there by her ex-boyfriend. Victim removed the device and then drove to an unknown park in Southfield. When six hours had passed, victim drove back to their meeting point on Evergreen Rd to turn the child back over to her ex-boyfriend.

After turning the child over to her ex-boyfriend victim felt that her ex-boyfriend and his new girlfriend were following her, as she went west through the round-about, victim saw her ex-boyfriend holding a handgun out of his driver's side window of his Black Ford Fusion. He yelled an

Officers were dispatched to business (Salon), located in the 29000 Block of Northwestern regarding subject making threats to burn down and shoot up the place.

Officers located the subject. He was in his vehicle with a female. Officers requested to see the subjects ID and he refused to provide that information. The subject was very uncooperative and hostile towards Officers and refused to identify himself multiple times when asked. It was confirmed by witnesses from the business that the subject came into the business and made threats to shoot up the place and burn the place down. The subject was asked again to identify himself and he refused. He was taken into custody for Resisting & Obstructing. The female that was with subject was identified and advised on Trespassing.

further assault. The females were separated and the unknown female went back to the Jeep. The unknown female retrieved a handgun from victim's ex-boyfriend, who was seated in the driver's seat of the vehicle. Victim ran back towards her apartment and heard a gunshot. Victim was unsure if the gun was fired towards her or her father's direction. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician recovered evidence suggesting that shots were fired. On 08/11/2020 suspect information was developed and the suspect vehicle was located. The suspect vehicle was followed to a location in Detroit where the vehicle was stopped and three suspects were detained. During the stop Officer observed the passenger, (believed to be male suspect in earlier incident) outside the suspect vehicle. The suspect saw Officer and turned around to flee on foot. As he turned around, Officer observed a handgun in the suspects left hand. Officer had suspect at gunpoint and the suspect dropped the gun. Officer pulled suspect away from the handgun and handcuffed him. Another male and female that were in the vehicle were secured by other Officers. The vehicle suspects were in was reported stolen out of another jurisdiction. The vehicle was recovered. Officer inspected the handgun. It was loaded with an extended magazine and had laser sights attached to it. All three subjects were identified and incident is under investigation.

## **Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**

### **How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

**Special Attention:**

**Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.**

**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.
