<p>Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!) - If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage. - Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock. -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels. -If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible. -If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and 	<p>Disorderly Conduct/ Resisting & Obstructing- 1- Arrest 08/04/2020 10:38am 20000 Block of Camden Sq. (Apartment Complex) Officers were dispatched to the 20000 Block of Camden Sq. for a trouble with subject. R/P called stating her ex-husband was outside her door, demanding to pick up the kids, and refusing to leave. Upon arrival, Officers observed suspect outside of victim's apartment building constantly ringing the doorbell to her apartment. Officers contacted the subject and he stated he was there to pick up his kids and the R/P was refusing to give them to him. Officers spoke with the R/P who showed Officers the Court Order that is in place that states on the day of transfer it shall commence at 4:00pm. The R/P stated she would turn over the kids at that time. The current time was approx. 10:38am. Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Officer was on routine patrol when observing subject in the bus shelter near the Northland Center. Officer has seen the same subject at the bus shelter many times and never has been seen getting on a bus.

Officer set up in the area and began watching the subject.

After approx. 10 minutes Officer observed subject walk up to suspect.

The suspect reached into his right front pocket and pulled out a clear sandwich baggie. The suspect then pulled a smaller bag out from the sandwich baggie and handed it to the other subject. The subject then handed suspect an unknown amount of currency. Suspect put the currency into his pants pocket. Due to Officers training and experience, he believed a narcotics transaction just occurred.

Additional Officers responded and contact was made with both subjects while they were still at the bus stop. While walking up to the seller, Officers observed a clear plastic bag sticking out of his right front pants pocket. While patting this subject down Officer felt the handle of a pistol. he lifted subject's shirt and observed a semi auto pistol tucked in his waistband. Officer took the pistol out from subject's waistband and secured it.

Further search of subject, a large clear sandwich bag filled with several corner tie baggies of a green leafy substance suspected to be marijuana and an undisclosed amount of cash from his left front pants pocket were recovered. The subject was taken into custody for CCW & Selling Marijuana.

The baggie with suspected marijuana that subject bought was confiscated and the subject was advised and released.
