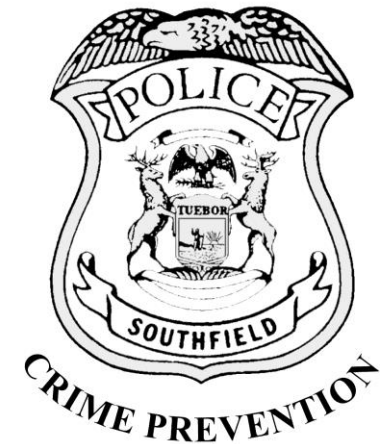

Officers arrived on scene and discovered Good B&E. The glass was shattered at the front of the store. Officers also discovered other agency Surveillance Units that were following the suspects and observed the B&E. They attempted to stop the suspect vehicle but it struck their vehicles and fled the area. After speaking with Officers from Unit they advised that the suspect vehicle is a Black Jeep Trail Hawk bearing a Michigan License Plate. Nothing was taken in the B&E but several items were damaged inside the store.</p> <p>Suspect Descriptions:</p> <p>Susp. #1 unknown, thin build wearing a black hoodie with white lettering along the chest, black pants.</p> <p>Susp. #2 unknown, heavy build wearing a black hoodie and black pants.</p> <p>Susp. #3 unknown, wearing a black hoodie and black pants.</p> <p>Officers investigating later learned that the surveillance unit had located and made an arrest of one of the individuals responsible for the B&E. He was transport to Southfield PD processed and lodged. Identified as Suspect#2.</p>

Officers interviewed the employee again and he still denied any knowledge of the wallet. Because Officers couldn't review the video on-scene the suspect was RPI'd pending further investigation. He was relieved of his duties by business. Suspect has been identified. The business will send a copy of the surveillance video to our Detective Bureau for review and possible future Complaint & Warrant.</p>

<p>Special Attention:</p> <p>Arson Investigation Involving a Vehicle 16000 Block of W Nine Mile Rd. (Apartments)</p> <p>On 08/31/2021 Officers were dispatched to the 16000 Block of W Nine Mile Rd (Apartments) regarding a possible arson. The caller, (witness) stated he heard what sounded like glass breaking. He looked out into the parking lot and observed an unknown male walking away from a parked vehicle that had an active fire inside of it.</p> <p>He described the suspect as a black male, approx. 6 feet tall, a short afro, blue jeans, and a grey shirt. He did not recognize the male.</p> <p>Southfield FD responded and put the fire out.
