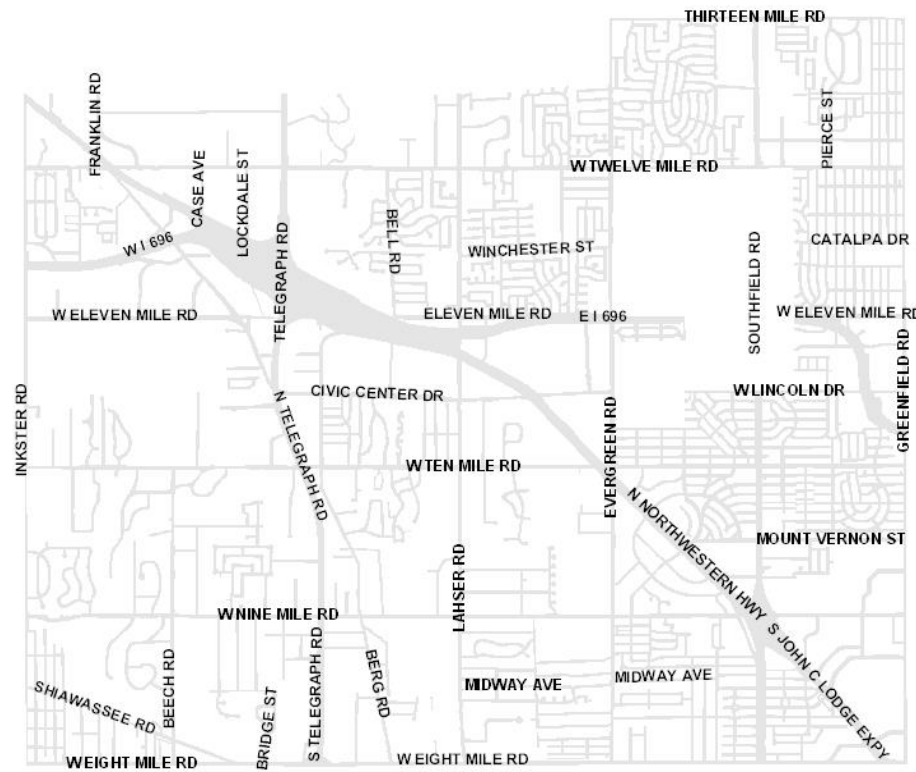

(Condo's)	Status SR - Both Stolen & Recovered Manufacturer JORDAN Model AIR RETRO 11 Serial No. License No. Color BLK - Black Description BLACK AIR JORDAN RETRO 11 Recovered Date/Time 12/18/2020 5:34pm	<p>Officers were dispatched to the 25000 Block of Shiawassee (Condo's) for an Armed Robbery that just had occurred.</p> <p>Victim states he arranged a Facebook Marketplace sale of a pair of Air Jordan Retro 11 shoes with a male that gave his face book name. Suspect told victim to meet him at 4:00pm and to park next to a red minivan and Impala that were parked in the lot. (Same M.O. as several other Robberies &amp; Larcenies) The suspect approached victims pickup truck from the passenger side and asked to see the shoes. Victim told suspect "let me see the money first". The suspect produced "what looked like a black handgun" with his right hand but never pointed it at victim. The suspect kept the handgun to the side and told victim, "give me the shoes." Victim opened the window a little further and the suspect grabbed the shoes and ran south between two condo buildings. He entered the south entrance door of building in the 25000 Block of Shiawassee.</p> <p>The suspect was described as a B/M, about 25-30 years of age, wearing a black "bootleg" Canada Goose jacket with a white patch on the sleeve &amp; black pants.</p> <p>A Farmington Hills K-9 Unit responded to assist in a track of the suspect. The K-9 track started near</p>

			<p>where the Robbery took place. The K-9 was tracking towards the same south entrance door. where the suspect was last seen entering this building. While on the track, a black male matching the description of suspect, poked his head out at this door. When the subject observed officers conducting the search, he quickly went back inside and closed the door. Officers observed the subject wearing a black winter coat matching the description given by the victim.</p> <p>The building was secured and several Officers conducted a building search for the suspect. Officers found the suspect in the lower storage level, hiding in the south corner, underneath the staircase. Officers ordered suspect out of the corner. He was detained, without incident. A search of the lower level revealed a black coat with a white patch on the sleeve covering a black/grey Jordan shoebox with a pair of "Air Jordan Retro 11s" inside of the shoebox. Officers searched the remainder of the building, along with the surrounding area and were unable to locate a handgun.</p> <p>Officers determined there was enough probable cause to place suspect under arrest for Armed Robbery. He was transported and lodged at the Southfield Jail without incident.</p> <p>A Southfield Police Evidence Technician made the location to process the scene and collect evidence.</p>

			<p><b>Note:</b> This incident appears to possibly be related to two earlier incidents possibly involving same suspect. Detectives interviewed suspect and he made admissions to this crime. Information was also gathered that would indicate that there is possibly a second suspect involved in the string of Larcenies and Robbery's at the same location. Detectives drafted a SW for the residence that suspect is associated with. The search warrant was later executed and evidence was taken from the residence. Investigation is on-going.</p>

Victim states she had just got her carry out order from Restaurant in the 18000 Block of 10 Mile Rd. and walked back to her car. An unknown B/M approx. 20-30y/o, approx. 5'5"-5'7", thin build, LSW a black surgical mask, black leather jacket, a black hoodie underneath the jacket with the hood up, and black pants opened her car door and forced his way into her car pushing her over into the passenger seat. He was sitting on her legs and stated, "where is your purse"? The victim stated, "Your sitting on it". The suspect lifted himself up to get the purse which allowed the victim to exit the vehicle from the passenger door and she ran back into the restaurant to call the Police. The suspect was last seen driving victims 2007 Blue Saab 9-3 N/B on Southfield Rd from Ten Mile Rd.

Victim had multiple items of value in her vehicle: Camera and lighting equipment, purse that contained approx. four credit cards, two check books, iPhone 11 Pro, and her driver's license.

### **Recovery Information:**

On 12/19/2020, Southfield/Royal Oak/Beverly Hills Police Departments recovered the vehicle at Southfield Rd and W Thirteen Mile Rd. The driver of the vehicle was located inside the garage of a nearby home and was arrested by Royal Oak PD after a brief vehicle pursuit and foot chase. Royal Oak PD charged suspect with receiving and concealing motor vehicle and fleeing and eluding.

			<p>Royal Oak PD also recovered the vehicle and processed it for evidence. Detective from Royal Oak PD and Detective from Southfield PD interviewed suspect at the Royal Oak Police Department. Suspect stated he knew the vehicle was stolen but he was not the one who stole it. Suspect gave Detectives the first name only of the subject he got the vehicle from. Investigation is on-going.</p>

<p><b>Special Attention:</b>  <b>Domestic- Assault/Strangulation/ Interfering with 911 call.</b>  12/17/2020 1:15pm  16000 Block of W Nine Mile Rd.  <b>(Apartments)</b>  Officers responded to the 16000 Block of W 9 Mile Rd. for a report of a female who was assaulted. Victim states she had been residing at her apartment with her boyfriend until approx. one week ago. Until the boyfriend was recently arrested by Southfield Police for Domestic Violence. The boyfriend returned to the apartment on 12/17/2020 to gather his belongings. While he was there he flipped the couch over while the victim was still sitting on it and then choked her until she almost lost consciousness. He also punched her and when she tried to call 911 he took her cell phone from her. The suspect was not there when Officers arrived. Investigation was completed and PC for arrest of suspect for Domestic Assault/ Strangulation and Interfering with 911 call was established. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician took photos of the condition of apartment and victims injuries. A Southfield Police Detective presented case to OCPO and obtained complaint and warrant for Domestic Assault/ Strangulation.  <b>Note:</b> There are numerous priors (out of state) besides the recent Southfield Incident.</p>	<p><b>Possession of Heroin/ Retail Fraud II/ Obstruct</b>  12/17/2020 11:30am  29000 Block of Southfield Rd.  <b>(Home Goods)</b>  On 12/17/2020, Officers were dispatched to the 29000 Block of Southfield Rd. for a Retail Fraud Investigation. Officers arrived on scene and their investigation led to the arrest of male suspect for Retail Fraud. He was observed placing several items into his shopping basket. He fraudulently returned some of the items at the return desk and then left the store w/o paying for the remaining items in his basket. When the suspect was searched Officers located suspected heroin in his shirt pocket. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested a sample of the substance and it returned positive for possible presence of Heroin. During questioning of suspect, he gave Officers an alias name. Suspect was transported to the Southfield Jail where he was processed and lodged.</p>

On 12/20/2020 at approx. 5:51am Officers were dispatched to the 28000 Block of Franklin Rd. on a naked female running around outside screaming for help. Officer located the female and she was dressed only in her bra and was very emotional about what had happened to her. She was shaking uncontrollably and holding onto Officer when she contacted her.

The victim advised that she was at a party at a friend's house in Detroit. She drank too much and when she realized that she was intoxicated she went out to her car to sleep it off. A subject known to her by first name only convinced her to let him drive her home to her apartment in Southfield. He drove her home in his White Dodge Ram Pick Up Truck and victim stated she remembers passing in and out because she was so intoxicated. The next thing she remembered was waking up in her bed, naked with the suspect on top of her, having sex with her. She began kicking and attempting to get him off her when he punched her in the face, strangled her with his hand and told her to shut up. Victim somehow struggled away from him and went into the main area of the apartment where she got a knife from the kitchen and chased the subject out of her apartment.

The victim gave Officers a complete description of the suspect and advised he was driving a White Dodge Ram Pick Up Truck.

Victim was transported to the hospital for treatment.

The suspect was not located.

Southfield Detectives met with the victim and obtained enough information that they developed a suspect.

Detectives presented a photo show to victim with suspect in it.

The victim immediately picked out the suspect.

On 12/21/2020 Detectives requested assistance from SPD Special Unit in locating the suspect. On 12/23/2020 at approx. 3:30pm Officers observed suspects White Dodge Ram at 12 Mile and Ryan. Surveillance units followed the Dodge Ram to a business in Madison Heights. Officers observed a tall black male exit the Dodge Ram and confirmed it was the suspect. Officers observed the suspect walk into business alone. Officers located the suspect inside business and he was taken into custody w/o incident. Great job by everyone involved in this investigation.
