Surveillance Video from business shows one suspect with a pry bar entering the business at 2:54am. The suspect is seen at the front of business going through the registers between 2:56am- 3:00am. The suspect then exited out of the back door at 3:02am. The suspect was wearing a dark green jacket, black hoodie with the hood up, dark jeans and appeared to be wearing gloves.</p> <p>Note: This incident appears to be like the B&E at another Donut Shop that occurred in the 24000 Block of Telegraph Rd. on 12/16/2019.</p>
