The suspects also attempted to open the ATM but entry wasn't made.</p> <p>Surveillance Video shows the following:</p> <p><b>Suspect Vehicle:</b> Silver, Chrysler Town &amp; Country (newer model), unknown plate, no special characteristics.</p> <p><b>Suspects:</b> <b>Suspect #1:</b> B/M, 300 lbs., 6'3"-6'5", gray shirt, gray sweatpants, wearing a dark hat.</p> <p><b>Suspect #2:</b> B/M, 250 lbs., 6', dark gray hoodie and dark gray sweats.</p> <p><b>Suspect #3:</b> B/M, 230 lbs., 6', black jacket and blue jeans.</p>

Victim had her phone in her hand and suspect forcefully took it out of her hand and shoved her as she entered the house.</p> <p>It was later learned that victim got into an argument with suspect that turned physical over money that suspect claimed she owed him for posting her profile online. Victim refused to clarify what the "posting" was all about.</p> <p>The victim then refused to cooperate and stated she didn't want to prosecute, all she wanted was her cell phone back.</p> <p>Officers checked the residence on Rougemont. There was no response at the door.</p> <p>The home registers to a subject that has had multiple contacts with Law Enforcement.</p> <p>Detectives contacted victim later and victim didn't wish to pursue matter.</p>

**Southfield Rd. & Mount Vernon St.**

On 12/4/2019 at 5:13pm Officers were dispatched to a shooting on S/B Southfield Rd. & 10 Mile Rd.

Dispatch advised Officers the shooting was the result of a possible Road Rage Incident.

Officers interviewed victim. She advised Officers she may have cut off a vehicle that was in traffic. The vehicle in question, a red sedan, pulled in front of her and stopped in the middle of the road. She stated she drove around the vehicle and proceeded to drive slow in front of him.

The suspect vehicle then drove up to the passenger side of victim's car and the unknown suspect pointed a small black handgun at her and shot one round at the passenger side window shattering the window. The victim was not hit by the projectile.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene. The projectile wasn't located and there was no damage located inside the vehicle.

It's possible the window may have been shot out with a BB or Pellet Gun.
